If still the party to the dispute is not satisfied, then the final appeal lies to the Arbitration Committee of the UELCI. Under no circumstances the parties to the disputes shall seek redressal of their grievances in the Court of Law before the Diocesan, Central Council or UELCI constitutional processes are exhausted.

The managing committee and/or governing body of the Bethesda High School, Gossner High School and Bethesda Inter College shall be formed by the Central Council.

ARTICLE - FIFTEEN

PROPERTY BOARD OR TRUST

- 1. The Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church is the legal owner of all immovable properties, lands and buildings presently lying within the territorial jurisdiction of Gossner Church Congregations, Dioceses, Ranchi GEL Congregation and Central Institutions. All proparties that may be acquired in the future by various units of the Church also belong to the GLLC.
- 2. The various units of the Church have only legal right to the use and development of the properties under their jurisdiction but have no right whatsoever at any time under any pretext to alienate the properties in whatever form.
- 3. There shall be a Property Board or Trust which consist of the following
 - Two representative from each Diocese i)
 - ii) Two representatives from Ranchi H/Qr. Congregation, one of whom shall be a woman.
 - iii) One legal expert - advocate as adviser
 - Manager, Property Board or Trust iv)
 - Secretary to be elected from amongst the v) members
 - Chairperson nominated by the Central vi) Council

- 4. The Board shall have a paid Manager or Managers to administer the property. The Manager shall hold in safe keeping all documents, registers etc. relating to properties. He shall also maintain the accounts of the Board into which all income from all properties of the Gossner Church shall be entered. In each Diocese there shall be appointed by the Diocesan Council a sub-committee on properties within the area of the Diocese. The Central Board will act in cooperation and consultation with the Diocesan Committees.
- There shall be a Half Yearly audit of the account 5. books of the Board. The Bishop of the Dioceses shall report to the Central Board from time to time on the financial aspects of the administration of the properties within their areas. The Manager shall submit a report at every meeting of the Board on the properties under the Board and their financial situations. The Board at every meeting shall pay adequate attention to the financial aspects of the report of the Manager and Bishops, and express its opinion on the report in writing, and the action of the Board in this respect shall be immediately reported to the Central Council and Diocesan Sub-Committes, Detailed rules of the aquisition, purchase, use, lease and sale of properties shall be worked out by the Board and reported to the Central Council and Diocesan Samiti. An annual report on property transaction shall be submitted by the Board of the Central Council and the Diocese. In the management of the property of the Gossner Church the Board of property shall be directly responsible to the Central Council and work under Its control, direction and approval. The special power of Attorney be given to the Manager. The General power of attorney shall be given by the Central Council jointly to the Chairperson, the Secretary and the Manager of the property Board or Trust, and special power of attorney to the individuals as per need on receipt of due recommendations of Diocese/Units.
- 6. The Board shall meet as often as necessary but at least once in three months and seven members ahall



Clause K:

Concerning Administration :

- 1. He/She shall have general supervision of the management of the Diocesan office through the office bearers and the other workers who are appointed by the Diocesan Council.
- 2. He/She shall see that the decisions of the Diocesan Council be implemented properly and in due time.
- 3. The Bishop can refer back any decision of the Parish Council to the concerned committee to review for reconsideration with reasons in writing. If the same decision comes again the same to be placed before the Diocesan Council for decision which shall be final.
- 4. He/She shall extend full co-operation to the plans and programmes of the Central Council to promote oneness and spiritual growth, development and witness of the Gossner Church as a whole.
- 5. The Diocesan Bishop shall participate upon request by the Central Council in programmes organised by the latter.
- D. JACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF BISHOP DUE TO RETIREMENT AND OTHER REASONS :

Clause A :

A Bishop shall retire from service according to the Rules of retirement applicable to pastors.

Clause B :

The sishop has the right to resign from his/her office giving three months notice. In such an event the matter is to be placed before the Diocesan Council and that the Diocesan Council shall immediately refer the matter to the Moderator for necessary action.

Clause C:

A Bithop shall accept the work assigned to him/her by the Diocesan Council after the term of his office is over. He/She has no right to how the Bishop's title after the term of office is completed.





Gossner of Berlin erected their tents on 2nd November, 1845 at the present GEIC Centre at Ranchi. Gossner Church was inaugurated with the baptism of a girl (Martha) on 25th June, 1846, followed by other children of Missionary and some local parents. - d) He/She shall propose the transfer of Pastors to the Diocesan Council through the Workers and Administrative Committee, if any.
- e) He/She may attend the meetings of the Parish Council and Congregational meetings and all other Boards and committee as a standing invitee and give advice and guidance as Ex-officio member without voting right.

Clause B:

The Bishop shall be responsible to enable the Gospel of Jesus Christ be preached to all people living in the whole area of the Diocese (Matth.28:19). He/She shall continually enable both ministers and members of the Diocese their duties in this respect and promote evangelistic work by his/her own example and by encouragement to others.

Clause C:

The Bishop being also the spiritual leader of the Diocese shall be responsible for the spiritual life of the Diocese. He/She shall carry out this task together with the members of the Diocesan Council so that the aims of the Church will be fulfilled faithfully according to the Constitution and decisions of the Diocesan Council.

Clause D:

He/She shall be an obedient preacher and teacher of the word of God and shall have oversight of the instruction concerning Christian faith in the Congregations of the Diocese.

Clause E :

He/she shall be responsible for fostering spiritual unity, love, faith and discipline in the local Congregations and watch over His flook by making every effort to prevent false teachings. If a person from a Church not ecumenically related to the Church wants to speak or teach in the Diocese, the Congregation shall have to get prior permission from the Bishop for allowing such persons to preach.

THE CONSTITUTION THE GOSSNER EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH CHOTANAGPUR AND ASSAM (Effective from 1995)

ARTICLE - ONE

NAME AND REGISTRATION


1. The body organised under this Constitution shall be called: The Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in Chotanagpur and Assam. The short name of this body in this Constitution shall be "Gossner Church".

Note: It is understood that the terms Chotanagpur and Assam do not mean the Chotanagpur Division and the State of Assam only, but the whole of Bihar, Orissa, Madhya Pradesh, Haryana, West Bengal, Assam and all the adjacent states, the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and the major cities like Calcutta and New Delhi.

2. The Gossner Church was duly registered on July 30, 1921. in the office of the Registrar, Joint Stock Companies, Pata under the Societies Registration Act 21 of 1860.

ARTICLE - TVO DOCTRINAL BASIS

- The Gossner Church receives and holds the Canonical Scriptures of the old and new testament as the inspired word of God, and as the only infallible rule and standard of faith and practice according to which all doctrines and teachings are to be judged.
- 2. The Gossner Church accepts the three ecumenical creeds: namely apostles, the nicene and athanasian, as important testimonials drawn from the Holy scriptures and rejects all errors which they condemn.
- The Gossner Church receives and holds the unaltered Augsburg Confession as a correct ekhibition of the faith and the doctrine of the evangelical Lutheran Church, founded upon the word of God; and acknowledges all churches that sincerely hold and faithfully confess the doctrines of the Unaltered

and through Head Quarter Congregation, Ranchi, with a special status as per revised Constitution adopted in 1960, In 1973 the GELC resolved that this Constitution (1960) needed revision and in 1975 adopted a revised Constitution. However, the Constitution as amended and adopted in 1975 could not be implemented for various reasons and at this time the them North Western Anchal declared itself as an independent Church as NW/GEL Church. As a result of which quite a number of members of the N.W. Anchal formed the N.W. Anchal seprately and Leaving the N.W.G.E.L.Church joined the K.S.S. as F.W. Anchal. The Gossner Church did not recognise this new Church (N.W.G.E.L.Church) as an independent Church. The new NW/GEL Church had been quite eager to become a member of NCCI, UEICI, ACC, LWF and the WCC. Under these circumstances the UEICI initiated negotiations for the possible re-union of these two Churches. The UELCI, meanwhile, on 26th April, 1989 accorded the so called NW/TEL Church a provisional membership of UELCI for a period of 5 years with a expressed goal of negotiating a re-union of the Churches within the period of Five Years. Over this period of Five Years series of negotiations took place under the leadership of UEICI from 28th April, 1989.

Due to insistent demand of the so called NW/GEL Church for withdrawal of the present special status of the Head Quarter Congregation at Ranchi and also due to its difference in opinion concerning the number of future Dioceses in the Church and its Constant demand to adopt the principles based on communalism as opposed to the principle based on the Gospel of Love, Unity and Geographical Contiguity as advocated by the GEL Church and the UEICI IN identifying the boundaries of these Dioceses, the negotiation could not progress satisfactorily. The representatives of the GEL Church with itw unitw exprewwed strong inclination to remain united in one strong GEL Church but with new features and structures reflecting the true nature of the Church. - 3. He/She shall have the general pastoral over sight of the whole Church and shall concern himself/hereself with the spiritual life of the Church and the Lord's mission.
- 4. He/She shall give spiritual guidance and encouragement to the Farish and Congregation.
- 5. He/She shall be the Chairperson of all meetings of the Diocesan Council.
- 6. He/She shall have the general supervision of the work of the other office bearers of the Diocese.
- 7. Special duties and special authority of the Bishop of the Diocese shall be defined in Bye-laws as determined by the Diocesan Council.
- 8. The procedure of election is laid down in the bye-laws.
- 9. He/She may re-elected once if eligible otherwise.

ELIGIBILITY AND ELECTION OF BISHOP

A. ELIGIBILITY

Bishop shall accomplish his/her tasks together with other members of the Diocess and society. To carry out his/her tasks with good conscience and spiritual authority his/her life and work should be blameless according to Scripture, 1 Timo 3:2-7. Therefore,

- a) A candidate for Bishop should be with qualities of leadership, good reputation, honesty, integration, sound theological education in a Seminary and should not have been convicted for moral turpitude.
- A person who has proven ability in his/her previous work, spiritual leadership, in management of property, stewardship of resources and other works.
- c) A candidate for Bishop should not be below 45 and above 59 years of age and must have at least 10 years of successful ministry provided that in the new set up, the First Bishops may be

In the future too Ranchi should continue to inspire not only through its historical past but also by creating a new history demonstrating to the people of Chotanagpur that in Christ the different cultural communities of the area could worship and witness to the one Lord together in true Christian social fellowship. Therefore, Ranchi Congregation historically known as the "Headquarters Congregation" remain autonomous reflecting in its composition and administration the unity of the Gossner Church consisting of several cultural communities.

Hence the Ranchi Congregation continues to enjoy in this new constitution also a separate identity and status, but an integral part of the Gossner Church.

2. COMPOSITION

- i) The membership of the Ranchi Congregation is open to all members of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church from whichever diocese they may hail, members of Gossner Church may join Ranchi Congregations by transfer letters from their respective Congregations. The Ranchi Congregation, however, is the ultimate authority to admit members to the Congregation.
- 1i) Pastoral care and leadership is open to any pastor of the Gossner Church belonging to any diocese if appointed to that responsibility by the appropriate authority of Council of the Ranchi Congregation (CRC).
- iii) The Congregation shall be administered by the CRC.
- iv) The General Body of the Ranchi Congregation shall consist of the confirmed members of the Congregation and also who regularly pay the membership fee as prescribed in the by-laws. The General Body of the CRC shall meet biennially to administer its affairs. It shall receive reports from the Dean the Secretary and the Treasurer Considering of annual budget, audited statements and appointment of auditors shall be the duty of the General Body of the Ranci Congregation. It shall elect its office bearers, Secretary and Treasurer. The Dean is Ex-officio President. It shall also elect a Council of 50 members and also elect an Executive Committee of the CRC.

PROCEDURE FOR AMENDMENT OF THE BYE-LAWS OF THE DIOCESE

- A. The Diocese can amend only the bye-laws related to the Diocese with the consent of at least 50% members of the Council. Proposals for such amendments shall first be submitted to the Parish Council for consideration and that the Central Council is informed of such an amendment.
- B. The section on the basis of faith can not be amended.

ARTICLE - ELEVEN

ARBITRATION IN THE DIOCESE

A. All disputes between members/workers/institutions/Parish Council and the Diocesan Council shall be decided as per the provisions of the constitution and bye-laws of the Diocese arbitration.

If any person/institution/Parish is not satisfied with the Cacision of the Diocesan Council, the said dispute is to be refarred to the Arbitration Committee of the Diocese through the Bishop. The Executive Committee shall set up an Arbitration Committee in each case of the dispute.

In case, function of Office Bearers is soized by any court Order or otherwise, the Central Council shall take the responsibilities of spiritual care and general administration of the Diocese until the Diocese can function legally.

ARTICLE - TWELVE

RANCHI CONGREGATION

- MATIONALE

Manchi had been the seat of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church since its establishment. In shaping the life of the Gossner Cturch, Ranchi witnessed great historical debates, struggles and solutions. Thus it has developed a personality of its own more often inspiring than otherwise. Its history recalls to memory its great personalities, its leaders, tastors, men and women, who have regarded Gossner Church porthy of their lives even. Thus Ranchi is a

- 8. He/She shall carry out all duties assigned to him/her by the Diocesan Council and the Bishop.
- 9. He/She may be re-elected for only one consecutive term.

II. THE TREASURER

- 1. The Treasurer shall be a lay person elected by the Diocesan Council for a term of office of five years.
- 2. The Treasurer shall according to the instruction of the Diocesan Council take care of the finances of the Diocese.
- He/She shall operate joint accounts of the Diocese with signatories of the three office bearers. Two signatories are enough for a single transaction one of whom should be the Treasurer. He/She shall also receive contributions from acroad or locally on behalf of the Diocese. He/She shall make proper investments in the bank as per the decisions of the Diocesan Council.
- 4. Ha/She may be re-elected for only one consecutive term.
- 5. The duties of the Treasurer shall be defined from time to time by the Diocesan Council.
- 6. The 'reasurer is responsible to prepare various plans and projects for future financial self support of the Diocese and place before the Diocesan Council for approval.
- 7. The Treasurer is responsible for reporting to the Diocesan Council for submitting audited accounts. He shall also prepare the annual budget of the Diocese and after approval by the Executive Committee of the Diocese present it to the Diocesan Council.
- 8. The Treasurer is responsible to the Diocesan Council for Proper financial management of the Church as per financial rues and regulations.

action in the matter. If the Diocesan Council finds that the Bishop is guilty for moral turpitude, the Diocesan Council shall take any of the following actions.

- a) In case of the offenses proved against the Bishop are minor the Diocesan Council may take appropriate action.
- b) The Bishop may be asked to submit his resignation.
- c) He/She may be removed from the post of the Bishop.
- d) He/She may be dismissed from all posts.

ARTICLE - NINE

I . THE SECRETARY

- The Secretary shall be a lay person elected by the Diocesan Council for a period of five years.
- 2. The Secretary in consultation with Bishop shall prepare the agenda for the Annual Diocesan Council meetings and convene the Diocesan Council meeting giving the notice of at least a minimum of 5 weeks. In case of an emergency Council meetings, the meeting could be convened with a notice of a minimum of 2 weeks.
 - The tecretary in consultation with the Bishop shall prepare the agenca and convene the normal Executive Committee meetings giving at least a minimum of 3 weeks notice and for an emergency meeting with a minimum of 3 days notice.
 - 4. He/She shall maintain a true and faithful written record or all mixtures of the Diocesan Council and shall keep their records and files in the Diocesan office.
 - 5. He/Sig shall be responsible for the safe custody, preservation and Protection of all minute books, records, files and other documents that go with his/her office.
 - 6. He/She hall be the custodian of all legal documents and represent the Diocese in all legal matters, and shall suo and be sued 0, behalf of the Diocese. He/She shall act according to the decision of the Diocesan Council.
 - 7. He/She shal submit all necessary amondments to the constitution and Bye-laws and necessary documents to the Registrar of

THE BISHOP'S IMPEACHMENT

All complaint and charges against the Bishop must be made in writing and supported by evidence. Any complaint without valid and sufficient evidence should not be entertained at all. & complaint against Bishop unless signed by one third of the ordainer ministers of the Diocese, cannot be entertained. As a Bishop is a pastor of pastors and spiritual leader of the Diccese the matter of impeachment of a Bishop must be dealt with atmost care and respect. Therefore, the question for imposchment of Bishop can be entertained only if it is signed by at least one third of the pastors in active service in the Diocese. This complaint shall be made to the Vice President of the Diocese who shall inform the same to the Secretary and the Treasurer. The Vice President of the Diocese shall send a copy of the complaint to the Bishop with a request to submit his comments on the complaint allowing at least 15 days time. After expiry of the period, the Vice President, the Socretary and the Treasurer shall jointly call for a meeting of the Diocosan Council where the complaint and the comments of the Bishop is to be placed for consideration. This meeting of the Diocesan Council is to be presided by the Vice President. Then the Diocesan Council shall examine the matter.

If it is found that the complaints are manipulated, the complainant if he/she is a worker of the Diocese, he/she must be dismissed from the service, if he/she is a lay person the Diocesan Council may keep him/her under the Church discipline as deemed fit. The Diocesan Council may also take appropriate action against the abaters of the complaint in the act of Bishop's impeachment.

In case the said Diocesan Council finds that there is a prima facio evidence, the Diocesan Council shall appoint an enquiry Committee consisting of five members which shall be constituted as fallows :-

Two Parish Priests, two lay persons (one of whom shall be a Wemen) and the Chairperson for whom the help of the Central Council shall be sought. The Chairperson of the Enquiry Committee shall either be a Bishop of another Diocese of the Central Council or a retired Christian judge or a senior legal person deputed by the Central Council.

If the Enquiry Committee confirms that there is a prima facie case, the Bishop may be honorably relieved until the final report is presented within three months. After closure of the enquiry, the Enquiry Committee shall submit a report along with all evidences collected to the Diocesan Council to take appropriate

Clause K:

Concerning Administration :

- 1. He/She shall have general supervision of the management of the Diocesan office through the office bearers and the other workers who are appointed by the Diocesan Council.
- 2. He/She shall see that the decisions of the Diocesan Council be implemented properly and in due time.
- The Bishop can refer back any decision of the Parish Council to the concerned committee to review for reconsideration with reasons in writing. If the same decision comes again the same to be placed before the Diocesan Council for decision which shall be final.
- 4. He/She shall extend full co-operation to the plans and programmes of the Central Council to promote oneness and spiritual growth, development and witness of the Gossner Church as a whole.
- 5. The Diocesan Bishop shall participate upon request by the Central Council in programmes organised by the latter.
- D. VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF BISHOP DUE TO RETIREMENT AND OTHER REASONS :

Clause A :

A Bishop shall retire from service according to the Rules of retirement applicable to pastors.

Clause B :

The Sishop has the right to resign from his/her office giving three months notice. In such an event the matter is to be placed before the Diocesan Council and that the Diocesan Council shall immediately refer the matter to the Moderator for necessary action.

Clause C:

A Bithop shall accept the work assigned to him/her by the Diocesan Council after the term of his office is over. He/She has no right to hol; the Bishop's title after the term of office is completed.

Clause 1:

In the case of demise, the Vice President shall act in place of Bishop until new Bishop is elected.

Clause F :

He/She shall make every effort, personally or through delegation, encouraging the following works to be carried out faithfully in all areas and branches of the Church.

- a) That the Diocese shall share the responsibility of the Central Council in its work, as a prophetic voice in matters affecting the Government, State and the people in general of the country.
- Appropriate teaching materials be made available for Christian children's religious instructions in confirmation classes, Sunday schools and hostels.
- c) That the Diocese, for the love of Christ and in witness thereof, shall work for the sick, the poor and the needy through appropriate services of the Diocese.

Clause G :

The Bishop as the pastor of pastors shall have the authority to advise and admonish the pastors, and other workers of the Diocese. If necessary the Bishop can take disciplinary action on any pastor, head of an institution, Evangelist or any worker and can suspend temporarily and Pastor, evangelist or any worker of the Diocese upon the recommendation of their concerned Boards and report of the Diocesan Council.

Clawse H :

He/She shall accept candidates for Episcopal ordination and ordain them accordingly.

Clause I :

He/She shall induct the Parish Priests to their works.

Clause J :

He/She shall see that annual refresher course for continuing education programmes and workshops be arranged by the Conveners of the respective Boards and committees for the workers, Elders, Lay people including women and Youth of the Diocese.



In the future too Ranchi should continue to inspire not only through its historical past but also by creating a new history demonstrating to the people of Chotanagpur that in Christ the different cultural communities of the area could worship and witness to the one Lord together in true Christian social fellowship. 2. COMPOSITION

- i) The membership of the Ranchi Congregation is open to all members of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church from whichever diocese they may hail, members of Gossner Church may join Ranchi Congregations by transfer letters from their respective Congregations. The Ranchi Congregation, however, is the ultimate authority to admit members to the Congregation.
- ii) Pastoral care and leadership is open to any pastor of the Gossner Church belonging to any diocese if appointed to that responsibility by the appropriate authority of Council of the Ranchi Congregation (CRC).
- iii) The Congregation shall be administered by the CRC.
- iv) The General Body of the Ranchi Congregation shall consist of the confirmed members of the Congregation and also who regularly pay the membership fee as prescribed in the by-laws. The General Body of the CRC shall meet biennially to administer its affairs. It shall receive reports from the Dean the Secretary and the Treasurer Considering of annual budget, audited statements and appointment of auditors shall be the duty of the General Body of the Ranci Congregation. It shall elect its office bearers, Secretary and Treasurer. The Dean is Ex-officio President. It shall also elect a Council of 50 members and also elect an Executive Committee of the CRC.

ARTICLE - TEN

PROCEDURE FOR AMENDMENT OF THE BYE-LAWS OF THE DIOCESE

- A. The Diocese can amend only the bye-laws related to the Diocese with the consent of at least 50% members of the Council. Proposals for such amendments shall first be submitted to the Parish Council for consideration and that the Central Council is informed of such an amendment.
- B. The section on the basis of faith can not be amended.

ARTICLE - ELEVEN

ARBITRATION IN THE DIOCESE

A. All disputes between members/workers/institutions/Parish Council and the Diocesan Council shall be decided as per the provisions of the constitution and bye-laws of the Diocese arbitration.

If any person/institution/Parish is not satisfied with the decision of the Diocesan Council, the said dispute is to be refarred to the Arbitration Committee of the Diocese through the Bishop. The Executive Committee shall set up an Arbitration Committee in each case of the dispute.

In case, function of Office Bearers is seized by any court order or otherwise, the Central Council shall take the responsibilities of spiritual care and general administration of the Diocese until the Diocese can function legally.

ARTICLE - TWELVE

Societies. He/She shall be responsible for circulating all minutes as per rules.

- 8. He/She shall carry out all duties assigned to him/her by the Diocesan Council and the Bishop.
- 9. He/She may be re-elected for only one consecutive term.

II. THE TREASURER

- The Treasurer shall be a lay person elected by the Dioceson Council for a term of office of five years.
- 2. The Treasurer shall according to the instruction of the Diocesan Council take care of the finances of the Diocese.
- 3. He/She shall operate joint accounts of the Diocese with signatories of the three office bearers. Two signatories are enough for a single transaction one of whom should be the Treasurer. He/She shall also receive contributions from atroad or locally on behalf of the Diocese. He/She shall make proper investments in the bank as per the decisions of the Diocesan Council.
- 4. Ha/She may be re-elected for only one consecutive term.
- 5. The duties of the Treasurer shall be defined from time to time by the Diocesan Council.
- 6. The "reasurer is responsible to prepare various plans and projects for future financial solf support of the Diocese and place before the Diocesan Council for approval.
- 7. The Treasurer is responsible for reporting to the Diocesan Council for submitting audited accounts. He shall also prepare the annual budget of the Diocese and after approval by the Executive Committee of the Diocese present it to the Diocesan Council.
- 8. The Treasurer is responsible to the Diocesan Council for Proper financial management of the Church as per financial rues and regulations.



- i) To initiate and promote ministries and programs that enrich the life and witness of the Church within the Diocese.
- j) The Diocesan Council shall appoint and transfer its workers within the Diocesa according to the need and as per rules to be framed by the Diocesan Council.
- k) The Council shall meet for a minimum of three full days.

D. DIOCESAN COUNCIL MEETINGS

- i) The Bishop shall preside over the Diocesan Council meetings.
- ii) In the absence of the Bishop, at his authorization in writing the Vice President shall preside.
- iii) In an emergency situation when neither the Bishop nor the Vice President will be able to preside, two thirds of the Council members can convene and the senior most Ordained member in age shall be asked to preside.
- iv) The quorum for the regular or special meeting of the Council shall be 1/3 = of the total membership of the Council. In an emergency meeting called under VI 4C(3)., 50% + 1 of the total membership of the Council constitute the quorum.

3. DIGCESAN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A. COMPOSITION

- i) The Diocesan Council shall elect for the period of five years an Executive Committee consisting of the following :
- a) The Officers of the Council = The Bishop, The Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.
- b) Each Parish Chairperson and one lay representative from each Parish.
- c) Chairpersons of the following Boards &
 - Board of Education (Primary, Middle, Secondary and Collegiate).

B. FUNCTIONS

- i) The Executive Committee shall act on behalf of the Council between the meetings of the Council.
- ii) The Executive Committee functions as the Executive of the Council implementing all the decisions of the Council.
- iii) The officers of the Council the Bishop, the Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer are also the Officers of the Executive Committee and may meet as Officers to handle any emergency situations which shall be later rectified by the Executive Committee/Council.
- iv) Executive Committee shall be responsible for the appointment of all the staff for the Council's office and for recruitment of personnel for various positions which the Diocesan Council has approved.
 - v) The Executive Committee shall prepare the agenda for the Diocesan Council meeting in good time to be Circulated to the members before the annual meeting.

C. MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- i) The Executive Committee shall meet as often as necessary but at least once in six months.
- ii) The Secretary in consultation with the Bishop shall propare the agenda and convene the Executive Committee meetings with at least 3 weeks notice to the members.
- iii) Emergency meeting may be called with a minimum of three days notice.
- iv) At both ordinary and emergency meetings $1/3 \div 1$ shall be the quorum.

it that the Lutheran Doctrine is safeguarded, the Gospol of Love is preached and that the Church constitution, the rules and regulations and the Bye-laws are followed and also see that the decisions of the Diocesan and Central Council be carried out.

- 3. He/She shall have the general pastoral over sight of the whole Church and shall concern himself/hereself with the spiritual life of the Church and the Lord's mission.
- 4. He/She shall give spiritual guidance and encouragement to the Parish and Congregation.
- 5. He/She shall be the Chairperson of all meetings of the Diocesan Council.
- 6. He/She shall have the general supervision of the work of the other office bearers of the Diocese.
- 7. Special duties and special authority of the Bishop of the Diocese shall be defined in Bye-laws as determined by the Diocesan Council.
- 8. The procedure of election is laid down in the bye-laws.
- 9. He/She may re-elected once if eligible otherwise.

ELIGIBILITY AND ELECTION OF BISHOP

A. ELIGIBILITY

Bishop shall accomplish his/her tasks together with other members of the Diocese and society. To carry out his/her tasks with good conscience and spiritual authority his/her life and work should be blameless according to Scripture, 1 Timo 3:2-7. Therefore,

- a) A candidate for Bishop should be with qualities of leadership, good reputation, honesty, integration, sound theological education in a Seminary and should not have been convicted for moral turpitude.
- A person who has proven ability in his/her previous work, spiritual leadership, in management of property, stewardship of resources and other works.
- c) A candidate for Bishop should not be below 45 and above 59 years of age and must have at least 10 years of successful ministry provided that in the new set up, the First Bishops may be

with regard to events that have happened within the Diocese and outside of it. Such pastoral letters shall be read out at the time of Sunday services.

- d) He/She shall propose the transfer of Pastors to the Diocesan Council through the Workers and Administrative Committee, if any.
- e) He/She may attend the meetings of the Parish Council and Congregational meetings and all other Boards and committee as a standing invitee and give advice and guidance as Ex-officio member without voting right.

Clause B:

The Bishop shall be responsible to enable the Gospel of Jesus Christ be preached to all people living in the whole area of the Diocese (Matth.28:19). He/She shall continually enable both ministers and members of the Diocese their duties in this respect and promote evangelistic work by his/her own example and by encouragement to others.

Clause C:

The Bishop being also the spiritual leader of the Diocese shall be responsible for the spiritual life of the Diocese. He/She shall carry out this task together with the members of the Diocesan Council so that the aims of the Church will be fulfilled faithfully according to the Constitution and decisions of the Diocesan Council.

Clause D:

He/She shall be an obedient preacher and teacher of the word of God and shall have oversight of the instruction concerning Christian faith in the Congregations of the Diocese.

Clause E :

He he shall be responsible for fostering spiritual unity, love, faith and discipline in the local Congregations and watch over His flock by making every effort to prevent false teachings. If a person from a Church not ecumenically related to the Church wants to speak or teach in the Diocese, the Congregation shall have to get prior permission from the Bishop for allowing such persons to preach.

INSTALLATION OF THE BISHOP ELECT

Clause A :

The Bishop elect shall commence functioning from the end of the Diocesan Council during which he/she was elected or re-elected.

Clause B :

The Bishop shall be installed with Episcopal rights and duties within six weeks from the date of election. The installation should be done according to the order of service fixed for its.

Clause C:

The Moderator (presiding Bishop) of the Central Council shall consecrate the newly elected Bishop assisted by the outgoing Bishop of the Diocese concerned and one or more Bishops of the Dioceses of Gossner Church and/or the other Bishops in the UELCI and CNI. The first Bishops of the Church shall be consecrated by the Bishop of UELCI headed by the Bishop of Trancober (TELC) and Bishop of the CNI .

Clause D:

The Bishop shall bear a cross as a sign of his/her high sacred service, a ring and shall carry a shopherd's staff. The Diocesan Council may decide for special robes for the Bishop. Uniformity in designs and colour of the robes shall be maintained by the Dioceses.


