Further to my discussion with you and Mr. S. Bhengra on 16th December 1969, I am now writing to confirm our conversation and to make some additional proposals:

- (1) As our 3 month basic course in Urban/Industrial Service, to be held from 4th Jan-20th March 1970 will be conducted in English (and it will not be possible this year to have a Hindi stream) you consider that the 5 candidates, whose names were sent to us in your letter of 11/12/69, will not be able to benefit fully.
- (2) You stated that you would prefer to withdraw all 5 names and that the Gossner Church in Germany be requested to permit the 5 scholarships to be used for a one-week's course to be conducted in Hindi in Ranchi for suitable 40 pastors or suitable laymen of your Church.
- (3) We agreed that those selected to attend such a course should be those of your pastors who are relatively young and those whom you are likely in the future to station in Urban areas.
- (4) You stated that you would be able to accommodate the pastors in your compound and would be able to make the necessary arrangements for lectures, rooms, etc.
- (5) You said you will be able to cater for the students at a cost of Rs.5/- per head per day. Mr. Bhengra also said that, if other churches wished to join the course, he could cater for up to 100 people. The cost also to be Rs.5/- per head per day.

(6) I enclose a copy of a draft budget from which you will see that I have allowed an average of Rs.30/- per pastor for travelling expenses. This was the sum suggested by Mr. Bhengra and I have left it unaltered, although it seems rather ^{high} to me. The pastors will, of course, be expected to fill in travelling claims so that we may reimburse the exact sum expended.

(7) After leaving your office I was able to talk to Bishop Dilbar Hans. He is most anxious for as many of his clergy as possible to participate in the course. He is willing to accommodate his own men and will pay their travelling expenses from his own budget. But, in order that the pastors of both Churches may enjoy full fellowship, the Bishop suggests that his pastors should have all their meals with your pastors. The two scholarships made to the Rourkela area by Germany (to be used for Churches other than G.E.L.) could be used to pay the cost of their food with you.

(8) It was suggested that the dates of the course should be Tuesday 7th April am to Mon.13th April pm. These dates are very convenient to the CIPBC also.

Of course, we shall also have to await permission from the Gossner Church in Germany to use their grant in this way, but I very much hope that we shall be able to go ahead with the plans as proposed and that you will be prepared to feed the clergy of the CIPBC in addition to your own.

I shall, of course, be visiting you again between now and April to make further arrangements, but shall be glad to know of the decision of the K.S.S. as soon as possible after its meeting so that I may begin to book lectures.

Dear Sir:

In response to your recent letter I am sending you a cheque for Rs.225/- (Rupees two hundred twentyfive only) being the refund of the pocket money sent by you for your 5 candidates. I have now paid them this money (Rs.45/- per head) out of the grant which came from Gossner Mission in Germany.

However, I feel it would be wise to share with you the exact position as regards this grant -

- (1) The Gossner Mission sent us Rs.4,900/- being the scholarship for 7 men @ Rs.700/- each.
- (2) Of these 7 men, 5 were your candidates and the remaining two were to be appointed by the Rourkela Christian Council. These last two places could not be filled this year and I have asked permission of the Gossner Mission to hold the Scholarship of these two and offer them again next year.
- (3) Thus you will see that the money actually sent for your 5 candidates amounted to Rs.3,500/- (5 times 700/-)
- (4) In ^{each} case the sum of Rs.700/- was made up of as follow:

However, I feel it would be wise to share with you the exact position as regards this grant -

(3) Thus you will see that the money actually sent for your 5 candidates amounted to Rs. 3,500/- (5 times 700/-)

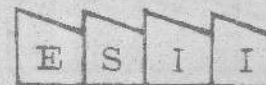
(4) In ^{each} case the sum of Rs. 700/- was made up of as follows:

Course fees		Rs. 600/-
Travel etc.		Rs. 100/-

You should note that while we charge the churches in India only a subsidized fee of Rs. 450/- our actual expenses for the entire course amounts to Rs. 600/- per candidate. The Gossner Mission kindly agreed to meet the entire cost and hence gave us Rs. 600/- for each of the candidates sponsored towards their fees.

(5) You will thus understand that I had in fact only Rs. 100/- per candidate for travel and other expenses. In fact after paying their 2-way travel bills, which I did directly, and gave them the pocket money @ Rs. 45/- each for the 3 months - the total came to Rs. 525/- a little more than the sum allotted.

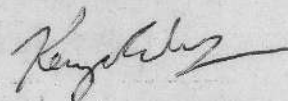
