Fifthly, send me routine of the School also to substantiate that you need two more teachers.

Dear Sir,

I am told here that on first, the Church Council promised to pay Rs. 100/- monthly ~~just~~ to the Takarona H.E. ~~just~~ before Mr. Jantala Singh visited this place.

Then, when the Inspector to D.H.S. came to see the High School, the President and the Treasurer promised before him that the Church Council would monthly pay Rs. 200/- to make the deficit of the High School.

Here the people simply think that the Church Council is not going to meet any deficit of the High School and its teachers will have, mercilessly, to suffer without redress, if a deficit occurs.

I think it will be helpful to us here, if the Council will kindly make a statement definitely on this point. If the C.C. takes up responsibility of meeting all deficits, these people will be eased. If not these people will go on thinking as they are doing now.

I am told that the people here as a whole are not willing to send girls away with a view to make the school income sure locally, for they believe that the Council will not meet the deficit, if it occurs at any time.

The way in which this may be done ~~is~~ ^{is} assuring, in my opinion, will be (a) to pass a resolution in the C.C. and communicate it to the school and to the State, (b) to call for monthly pay bills, which will always show whether there is a deficit in the H.S. section, and (c) to give the school a complete staff as soon as possible.

During this period there was no deficit as apparent in the above two sets of figures. However there will be deficit this year as pointed out below.

The average monthly income for the current twelve months, basing the calculation mainly on the even roll number, given above in the attached sheet under item 1 above, will be Rs. 747 monthly. In the last twelve months, ~~Rs. 1250/-~~ Mr. J. B. Bantle's salary for ten months was Rs. 1250/-, giving a monthly average of Rs. 104/- . This amount should be deducted from the school average income above mentioned. Then the actual monthly average income will be (Rs. 747/- - Rs. 104/-) Rs. 643/-
