

Although it has been reported to Miss Quy that you are the Convener of the above Committee now, somehow the enclosed were sent to me. I am forwarding them to you for your attention and action.

Quite a while ago I wrote to you, enquiring when you would be able to take over the Adult Literacy supplies which are lying with me but belong to The Biher Christian Council. Also I had expected you and Mr. Tirkey in February to work on the Mundari charts. Perhaps you did not receive that letter of mine.

Anyway, as I am now planning on leaving this October, and must clear away these materials before I start packing, I would be very grateful to you if you would come at your very earliest opportunity to take the files, library books and other adult literacy materials. There are some things that I need to explain to you about the files, receipts, etc. I shall be remaining in Jasidih for the summer, except for the few days between May 18th and 24th. But the sooner, the better.

Some college students in Sahibganj want to be given training in teaching illiterate adults, so I plan to hold a training course in June. The exact date has not been set. If there is any way at all that I can be of any help to you in this work of adult literacy, I shall be glad to do so as long as I remain in the Country. Blessings on you and this great work!

Adult Literacy Work :

Enclosed are extracts from the proceedings of the BCC biennial meetings held at Ranchi in November last. I am sure you have received a copy of the report which Miss High presented to the Council. You will please read in the resolution 22(g) on the enclosed sheet the very special request the BCC has made to the A.L.C. of the NCC and the reason for making such a request. Perhaps Miss High has already written to you expalining the situation under which the Council had to make this request and hope that you will be pleased to get the approval of the Committee for the arrangement the Council wishes to make regarding the whole-time secretary of the Council and the A.L.Organiser. I have them now on my table and have begun taking action on them some one month behind schedule.

While you will be considering things for Bihar in your meetings, I am preparing myself for a training course in A.L. work at Jasidih from the 17th to the end of Februray 1964. In any case, this training will enrich me in my work as Secretary of the RCC who is supposed to be a jack of every thing and master of none.

High, the Convener, presented a very interesting and inspiring report on the progress made during the year 1963 and wished to be relieved of the Convenership as she was to proceed on furlough. I200/- per amnumn to be paid into the secretarial budget out of the Adult Literacy Fund budget.

We had a very good training-institute in Barharwa, in Santali. Eight women took the course and received certificates. But I suppose this will be reported through the Santal Christian Council.

Then I went to Calcutta and handed in the proof for THE ABUNDANT LIFE READER. The Hindi copy should be ready soon. So I have asked Mr. Blair to have printed on the cover, "With acknowledgment to the N.C.C. for subsidy." So we can include a request for grant in our budget.

I have looked and looked but do not find a budget form for N.C.C. grant applications—only publication grant forms. So I have written to Miss Quy and requested some. When received I shall fill out the form and send it to you, along with the other reports that have to be submitted to her.

Enclosed is a letter sent to me, which I am sending on to you, our new Convener! I hope you will be able to find some prospective writers to take advantage of this offer.
