Explanation of additional expenditure in estimate III compared to estimate II.

I. Item 14. The actual expenditure on working charges exceeded estimate I by Rs. 98, 12, -.

II. Estimate I and II make no provision for nails, cement, lime, metal and transport charge. The actual expenditure on these items amounting to Rs. 98/-/- are seen in estimate III items 15, 16, 18, 19, 21, 22.

III. Sawing charges: When preparing estimate I and II we could not discover that most of the battas had got rotten and had to be replaced. This explains item 20 of estimate III.

IV. The first estimate was prepared before the Hailstorm, did great damage to the tiles. This explains item 17, namely Rs. 120/-/-

V. Items 3-7 proved to be insufficiently provided for in estimate I and II. There was an additional expenditure on wood amounting to Rs. 73/15/-.

We are really sorry that we could not foresee all the repairs necessary, so that we have now to place before the Board a new estimate exceeding estimate II by Rs. 495/7/-

We wish to make it clear, that these Rs. 495/7/- are not meant to purchase asbestos sheets for a ceiling. We ask the C.C., if this ceiling cannot be provided at present, to make provision for it as well as for the floor in next year's budget. The present ceiling gives us no sufficient protection

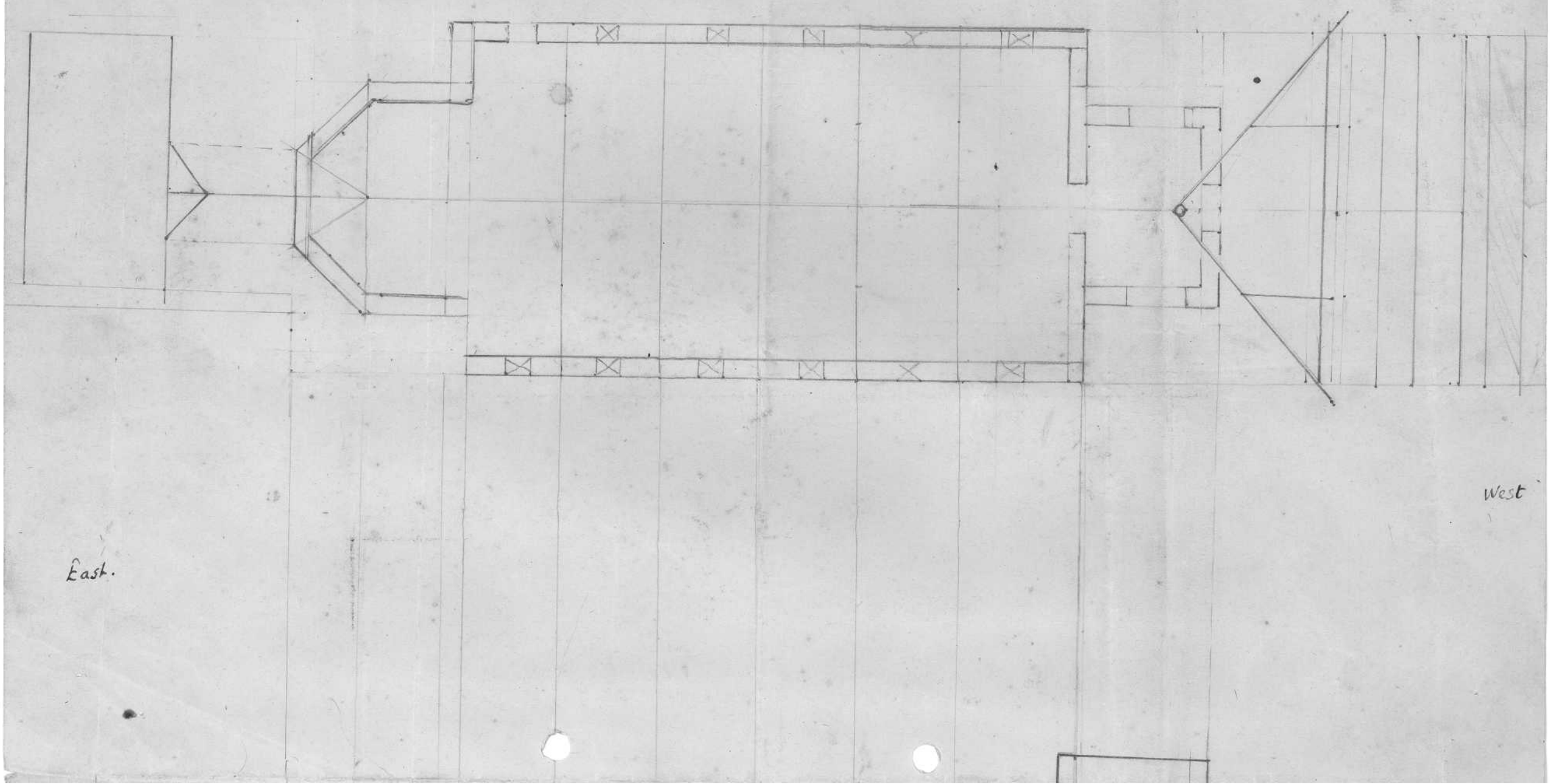

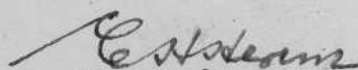

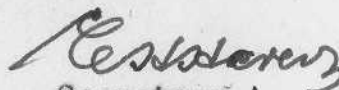

" Matters arising out of the last minutes :-

(a) Akalibandh, (b) Dokad bandh, and (c) Koronjo bandh Pain :- The subject of these lands was ~~discussed~~ discussed in the previous meetings of the full C.C. and the Executive and it was pointed out that the Akalibandh of Khutitoli is the most important bandh which needs repairs. When repaired, there would be available a large area of cultivable land. Further this bandh will be a safeguard to the Chitrabandh for which the C.C. has spent a large sum of money last year. This will cost about a thousand rupees.

Regarding the Dokad bandh it was reported that the bandh has been spoiled by rain water and a little expense to repair it will fetch two crops yearly in the Church land. The cost was said to be Rs. 100/-

Regarding the Koronjo bandh Pain, Daniel Tahshildar reports that Rs. 200/- will be required to repair it. If this Pain is not repaired, there is a likelihood of whole bandh to be affected.

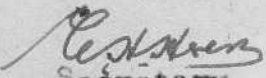

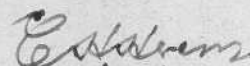

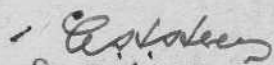
