



Whereas Mr. Strock must be in intimate touch of things in the Gossner Church to be able to make minute study of situations in different spheres of the Churches activities in order to suggest improvements for which he has been called

But whereas Dr. Strock, as any other foreign missionary, under terms of reference, should not fill any administrative position in the Church, so that the autonomy of the Church remains inviolate, which to defend and strengthen is his chief concern

It is resolved that Dr. Strock's ^{besides} designations shall be as follows: ^{and that he} ~~be well also be~~ ^{be} Inspector of Church Finance.

~~Church Property and Church Schools and ^{and} ~~he~~ checks all bills before they are passed by respective authorities. He draws up schemes to make better use of the property for the Church and introduces them in consultation with the C.C. and Bishops shall have access to all books of all schools and recommend ameliorative measures to the C.C.~~

This arrangement shall hold good for three years from the time of its inception.

FEDERATION OF EVANGELICAL-LUTHERAN CHURCHES IN INDIA

Committee for Drafting a Constitution of a United Lutheran Church in India

In preparation of our meeting at Madras I wish to communicate to all members of the committee some thoughts, suggestions and questions which were the outcome of conversations between some friends up here at Kodikamal. They are only meant as material for thought and open to reflection, alteration, and amplification.

We are living in a time when God forces the churches closer together. The ecumenical unity of all true believers becomes more and more manifest (e.g. in the Lutheran World Federation, the World Council of Churches, the Church of South India). The United Evangelical-Lutheran Church in India should be understood as the obvious first, but deliberate step towards such ecumenical unity. It should not be formed to prevent any further wider unity, but to assure that the voice of the Lutheran Church will be strong and clear and that ecumenical unity is established on the unshakable basis of God's Holy Word and without compromise on matters of faith and conscience.

It is felt that the common tasks of a United Evangelical-Lutheran Church in India will grow with the years to come and will necessitate and produce organically the necessary constitutional arrangements. It will therefore be wise to interfere as little as possible with the present internal and financial administration of the constituent churches.

For this reason it is suggested to follow the constitution of the F.E.L.C. wherever possible, notably in the following points: 1. Basis of faith, 2. Objects, 3. Registration under the Societies Act, 4. Conference, Executive Council and Committees as administrative organs, 5. Four office-bearers, viz. President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

The name of the United Ev.-Luth. Church should be as short and clear as possible. Suggested "The India's Evangelical-Lutheran Church" (I.E.L.C.) in analogy to Andhra E.L.C., Santal E.L.C., Jeypore E.L.C. etc.

- The common tasks of the I.E.L.C. Suggested are
1. All objects and aims of the F.E.L.C.
 2. Representation of the Lutheran Church in future negotiations for wider ecumenical unity with Non-Lutheran Churches. The Lutherans should speak with one voice as one church because they are essentially one in faith and doctrine.
 3. Care for a more uniform thorough theological education of Lutheran pastors and educationists. This would find concrete expression in the establishment of a common Lutheran Theological Faculty for advanced studies and research work and in the participation of the President in final theological examinations and the ordination of pastors.
 4. The evangelistic missionary activity of the church, i.e. care for the N.L.M. as the recognized evangelistic agency of the church.
 5. Representation of the Lutheran Church in India before the Lutheran World Federation, the World Council of Churches, the National Christian Council etc.
 6. Care for the Indian Lutheran Churches in distress and need.
 7. If the uniting churches desire so representation of the I.E.L.C. and its component parts before Government and before Mission Boards abroad.
 8. Advice and aid regarding sending and exchanging missionaries from the West.
 9. The question has been raised whether the I.E.L.C. might not serve as an advisory body or even as a Board of Arbitration or Court of Appeal in internal difficulties in one or the other of the unit

Missionary & I.E.L.C.

Handwritten notes: The President should for the time being be honorary, preferably the President of one of the sister churches (changing every three or four years; see below). His tasks would be: Chairmanship in all meetings of the Conference and Executive Council; all correspondence with churches and organizations abroad; representation of the I.E.L.C. before all Non-Luth. churches and organizations in India; ex-officio member on all boards of Examiners for final theological examinations; standing invitation for all colloquia and ordinations; chairmanship of the Committee on Subsidized Churches; he will receive the annual reports of the member churches and forward them to the Secretary for preparation of the consolidated annual report of the I.E.L.C.

The Secretary should be full-time paid worker. His tasks would be: The office of the I.E.L.C.; archiv; all correspondence inside India with Lutheran and Non-Lutheran churches and organizations; extensive travelling to maintain personal contact with the different churches and to promote the missionary work, the youth work and the literary activities of the I.E.L.C.; co-ordination of all committee-work; preparation of the annual report. - His budget would be approximately Rs 7300/- per annum (Salary and Provident Fund Rs 300 p.m.; house-rent Rs 50/-; Travelling and bhatta Rs 150/-; office and clerk's quarters Rs 45/-; clerk Rs 75/-; Postage and Stationery Rs 30/-; total p.m. Rs 650/-).

The Treasurer would be honorary for the time being and have the same work as the present Treasurer of the I.E.L.C.

The income of the I.E.L.C. would be secured most equally and justly if a certain percentage (1/2% or 1%) of the budget of the individual churches and their co-operating missions (eccl. missionaries' personal budget, medical work and arts' colleges) would go to the central treasury.

The possibility and advisability of a subdivision into two regional conferences (North and South) should be earnestly considered. Such subdivision would mean that the regional synod (or conference) would meet every second year and that the general synod (or conference) would gather every fourth year and that the term of the office-bearers would consequently have to be prolonged to 4 years.

For the future a subdivision of the I.E.L.C. into 5 or 6 dioceses with a Bishop for each should be considered. The Bishops' task would be the spiritual leadership of the diocese and the pastoral care of the workers (and congregations). The administrative functions would in this case remain with the office-bearers (mainly the President).

A greater pooling of resources would ensue in the same degree in which the common tasks of the I.E.L.C. will grow and should be kept in mind as a possibility and necessity for the future.



The amended and approved proposals of function of Dr.J.Roy Strock, as circulated to the Ilaka Chairmen and the Parish Chairmen of the Gossner Church on 24/27 October, 1947 is enclosed herewith.

Whereas Dr. Strock must be in intimate touch with things in the Gossner Church to be able to make minute study of situation in different spheres of the Church's activities in order to suggest improvements, for which he has been called.

But whereas Dr. Strock, like any other foreign Missionary, under the terms of reference, should not fill any administrative position in the Church, so that the Autonomy of the Church remain inviolate which to defend and strengthen is his chief concern, it is resolved that Dr. Strock's designations should be as follows and that his duties shall be as under :-

" Adviser of Budgets, Property, General Finance and Stewardship and Inspector of Church Schools."

D U T I E S.

1. To check all items of expenditure under both the Church Treasury and the Property Board before they are passed by the final authorities.
2. To check all contracts, both new ones and renewals before they are placed before the Board.
3. To prepare, in co-operation with the Treasurer, the annual budget for presentation to the Officers and the Church Council, and, in consultation with the Treasurer, to prepare recommendations for the Church Council in respect of alterations in the budget during the course of the year.
4. To assist in carrying out, after consultation with the Treasurer and for the Secretary of the Property Board, all resolutions pertaining to accounts connected with the central Treasury, the Property Board, departments, Ilakas or Institutions, and to suggest schemes for the more profitable use of the Property of the Church.
5. To promote, in consultation with the Ilakas and in all possible ways, the practice of Christian stewardship throughout the Church, and to assist the Ilakas to find ways and means for supporting adequately the work of the G.E.L. Church as a whole, especially Church institutions like the Theological Seminary, Training Classes for Pracharakas and Pracharikas, and Training Schools for Teachers (for men and women), Church Publications, Provident Funds and Pensions Transfer charges of Pastors, Candidates and other workers, expenses connected with external bodies like the Federation, B.C.C., Etc., etc.
6. To inspect Church Schools of all kinds and grades as opportunity arises, with a view to the making of recommendations concerning their improvement to the various authorities maintaining them.

This arrangement shall hold good for three years from the time of its inception.




