being made from his salary on account of overpayment.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

AT KARIGIRI, near to Vellore, is situated the Schieffelin Leprosy Research Sanatorium. Although still only a young institution it is rapidly establishing for itself high traditions, one of which is the annual exhibition when friends from outside have an opportunity to see for themselves something of the work that is being done. The theme of the last exhibition was: "Leprosy Is Your Responsibility." That is a theme that the Christian Church as a whole could take to heart.

It was in 1874 that The Mission to Lepers was founded, and ever since then, as an international and interdenominational society, it has been used of God to accomplish in His Name great things for those suffering from leprosy. It is not exaggeration to say that, among other things, the Mission has been used to put the leprosy problem in India and Pakistan into focus. The work of the Mission began in this land, and it is fitting that this sub-continent is still the biggest field of its operations. Of recent years the Mission has had the joy of seeing Government and non-Government agencies enter into this service. To some that might appear to be reason, or excuse, for the Mission, and the Christian Church of whose world wide enterprise it forms a part, doing less. But the arrival of these new colleagues is properly regarded as a challenge to each member of the Church of Christ on earth to shoulder as never before his or her own responsibility.

For many a long year it seemed as if doing anti-leprosy work was like labouring in the darkest night. The discovery of the sulphone drugs, of the place and value of physiotherapy techniques and orthopaedic surgery, has changed all that, and to-day the sun of a new hope is shining. An air of great expectancy is abroad. How tragic it would be if the Christian Church were not to rise to the responsibilities that this increase in knowledge brings. It would be a betrayal of Him whose name we bear, and who, so many years ago,

looked with compassion on one stricken with the disease, took hold of him, and in reply to his request said: "I will; be thou clean."

From very small beginnings the work of the Mission has grown until to-day it is to be found in over twenty different countries, and is being done in co-operation with many different branches of the Protestant Church. Although much has been done, and for that we praise and thank God, much still remains to be done. It is to that unfinished task that the Church must continue to address itself. The statistics given on the last page of this leaflet tell their own tale of what the Mission has done throughout another year in India, Pakistan and Burma. But they do not tell of the multitudes of the estimated two millions of sufferers from this disease in these lands for whom, as yet, little, if anything, has been possible.

Our cover picture shows a patient at the Mission's Home at Belgaum. Engaged in completing a piece of excellent embroidery she represents untold numbers of those who not only need medical treatment and spiritual strength and comfort, but who are also anxious to get well and take up once more their wonted place in life.

The Church's responsibility, as it is invited to share in the observance of the 14th Sunday after Trinity, September 7th, 1958, as Leprosy Sunday, is to see that everything possible is done to take physical, mental and spiritual succour and healing to all in this great need.

Will you, as a member of that Church, shoulder your own part of this responsibility by giving of yourself, your material means and your prayers? As you do, and as you get to know more the people who need your help, the sense of privilege in being able to help them will join that of responsibility.

100 Years death Anniversary of Father Gossner Impressive Ceremony at Ranchi.

Ranchi, March 31,1958.

On Palm Sunday (March 30) over 2 lakh Christians of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in India celebrated the 100 years death anniversary of Father Johaness Evangelista Gossner, the man who during his life time sent out from Germany 140 missionaries throughout the world and sustained their work through incessant prayers. The Gossner Evangelical Lutheran fruit Church of North East India is the first of his prayers.

Father Gossner was born on 14th Dec:1773 in a Catholic family of Hausen, Bavaria. Through Confession at an early age he expressed his desire to be a priest and became a Roman Catholic Father. He preached the true and pure Gospel of the Bible inspite of persecutions from the Roman Church and finally became a protestant Pastor in Berlin. Till his death on 30th March 1858 he served in the Bethlehem Church in Berlin and established several Charitable institutions.

The Lutheran Congregation at Ranchi assembled before the Memorial Stone - where the first 4 Gossner's missionaries pitched their tents - formed into a long procession which mended its way to the oldest church building in Chotanagpur -the Christ Church. Rolding Hundreds of children with palm branches headed the procession in which the Master entered Jerusalem before his Crucifixion. The President Rev.J.J.P.Tiga preached in the Church which was packed to its capacity with many standing outside.

"Remember them " he read from the Scripture, which have the rule over you, who have spoken un to you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation. Jesus Christ the same yesterday and today, and for ever. "He said "Christ is the hope of the World and so we pray and work that His Kingdom come. We have take the Gospel to every one and bring him to the Cross of Calvary. Every sould must be won for Christ."

Later in the evening before a long gathering Dr.M.Bage extensively spoke on the life and work of Father Gossner.

Bishop Dilbar Hans of the Diocese of Chotanagpur said: "God works and no one ever could stop Him. In His great purpose we come as partners. If we, as commanded do not give ourselves for His work then stones and mountains will raise up. " Paying homage to Father Gossner he asked the congregation to accept the challenge of evangelisation and said: "the Kingdom of God has to come however we wish otherwise, for which, one should surrender and pray incessantl like Father Gossner."

We are writing to you about us from one of your Pastors, namely Rev. C.H. Tirki of G.E.L. Church, Lohardaga to whom we sent tablets of Cholera and Soda Mint worth Ps 27.25 on the 16th of June 1956. We have sent him five reminders since then but he has refused to pay the amount, Wexeingexthatxtime We have since that time had orders for drugs from Rev. I. Bara of Lohardaga and from Rev. E. Ekka of Jhiko Chatti P.O., but have been forced to refuse to send them medicines since we are unable to collect the amount from Rev. Tirki. Rev. Ekka g has asked us to contact your goodself and we trust it will be possible for you to take some action so that the amount may be settled at an early date. We deal only with Mission Institutions and would point out that it is very seldom that our bills are not paid in due course. It has now been fifteen months since we sent the medicines and the bill is not very large so we trust you will be able to persuade Rev. Tirki to settle the amount at an early date.

To Members, supporters, well-wishers.

My dear brethren and friends in Christ.

Greetings in the dear name of Jesus. Since I wrote last during Christmas many things have happened in the world, in our country and also in anahumble Fellowship. I have tried to give some news through correspondences and the Seeker. The political sky of the world is dark with clouds of bursting Hell-Bombs, cold war, colonial repression, economic and military imperialism, mutual mistrust and hate. The pitv is that countries, that regard themselves as Christian and have sent thousands of missionaries with millions of dollars and pounds to Asia and Africa to convert "heathens", excel in these evils. That is the more reason why Indian Christians should give up their connections with foreign mission systems, and, as followers of Jesus Christ, should fully support the national and foreign policies of India - the land of Gautama Buddha, Shree Chaitanya and Gandhi - seeking the way of peace and toleration. May God give us grace and courage to walk in the foot-steps of Jesus - the Incarnation of Truth and Love.

The targetof one thousand personal members for the Fellowship is not anywhere near being reached. It indicates that all of us have not seriously tried to enrol new members through quiet propaganda. Some of you have Sangha Receipt Books. I shall be glad to receive any sums collected. Some of you have not paid your personal membership or church affiliation fees for 1957 which should have been done by 31st March. Please look into this matter. If we get an adequate yearly income we can meet all our expenses including some help to our poorer voluntary workers.

I am trying to arrange a Retreat Conference at St. Stephen's Church, Dum Dum, Calcutta for a week or ten days of intensive praver, study and thinking, of important decision and work between 22nd. and 31st August, 1957. Please write and say how many of you will be able to come and meet your travel expense and meals charge of Re.1/- daily?

Since February I have travelled far and wide in the country touching centres in Bengal, Calcutta, Orissa, Madras, Tirupattur, Poona, Matheran, Bombay and Ranchi. You will be interested to know that the Puri Ashram is going to be taken over by the N.M.S. and we expect to have a share in its conduct. It is also hoped that Sadhu Sircar will be accepted as an Hon. Missionary. In Bombay and Poona my contacts with the National Church leaders were helpful. At Matheran I was able to put the national church point of view before 25 leaders of churches through my paper on the "Indigenisation of Christian Worship in India". In the month of March at Calcutta there was a Nations ist Christians Conference with your Palak Pramukh presiding and the very Rev. Dr. J.S. Williams as the main speaker. We had a nice little ceremony at which Bro. Williams invested the orgained ministers of the Sangha with sandal wood Crosses made and donated by Brc. Biren, Falak of Bolpur Khristiya Mandali, who is in charge of the Jarpentry Department of Shantiniketan. In this meeting a Resolution was passed to the effect that Government should recognise the claim of the National Church in respect of advice in the appointment of

teachers and priests to military churches. The Governor of Bengal - Shreemati Padmaia Naidu graciously granted an interview to seven leaders of independent indigenous churches. She heard with interest the story of the National Church in its struggle for independence of Indian Christians from the foreign mission planted denominations and also expressed her readiness to read the Seeker. Before this we had gone to Kharapara Mahamaya - a village 24 miles south of Calcutta where we were invited to participate in the deliberations of the independent 24 Parganas Baptist Sammilani. This summer I was in Ranchi for 6 weeks, made useful contacts with old students and friends - Hindu and Christian - and was able to sell some Bibles and N.T.'s. Here I discovered an interesting Institution called N.T.'s. Dhunkuria Cultural School and an independent group of Adibasi Their aim is to preserve Adibasi cul-Christians around it. ture and educate children through play, song, dance and activity. Shall we remember in prayer the Founder-Principal -Shreeman M.D.Julius Tiga B.A. and his seven assistants who have been struggling for lack of enough funds and against the indifference of the church.

While at Ranchi I had a mild attack of Influenza and a rather severe one of Gastritis so I have come back very weak,

While I write of Ranchi I must ask you to prav for our very dear friend and brother Premananda Anathnath (the Rev. P.A.N.Sen - VIM.C.A. Secretary, C.M.S. Missionary and Founder of Anugrihita Home of Rest for women). He is over 80 and suffers from infirmities of old age. He is sitting in his Ashram and looks like an Indian Rishi and he is one. May God grant him peace and joy while he waits in patience. Read his autobiography. We must also remember our brother - Joel (the Rev. J. Lakra M.A., B.D., S.T.M. late President - Lutheran Church and Principal of their Theological College) who has been in deep waters for nearly a year owing to sad cuarrels among the leaders due to jealousy, pride, selfishness - foreign money. There is a ray of hope that the situation will be soon relieved.

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

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

The Mission to Lepers

founded in 1874, is an Interdenominational and International Society engaged solely in work among sufferers from leprosy and their children.

Its Object.

To preach the Gospel to the sufferers from leprosy and to provide them with shelter, food, clothing and medical treatment; to rescue their healthy children; and to help to bring about the extinction of leprosy.

The Means Used.

The Mission establishes and maintains Homes or other institutions for sufferers from leprosy where the inmates are provided with Christian instruction and receive medical care.

It establishes and maintains, under Christian management, homes for the healthy children of patients.

It also makes grants in aid of other homes and institutions for leprosy work carried on under Christian auspices; and it

Provides for Christian teaching and worship in government and other leprosy institutions in the administration of which it has no responsibility.

In India Pakistan and Burma.

In the Mission's own Homes in India, Pakistan and Burma provision is made for over 5,400 of the adult patients and for over 700 of the child patients mentioned above. Over another 2,000 adults and nearly 300 children are also provided for in Homes in these lands which the Mission aids.

More than 650 healthy children of parents who have leprosy are cared for in separate homes attached to some of these institutions, and are thus given the chance to grow up into sturdy, independent citizens.

In addition, some 15,000 patients, both adult and child, are treated annually at out-patient clinics.


The Present Opportunity.

The work was never so full of hope as to-day. Large numbers of sufferers in all stages of the disease are daily seeking out help, and there are constant opportunities for extending the work as funds and circumstances permit.

Method of Working.

The Mission works in co-operation with Protestant missionary societies—Commonwealth, American and European. Missionaries of these societies are the honorary superintendents of the Mission's work.

The Extent of Leprosy in the World.

It is impossible to state with any degree of accuracy how many sufferers there are in the world today, but there must be at least five millions. Many thousands are destitute and hopeless sufferers who need Christian care and shelter as well as physical relief. Large numbers are in the earlier stages of the disease and would benefit greatly from medical treatment if it could be made available to them.

The Appeal of the Gospel.

No class of people is more responsive to the preaching of the Gospel. A large number of the inmates of our various institutions have become Christians and show by their daily life and conduct the work of grace in them.

Leprosy Treatment.

The latest methods of treatment are having encouraging results, and many cases show marked improvement. Hundreds have been sent out free from all active symptoms of the disease. Many who have come to our Homes are so maimed by leprosy that although they have benefited by treatment they will continue to need Christian care. The success of the Sulphone drugs during the last decade gives more hope than at any previous time.

The Healthy Children.

The disease is not hereditary. A very important part of the Mission's work therefore, is the rescuing of healthy children of parents with leprosy and bringing them up in separate homes. Infected children are being given the new medical treatment under which some are making wonderful recoveries.

Existing Work.

The Mission is now working at 104 stations in 21 different countries.

In its own Homes there are at the present time about 7,000 patients and children, and in the aided institutions about 9,500. All these need constant support and Christian care.

Altogether there are over 5,400 Christians at the above stations.

The Mission is also providing Christian worship and teaching at Government and other public institutions where such provision is not otherwise made.

THE MISSION TO LEPERS

(FOUNDED 1874)

More than eighty years after its establishment the main field of the activities of The Mission to Lepers is India. It is very appropriate that this should be so because it was started by a man who was called to service among those whom he saw suffering from leprosy in this land.

Wellesley Cosby Bailey, an Irishman, came to India in 1869 intending to join the Indian Police. While learning Hindi he lived with his brother, an army officer, who was stationed at Faizabad in Uttar Pradesh. On the transfer of his brother to Europe he went to reside with a German of the Church Missionary Society. It was as a result of this close contact with missionary work that, even though he had passed his first Hindi examination and his name was on Sir W. Muir's list for an early appointment with the North-West Police, he decided to become a missionary instead of a police officer.

Towards the end of 1869 he moved to Ambala to work with the American Presbyterian Mission, and it was there that he saw the small group of leprosy patients, the sight of which stirred his soul and led him to his real life's work.

On furlough in Ireland in 1874 he told some of his friends of the work he was doing among those suffering from leprosy, and they promised to collect or give £30 every year to support it. At the end of the first year the promised £30 had become over £500; at the end of the second, contributions amounted to £809. On his return to India after furlough Mr. Bailey worked at Chamba with the Church of Scotland Missionary Society, and from the spare funds at his disposal was able to make a beginning in helping others who were engaged in anti-leprosy work.

From such small beginnings, conceived, cradled and nurtured in prayer, the work of the Mission has continued to grow until today it can be found in many widely scattered countries. It is international and interdenominational in character and, within the limits of its resources, it ministers to all who need its help irrespective of caste, class or creed.

In India, Pakistan and Burma in 1954 there were over 9000 adult patients, over 1200 child patients, and over 600 healthy children of parents with leprosy in institutions owned or aided by the Mission.





The conference is likely to continue on 6th November also. The time of the subsequent sittings will be announced at the Conference.

The Conference will discuss specific problems of Chotanagpur concerning Agriculture. A copy of the Minutes of the Minister Agriculture on the Agricultural problems is enclosed herewith.

It is regretted that it will not be possible to pay the travelling allowance to the invitees or to arrange for their boarding and lodging at Ranchi. In view of the importance of this conference, it is hoped that you will attend the meetings despite the inconveniences involved.

Note relating to agricultural problems to Chotanagpur to be discussed at the proposed conference to be held by the Agriculture Minister.

Chhotanagpur area of Bihar needs special attention in respect of its agricultural problems. Its topographical condition is hilly and there are shallow valleys with patches of flat lands. The rainfall conditions are guite satisfactory but owing to hilly and undulating nature of land the rainfall waters are quickly washed away and after Kharif crops the moisture is not left in the land and wherever it is available it is not utilised for rabi crops for various reasons; one of the reasons being that cattles are let loose by their owners and the stray animals graze the crops in those places where the cultivators venture to grow rabi crops in their lands. The lands are also deficient in organic matter and the nature of crops grown are mostly paddy crops (summer paddy as well as Aghani paddy). The by-product of paddy crop, viz. the straw is the main stay as food for Chhotanagpur cattle specially after the rainy season. The cattle of Chhotanagpur are stunted in growth and not useful for milch conditions and are very poor for draft purposes. This is due to insufficient fodder as well as insufficient period of grazing available in unreserved forests area. After paddy crop, cultivators do not sow Khesari or other pulses for the reasons given above and this adversely affects the soil which otherwise world benefit from growing of leguminous crops. Absence of this also affects the health of the cattle of this region. Leguminous types of green fodder provide protein as well as required proportion of vitamin as well as mineral matter. There is no recognised breed of cattle in Chhotanagpur and whatever the department has been doing is very negligible.

2. The specific problems of Chotanagpur concerning

Agricul s follows:-

- (i) Increasing the area under irrigation by constructing medium irrigation schemes, minor irrigation schemes and wells. There are innumerable rivulets in Chhotanagpur, water of which flows down to the plains and thus the lands of Chotanagour are deprived of irrigation although there is sufficient rainfall. The water can be utilised by means of medium irrigation schemes and minor irrigation schemes. The construction of wells in Chhotanagpur is very costly and it would not be possible to irrigate lands by means of wells except in those places where the land is not rocky and so we have to fall upon medium irrigation and minor irrigation schemes. For purposes of increasing cultivation of vegetables it may be necessary to sink wells throughout Chotanagpur but as Government would be discontinuing subsidy such wells can be constructed by taking loans from Government and Cooperative Societies by the cultivators.
- (ii) Improving fertility of the soil by green manuring, green leaf manuring with jungle leaves, compost manufacture and use of fertilisers issued on credit, and by sowing Khesari and other pulses and leguminous crops.
- (iii) Preventing soil erosion by contour bundhing, and contour ploughing which have to be adopted by the cultivators. Plugging of gullies and growing of crops which reduce erosion have to be advocated.

 Selected public workers can be trained up in this work by the Department of Agficulture. The cultivators will have to be persuaded to allow constructions of contour bundhs disregarding its effect on their present boundaries of fields.
 - (iv) Increasing the areas under double cropping by

by raising rabi and summer crops under appropriate conditions.

As noted above, stray cattle is an important cause of not allowing the people to have double crop. The Cattle Tresspass Act has not been helpful in checking this menace. The question of amending this Act by enhancing the punishment etc. is under consideration but it is doubtful even this will help in controlling the stray cattle. The prevention of grazing by cattle can be effected only by joint village action. Some other remedies may be as follows :-

- (a) Consolidation of village holdings by mutual exchange to make compact blocks or else cooperative efforts on the part of cultivators to make compact blocks of 10 to 20 acres and fence them with cactus plants of the type which grow erect (not the hand palm type).
- (b) Growing hedge of Acacia Australia which does not spoil the land nor shades the land.
- (c) Construction of Bandhs for catchment of water, which would percolate in the adjoining steps for growing of rabi crops or for using it for irrigation water.

. The people of Chotanagpur also do not know the methods for growing rabi and summer crops. It will be necessary to teach them methods for growing rabi and summer crops and issue adequate quantity of rabi crops.

Introduction of cultivation of cash crops (V) like groundnut, cotton and vegetables to provide the funds required for developing agriculture.

This will require teaching of methods of raising new crops, supply and multiplication of seeds and organisation of orderly marketing. Chotanagpur is deficient in money crops unlike rest of Bihar. Groundnut, potatoes and vegetables like early tomato, early cauliflower and french beans are good money crops. It is also necessary to encourage the cultivation of sweet potato so that supplementary food is available for the people. The cultivation of orange in Palamau has to be pushed up so that the State becomes independent of imported orgnges and at the same time the cultivators are able to have some money for developing their agriculture. Propaganda has to be made for all these things and also for plantating quick growing fruit trees such as guava, papaya etc. Development of fruit agriculture will provide health promoting diet and alternative profitable occupations. This will no doubt, require establishment of nursery for supplying seedlings of guava, papaya, banana, lime, oranges and peaches. It will also be necessary to make provision for loans for sinking irrigation wells and establishing orchards for rapid development.

(vi) Promotion of Japanese Method of Paddy Cultivation on a large scale. As noted above, the principal crop of Chotanagpur is paddy and it is necessary that its yield should be increased considerably. This can be done by teaching Japanese Method of Paddy Cultivation which involves using improved seeds, fertilisers and improved method of agricultural practices. Limited stocks of improved paddy seeds are available and we cannot hope to cover large acreage within the next two years with the improved variety of paddy. There is, however, no reason why large scale adoption of Japanese Method of Paddy Cultivation and large scale of green

manuring, green leaf manuring with jungle leaves cannot be carried out in this region. The ways and means have to be devised for reaching this message to every cultivator and for providing necessary credit for the fertilizer to be used for the production of paddy.

Arrangements has also to be made for the training programme in every Sub-divisions, Thanas and villages for the Japanese Method of Cultivation.

- (vi) Improvement of breed of cattle. It is necessary to start artificial Insemination Centres and to distribute Stud bulls in the interior. Stray bulls of inferior type will have to be castrated and propaganda for keeping lesser number of cattle than is actually required so as to enable the people to feed their animals with proper foods will have to be done.
- 3. The problems stated above cannot be tackled by the Government machinery alone . They are already doing whatever is possible but to have rapid progress it is necessary to build up a suitable machinery for public workers to execute the plan which should be independent of the Government machinery. The pace of progress can be quickened only if voluntary public workers came forward for giving help in the matter. The Agricultural staff will, no doubt, give them necessary training and technical advice. Non-official organisation for the whole of Chotanggpur area should be set up and every public worker should prepare a plan for his area and submit it to the Divisional Board to be established for securing necessary financial assistance. The Cooperative Societies will have to be strengthened and this cannot be done except with the help of public workers. In short, the special problem of Chotanagpur can be tackled with the help of the staff of the various developmental departments of Government as well as voluntary public workers. The advice of the conference is solicited on the points stated above.





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Report of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in Chotanagpur and Assam, Ranchi

Autonomy Day July 10, 1954.

The Gossner Missionary Society of Berlin sent four Missionaries to Ranchi in 1845, who were the pioneers of the Mission work in this part of India. Later more Missionaries were added to the staff, all having been sent by the same Mission. Five long years were without any tangible result when the Missionaries decided to leave the field as a result of disappointment. But Father Gossner the founder of the Mission insisted upon continuing the work in this country among the so called Adibasis, not leaving out the non-Adibasis from the influence of the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Thus the Missionaries continued to work here in spite of the apparent failure. At last four Uraons who had adopted Kabir Panth as their religion became enquirers and after proper instruction they were baptised on the 9th June 1850. This was the beginning of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in Chotanagour and Assam.

The small Church began to grow by leaps and bounds, although there were so many obstacles and impediments. The Missionaries opened schools for boys and girls and compelled the Christian children to come to school. Yet it was not an easy job to get good attendence. Each child was paid one anna at the end of the week if his or her attendence was good. Thus with great difficulty the first Christians were taught to come to school.

Two German Missionaries were engaged in the study of native medicines and they learnt to recognise medicinal herbs and plants of the jungle. Instead of allopathic medicine, they were using the native

the native medicines for the treatment of the sick and the suffering. Later on they sent some wakkdraw Christian young men to Agra medical school and prepared allopathic doctors.

Some Mission Stations were opened in four districts of the Chotanagour Division viz. Ranchi, Hazaribagh, Chaibassa and Purulia and the work was started also the Dist. of Palamau. In Purulia a Leper Colony was established which was developed to be one of the largest, if not the largest Leper Colony of India.

The Chotanagpur Labour was considered to be among the best for the Tea Gardens of Assam and Duars. Thus the Chotanagpur Christians reached those Tea Gardens and the Gossner Mission work spread in Assam but till recent years the Duars area was looked after by the Scotch Mission. But now the Gossner Autonomous Church is working vigorously in Duars in North Bengal. Thus very early three states viz. Bengal, Bihar and Assam were brought within the sphere of the Gossner Missionary Society.

The Mission work was also started in the Eastern States of Gangpur, Banai and Banra now merged into the Orissa State. The work flourished here too. At present over 40,000 of our Christians are within the State of Orissa. Our work in Orissa has been specially appreciated by the Govt. of Orissa which they have promite by granting Rs. 10,000/- to build a Church at Sundargarh which we consecrated only in the month of March this year. The Orissa Government have also kindly granted over 22 acres of land last year in the former State of Banra now a part of Sambalpur District, and we are building there a Hospital in a most inaccessible place away from civilization.

The Mission work spread in the west as far as Jashpur State now merged into Madhya Pradesh. The work here also flourished and now it has entered the former State of Udaipur now merged into the Raigarh District. Also the Pastors and evangelists of this Church are doing evangelistic work in Surguja and Korea now merged into Madhya Pradesh.

Thus the little beginning made with four families in 1850 grew and spread over five present States and so our sphere of work comprises almost the whole North India. In the meantime other Missions made their appearance at Ranchi. The Society for the Propagation of the Gospel (S.P.G.Mission) from England, started work in 1869 and spread its activity all over Chotanagpur. The Roman Catholic Mission largely from Belghum arrived as lete as 1885 and made a very rapid progress. The Seventh Day Advantist Mission of America came last in 1916 and has stayed here.

In 1914 the first World War was started and Germany being the leading enemy country all the German Missionaries were repatriated by then British Govt. At that time the Lutheran Christians numbered about one lakh to be more correct, 97000 souls. The situation caused a real trial of the Church. All help coming from Germany stopped and all the Mission workers were plunged into untold suffering. It was a trial of faith, in which the Lutheran Christians proved the reality of their religion. There were so many kantation temptations which presented grievous situations so as to fall away from the path they had pursued thus far. But things apritimate spiritual prevailed from things material. The people understood what Christianity meant. Christ has said, " In the world ye shall have tribulations but be of good cheers I have overcome the world" (John 16.33). This and other such promises of our Lord Jesus Christ were realised by the Christians and they stood firm in the faith. Thus the faith of this Church is a tried faith.

In this faith the bearth of Autonomy. It was realisation of the truth of Christianity owning Christ as the Saviour from sin and svil, accepting Him as the giver of salvation and life and this realisation as self-determined out of free choice and will without any outside influence or incouragement but guided and directed solely by one's own personal experience and knowledge. This is the ground of the Autonomy of this Church. The truth of Christian nity is held irrespective of foreign personnal or foreign money. In other words the basis of the truth of Christianity is Christ Himself and no other person or matter.

The above described feith is indistructible and it will form its own body wherever it exits. Accordingly on the 10th of July, 1919 an indigenous Church was established here to preserve, maintain and perpetuate this faith. This Church is named the Cossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in Chotanagpur and Assam. A constitution was drawn up and was registered at Patna in 1921. The Constitution provides for the three Officesbearers, the President, Secretary and the Treasurer with an Executive body called Church Council consisting of 30 members who are representatives of the different Synods into which the Church is divided. There is a Mahasabha constituted by the delegates coming from all Synods of the Church. This is the legislative body of the Church, sits once in two years and chalks out a programme for the Church Council. The Church is affiliated to the Federation of the Lutheran Churches in India and also to the Lutheran World Federation, the headquarters being at Geneva.

According to the Constitution the Church can utilise the services of foreign Missionaries, but the foreign Missionaries can not fill up administration positions which we reserved only for the Indians. The Church Council the administrative body is and will always be purely Indian.

The Church stands only for religion. As our Gevt. is purely secular, so this Church his purely religious. But as the State has good religious men and women, so the Church has men and women with political thoughts and ideals having godly fear and hely life as the back ground.

The Church teaches that Jesus Christ is the Saviour of mankin d from Mar sin granting forgivness of sin to every believer and reconciling him with God the Father and in so doing starting a new life in the individual which is the spiritual life in God. The individual thus becomes a new man with his thoughts words and deeds uplifted and ennobled which hefits a godly man. So Christinehity is not a system of teaching or doctrine, not a philosophy of life or a Science of living, not even a set of moral teaching whatever may be the height depth of such teaching but Christianity is Christ

Eimself as the transforming Power of human life from sin to righteeusness from bad to good from mundame to devine, from vileness to holiness. Thus the whole business of the Church is to present Christ to the world to the shole humanity as the transforming
Power for the good of the muman race. This act of presenting Christ
is called preaching of the good news or evagelism.

This Autonomous Church has been in existence since the 10th of July 1919 and she has done very well during the last 35 years. She has doubled her etrength, the present member being very nearly 200,000. From 1845 to 1941 there was only on Eigh School in the whole field. Since 1942 we have started 12 more High Schools which are equally open to Christians and non-Christians, Managous primay and Middle Schools are being maintained by the Church through out her area equally open to all. The whole Bible has been trans-Lated into Urson Language by this Church and it is being translated into Kharia now, Sundrede of religious hymns and bhajans have been composed and published in Munderi, Uraen and Kharis, Missionaries have been sent out to Surguja Vasipur. Sores and Jashpur in the west and to Sundargarn, Bansi, Banra, Moyurbhan j and Recogher in the South In doing so the Church is trying to fulfil the Command of her lord Who said, " do ye, therefore and teach all nations, baptising them I in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Boly Thost. teaching them to observe all things whatenever I have ammended you and lo, I om with you always even unto the end of the world. (Mathew 28, 19-20)

The above is a short story of the indigenous Church of wide we observe to day the Day of Autonomy. It may not mean any thing to many people but to the Intherens of the Course church it is a most memorable in the history of the Church and every year as it comes and goes it brings a new life and a new determination to live up to the faith they hold so dear.



ASSAM. (Founded 1845 - Autonomy declared on 10 th July, 1919)

The activities of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in Chotanagpur and Assam, as an autonomous church is spread in the five states of the Indian Union, viz., Bihar, Orissa, Madhya Pradesh, Bengal and Assam.

This church is using 9 different tribal and other languages to disseminate the Word of God. Bible in Mundari and Oraon are used throughout the country. Translation of the Bible in Kharia is being done. So far the Gospel according to St. John has been printed in

the Kharia language.

There are 15 Synods, each under one Synod Council presided by the Synod President. In addition to it there are several Mission fields spread over the former chotanagpur states viz., Keonjhar, Bonai Bamra, Gangpur and in the district of Singbhum. Mission fields are looked after by a body called Joint Mission Board in which the Home Board of the Gossner Missionary Society, Berlin and the G.E.L. Church co-operate. There is Surguja Field where the Word of God is being preached by the Gossner workers under the auspices of the Surguja Board and the N.M.S.

The congregation at the Head Quarters of the G.E.L. Church is called the Head quarters Congregation which is directly under the management of the Church Council. Synods area have been given some powers which the Church Council formerly used to exercise. Church Council is the highest Executive body of the Mahasabha or the General Conference of the G.E.L. Church. The Mahasabha sits

biennially.
