Sir,

In continuation of this office No. 1864/42/F- 23, dated the 28/29th August, 1942 I have the honour to submit further documents showing the past relationship of the Church with the Managing Committee of the Gossner High School. All the documents prove that the Church has had the sole power to appoint the Principal of the School, and in other matters, the Church has had a large say and the Managing Committee depended on the Church for help and guidance almost in every respect.

Such cordial relationship between the Church and the Managing Committee cannot be restored so long as the present management of the School is there. At present the management has completely non-cooperated with the Church.

Therefore in order to bring about a cordial relationship between the Church and the Managing Committee it is respectfully requested :

1. That Messrs. A. L. Tirkey and P. K. Choudhery, the so called Principal and Headmaster of the Gossner High School may be removed from the School immediately.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that in continuation to my letter No. 1864/42/F- 23 dated the 28th/29th August, 1942 and the copies of documents despatched along with it, which you have received on the 31st August 1942; I have despatched another letter No. 2005-2006/42/F- 23 dated the 11th September 1942 together with copies of further documents. The second despatch was also under an acknowledgement register cover, but, I have not yet received the acknowledgement till now. May I therefore request you to be so kind as to inform me whether it has reached you or not.

I may also add, that recently I have been informed that in the Memoranda of the grant-in-aid for the Gossner High School, the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church or the Board of Trustees of the Gossner Church Properties is given as ^{the Proprietor of the said school} If, so, then in either case the Proprietor is the said Church, and the Managing ^{hence} Committee of the Gossner High School, itself, admits that the Managing Committee is not the proprietor of the School.

The Managing Committee is the Manager of the said school, for, and, on behalf of, the Proprietor which is the said Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church. If honestly is there, the Managing

Managing Committee cannot but do the wish of the Church in the appointment of the Principal of the said School, specially when the Church repeatedly since 1940 have considered this question and Mr. J. Earla is designated to fill up the post of Principalship of the school.

I may also request you to kindly confirm the statement which you and the Divisional Inspector of Schools had said in the course of our conversation on the 12th August 1942, at Ranchi, that Department have not accorded approval to the Constitutions, passed by the Mahasabha or the General Conference of the said Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in 1939, and submitted by the Managing Committee to the Department for approval in the same year; and as such the Church or its Executive the Church Council is not bound by it.

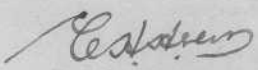

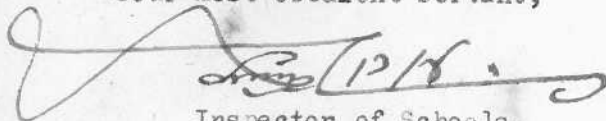

2. That the amended rules to conduct the Gossner High School as submitted to the Inspector of Schools, Chotanagpur Division on the 26th June, 1942 may kindly be approved. (A copy marked XIII attached)

3. That the present Managing Committee may kindly be replaced by the new as submitted to the Inspector of Schools, Chotanagpur Division on the 30th August, 1941. (A copy marked XIV attached, re-arranged according to the latest developments.)

It is believed that it now within your power and jurisdiction in the light of the mismanagement of various accounts in the School referred to above as recently discovered you will be in a position to give effect to the above, personally, without reference to the Board of Secondary Education.

The President of the Church and I would very much like to have an interciue with you on the above subject and would request you to kindly fix a time and place for the same.

RULES AS AMENDED AND SANCTIONED BY THE MAHASABHA OF THE G. E. L. CHURCH IN CHOTANAGPUR AND ASSAM IN ITS SESSIONS HELD AT BURJU, P. S. KHUNTI, DIST. RANCHI, FROM 27TH APRIL TO 30TH APRIL, 1942 FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE GOSSNER HIGH SCHOOL, RANCHI.

Applicable also to Tadenomura. ~~Applicable~~

(For the purpose of these Rules "Mahasabha" means the General Conference of the G. E. L. Church in Chotanagpur and Assam and "Church Council" means the Executive Body of the Mahasabha.)

1. Gossner High School has been founded by the G. E. L. Mission with the aim that Lutheran boys should receive a Christian Education in a Lutheran Institute. This aim remained unaltered when the G. E. L. Mission was succeeded by the G. E. L. Church in the ownership of Gossner High School. The G. E. L. Church has the right and the duty to see to it that this uppermost aim be attained.

2. The Managing Committee :- There shall be a Managing Committee for the Gossner High School as provided in the Education Code.

(a) The Constitution of the Committee :-

The Constitution of the Managing Committee shall be as follows :-

(b) Before asking the consent of the representatives of the special interests or communities to serve on the Managing Committee, the approval of the Church Council or of its Executive shall be secured to such representatives.

(c) The Church Council shall have the right to recall from the Managing Committee its representative or nominee who forfeits the confidence of the Church Council. The Church Council also may ask the removal of the member representing special community or interest if the Church Council will find it so desirable.

3. The appointment, discharge, dismissal, resignation and transfer :-

(a) The call and appointment, dismissal, discharge, resignation and transfer of the Principal-Headmaster shall lie with the Church Council. The Managing Committee will report the Council's action to the Government Authorities.

(b) The appointment, dismissal, discharge, resignations and transfers of members of the staff except as provided above in 3 (a) shall lie with the Managing Committee, but before taking any action the approval of the Church Council must be secured, each ~~case~~ case of vacancy must be at once intimated to the Church Council.

(c) The Church Council shall have the right to recommend to the Managing Committee any one for appointment, dismissal or discharge and the recommendation will hold good unless negatived by two-third votes of the members present at the Managing Committee meeting at which the matter is taken up.

1. Gossner High School has been founded by the G. E. I. Church in
Mission with the aim that Christian boys should receive a Christian
education in a Christian institution. This aim remained unaltered
when the school was succeeded by the G. E. I. Church in
the ownership of Gossner High School. The G. E. I. Church has the
right and the duty to see to it that this purpose is not lost.

2. The Managing Committee :- There shall be a Managing
Committee for the Gossner High School as provided in the Education
Code.

(a) The Constitution of the Committee :-

The Constitution of the Managing Committee shall be as
follows :-

- i. The Principal-Headmaster
- ii. The representative of the staff
- iii. A representative of the Church Council
- iv. A representative of the Government
- v. A representative of the community
- vi. A representative of special interest
- vii. A representative of the G. E. I. Church
- ix. The President of the G. E. I. Church

(b) Before asking the consent of the representatives of the
special interests or communities to serve on the Managing Committee,
the approval of the Church Council or of its Executive shall be
secured to each representative.

(c) The Church Council shall have the right to recall from
the Managing Committee its representative or nominee who forfeits
the confidence of the Church Council. The Church Council also may
ask the removal of the member representing special community or
interest if the Church Council will find it so desirable.

3. The appointment, discharge, dismissal, resignation and
transfer :-

(a) The call and appointment, discharge, dismissal, resignation
and transfer of the Principal-Headmaster shall lie with the
Church Council. The Managing Committee will report the Council's
action to the Government Authorities.

(b) The appointment, discharge, dismissal, resignation and
transfer of members of the staff except as provided above in 3 (a)
shall lie with the Managing Committee, but before taking any action
the approval of the Church Council must be secured, each member
case of vacancy must be at once intimated to the Church Council.

(c) The Church Council shall have the right to recommend to
the Managing Committee any one for appointment, discharge or dis-
missal and the recommendation will hold good unless negated by two-
third votes of the members present at the Managing Committee meeting
at which the matter is taken up.

(d) The Church Council may recommend to the Managing Committee transfer of High School teachers to a Middle School under the management of the Church and of the Middle School teachers to the High School, and the recommendation will hold good unless negatived by two-third votes of the members present at the meeting at which the matter is taken up.

(e) The Managing Committee may recommend to the Church Council the transfer of a High School teacher to a Middle School under the management of the Church and of the Middle School teacher to the High School.

(f) In any event of dispute, disagreement or protest regarding any appointment, dismissal, discharge, resignation or transfer, the decision of the Church Council shall be final.

4. Hostel :- There shall be a hostel attached to the Gossner High School under the supervision of a Superintendent and if necessary an Assistant Superintendent.

(a) The Superintendent of the Hostel shall be called appointed and if necessary discharged, dismissed or transferred by the Church Council.

(b) The Managing Committee may recommend to the Church Council the appointment, discharge, dismissal or transfer of a Superintendent of the Hostel.

5. The Finance :-

(a) The Final responsibility of the finance of the School shall lie with the Mahasabha of the G.E.L.Church and the Church Council shall act for the Mahasabha when the latter is not in session

(b) The Annual Budget of the School shall be submitted by the Managing Committee to the Church Council which will forward the same to the Mahasabha with its remarks for the final approval, but according to the circumstances the Church Council also can give the final approval to the Budget.

(c) A quarterly Statement of income and expenditure of the School and the Hostel shall be submitted by the Managing Committee and the Hostel Superintendent respectively to the Church Council.

(d) An Annual Statement of income and expenditure of the School and the hostel for the previous year shall be submitted by the Managing Committee to the Church Council which shall present the same to the Mahasabha.

6. Accommodation of the School and Hostel :-

(a) The G.E.L.Church shall set apart out of its property (buildings and grounds) for the adequate accommodation of the School and the Hostel. The Mahasabha shall be responsible for the repair and upkeep of this property. The amount set apart out of the Government Grant for Repair and Municipal Tax shall be contributed to the Repair and Tax Fund of the Church.

(b) The final Proprietary right and responsibility over the furniture of the School and the Hostel shall lie with the Church.

(c) The Staff quarters including the Principal's bungalow and out-houses shall be rented out by the Church as far as possible to the members of the Staff. The proceeds thus obtained shall be credited to the Repair and Tax Fund of the Church.

(d) If the property set apart for School and Hostel in part or in whole, is not used by the school, it shall automatically be at the disposal of the Church.

7. Amendment :- Save and except the above provisions the School will be administered according to the rules of the Education Code. Any addition or alteration to the above rules can be made only by the Mahasabha at the initiation of the Church Council. The Managing Committee may bring proposal for such additions or alterations through the Church Council.

Dear Sir,

I am glad to inform you that the Mahasabha Meetings ended peacefully on the 16th of April, 1937.

The Pastoral letter was read to the Mahasabha at the very beginning of the Session and the Mahasabah expressed deep sense of gratitude for the Boards's love and care for the Gossner Church in Chota Nagpur and Assam. The Mahasabha then standing greeted the Board with Yishusahay.

A representatives of the All India Lutheran Federation, Mr. J. D. Asirvadam was also present in the first two days' meetings of the Mahasabha and his coming to the Mahasabha was a blessing. There were no misunderstandings in the Mahasabha and all the business could be finished peacefully and within time.

I am sending a few extracts from the Proceedings of the Mahasabha and as they are self-explanatory I need not write on the subjects discussed. However I like to mention here that the Mahasabha unanimously invites you as president, to the Gossner field in Chota Nagpur and Assam. I shall try to send a copy of the Proceedings immediately ~~after they are printed~~ after they are printed; they have been sent to the Press.

The Church Council feeling the pressing need particularly at a moment when all the people desired it, resolved on 23-3-37 to appoint Dr. O. Wolff the Principal of the Gossner High School and he was appointed Principal the following day.
