IV. Appointment of Chairman and Secretary for this Joint Conference: It was unanimously resolved that Revd J. Gausdal and Revd J.J.P. Tiga be appointed Chairman and Secretary respectively.

"JOINT LUTHERAN THEOLOGICAL INSTITUTION AT RANCHI."

President Lakra made the following statement: Students from the Ebnezer Church have been coming to the Theological College for some years and now and several of them shave graduated from this institution. Triax their copperation in the matter of student population already started.

But a closer cooperation in the matter of administration, maintenance, management, establishment and supply of members of the staff, is to be sought and considered by this meeting. The subject may be decided into immediate and long range projects. The immediate need is of an English speaking Professor and the continuance of sending students to the College, Also the governing Body may include sending students to the College. Also the governing Body may include members from the Ebenezer Church.

Regarding the long range project, it may be mentioned that a desire has already been expressed by the Gossner Church Council and deligates of the Ebenezer Church too have a joint Theological Institution at Ranchi. Site also has been agreed upon. The final again action has been pending due to the War condition and this meeting should revive the idea and take suitable action to fulfill the aim.

Let us take a concrete step and place the same before the authorities

of the two Churches.

The cooperation in the Theological education is only the beginning of a bigger task ahead of the two Churchez bodies. The two Churches consist of members of the same cultural background and so the two churches have greater reason to unite rather than taking a leap.into the E.L.C.I. at once. Also the scheme of the Joint Mission Field in Bamra, Bonai, Mayurbhanj, Keonjhar and neighbouring areas, will have greater chance of success with the cooperation of the Ebnezer Church, for in a district like Mayurbhanj where the Santal population is overwhelming, the Gossner Church alone cannot perform the task which is expected to be done in cooperation with the Ebnezer Church. Here the service of the Ebnezer Church will be invaluable.

This meeting should consider the above matters and take some concrete actions which should placed before the authorities of the

concrete actions which should placed before the authorities of the

respective Churches.

Revd. J. Gausdal reminded the Conference about the Joint meetings which were held before and also about the offer of the G.E.L.Church of a site for a Joint Theological Institution. He expressed joy for the renewal of these discussions and told the members of the house about his recent correspondence with the responsible leaders of his church. He stated "We have our own Santal Divinity School, and we will need that in the future also." But he also told that more and more, Santahal Lutherans will be coming to Ranchi in future for both Arts and Theological education.

After a long and careful consideration of the matter it was unanimously resolved that a drafting Committee be apointed to formulate resolutions in the light of discussions and to present them to the Joint Conference at its next session. The members of the drafting

5. This preliminary meeting shall have to send out a general invitation to the Gossner Church. The Ebnezer Church, The M.P. Church and the Jaipur Church to join in the institution. This is not intended to exclude copperation of the above churches with the Gurukul College and the

Research Institution.

6. The Revd.J.J.P. Tiga, the Principal of the existing Institution shall act as the ad-interim Secretary and the Convener of the Committee and will send out reports and resolutions of this Committee and upon receipt of the replies, fix up time for the next meeting to be held at

7. In the present institution we have heard of the immediate need of a Professor lecturing in English and acquainted in this present Theological literature in the English language. From a private letter we have heard with joy that such a Professor may be saxuates found in America. He will be received with gratitude and quarters for his stay will be arranged. The Gossner Church be requested to arrange for his accommodation. The Principal of the present institution is hereby asked to correspond directly with Revd. Gornitzka in U.S.A.

8. We also recognise an immediate need for books in the English language for the Library of the present institution as it is and would invite immediate help from publishers and Mission Boards

in the U.S.A.

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Statement II : The College Building .

The Church has set apart 7.50 acres of land in the G.E.L. Church Compound of 120 acres at Ranchi. A plan had been drawn up in 1944, but it could not be worked out as the site has all these

years been under military occupation. Earnest attempts are being made for its release. The following is an extract from a letter sent by President Lakra to General Thakur Nathu Singh ,H.Q., Sastern Command Ranchi dated 3.1.1953:

The Rest Camp Ground .. This covers the Theological College Campus . The Theological College is to be housed on this ground. At present the college has no building of its own. The building project is ready but cannot be given effect to because of the occupation.

It is prayed that immediate steps be taken to release the Bround ".

For the period until the new building is erected on the proposed site , the College classes and the students are accommodated in the present building . This building is also the property of the G.E.L.Church. It has nine big rooms , three big halls and several small rooms. The Principal resides in one part of the present

College building. Dr. Schultz , Revd. Klimkeit and revd. Lakra are residing in Church buildings in the same compound, not very

far from the College building. The military Department have built many houses in the proposed site which are quite suitable for staff quarters and students' nostel etc. The Church has intended to mee construct a college building on that site as soon as it is released. It is also the desire of the Charch to purchase from the military Dopi. all the nouses they have built there and to use them for the Theological College.

For the present, the work of the College is being managed in the present building. The two students who are now living together in one room will be provided with better and single

seated rooms from June 1953 so that these B.D. students will

have better facilities.

STATEMENT III . LIBRARY.

Until last year we had been spending about Rs. 100/- p.a. on Library books. A request has just been sent to the Church council for the sanction of Rs. 500/- p.a. for the College Library. The Secretary and the President of the Church Council ha we given assurance that the matter will be considered by the Church Council in their meeting to be held from the 10th. of January, 1953. We believe that the Church Council will provide Rs. 500/- p.a. on the College Dudget for the Library.



(2) They all possess good character and conduct and they all have satisfied the members of the Faculty

(3) According to our experience in teaching Greek we suggest that after a period of six months in the first year those who cannot achieve the required standard should be allowed an alternative subject e.g; Vernacular Bible (Vide Serampore Syllabus Page 48)i.e; special studies in their own tribal languages. For the L.Th. students Greek should remain compulsory.

(4) It is recommended that the Final Examination be always held in the month of April so that course may be covered. This year we had to examine them early only because the Church Council is meeting in February and there will be no chance for the Council to meet in April. The Church Council may be held either in the end of April and one or way and that the final ways boys may appear

The Church Council may be held either in the end of April or early in May so that the final year boys may appear before the Council after finshing their course in April.

(5) It is also recommended that whenever the xix students are invited for an interview the members of the Faculty may also be invited to the Council meeting.

(6) In view of the possibility of having some students this year for 1st. Year B.D.Class it is also recommended that the Church Council Axidax may take decision to open B.D. Class in July 1952 and that suitable accommodation and necessary staff may be provided for the same. for the same.

Irregularities in monthly payments have caused untold troubles. It is hoped that the Church Council will see its way to redress all these irregularities at the earliest moment.





(1) Extract from the letter dated 4.4.1949

" With regard to the question of distinctive Lutheran teaching , let me say that the Serampore College (University) has no desire to interfere or control in such matters a matter. The teaching of Christian Theology (or other subjects) is in the hands of the individual Colleges and the papers used in Examinations are set by representative examiners gathered from all the Colleges and moderated by a representative Board of Moderators. Generally speaking the papers do not ask questions that involve purely denominational matters, and in any case no student would gain or lose in the examination on the score of particular wiek views. You should feel that you enjoy with all other affiliated Colleges such liberty in teaching as is consonant with the maintenance of a proper standard in scholarship."

(2) Extract from letter dated 21.4.1949 .

Resolution V. That the Lutheran Theological Seminary, G.E.L.Church, Ranchi, be welcomed into affiliation with Serampore College (University) from the beginning of the Seminary Academic Year, July 1, 1949, as an institution preparing students for the L.Th. (A.V.) Diploma."

With due respect I beg to lay the few following lines for your kind and favourable consideration :-

- 1. That, as the Lutheran Seminary is affiliated to the Serampore University, some under-matriculate Seminary students are going to be prepared to appear in the Matriculation Examination in various secular subjects also; and Hindi being one of them I have to inject them the standard and upto date Hindi ideas; wherefore requires much labour and attention therein.
- 2. That, there are some matric Seminary students who are to be prepared to appear in the L. Th. Examination for Hindi subject under the aforesaid University, the Hindi Teacher has to undergo much mental labour in infusing the standard Hindi Knowledge and materials to the students and promotting their Hindi language to an upto date status.
- 3. That, under the aforesaid category the wages for imparting standard Hindi knowledge to the students are too insignificant and injustified.
- 4. That, in accordance with the new Salary Scale of the G. E. L. Church in Chotanagpur and Asam, Ranchi: constituted and passed by the full C. C. meeting dated 2-10-46. The salary of the assistant teachers at Seminary and Catechist Training classes is ordinary pay plus allowance of Rs. 5/-only. But since I joined the Seminary Staff I have been always deprived of the ordinary pay of Rs. 50/-only and enjoying simply the allowance of Rs. 5/-only.

we can arrange the books of the Library for the inspection.

The Seminary Board Of The G.E.L. Church , Ranchi.

Meeting held in the Seminary Office at 10:30 - 12 A.M. and 2 - 5 P.M. on the 19th. August, 1949.

President J.Lakra was on the chair in the morning and from 2to 3:30p.m. in the afternoon. For the rest of the time he could not be present on account of some important engagement. Dr. Strock was then requested to take the chair.

1. Prayer : President J.Lakra led in the opening prayer.

2. Attendance: The following were present at the meeting:
Rev. J.Lakra, Chairman, Dr. J.Roy Strock,
Rev. S.Kula, Mr. J.Barla, Rev. J.A.Kujur (visitor)
and Rev. J.J.P.Tiga (Secretary- Principal).

3. Confirmation of Minutes: Minutes of the meeting held on 21.3.1949 were read and confirmed.

4. Kailash Kongari: The Principal and Dr. L.Ekka gave their reports about the illness of Kailash Kongari, a student of the Seminary. After a long deliberation the arrangement made regarding treatment and accommodation was approved. It was, however, felt necessary to remove him from the Elizabeth hospital premises to some other place. It was agreed that the Church Council be requested to find more suitable place for him to stay. Dr. L.Ekka expressed all hopes of his recovery and Rev. Kula expressed his willingness to serve him food. the most likely place is the outhouse of the President. It was resolved that the Church Council be requested to meet all the cost of treatment and diet and also to find suitable accommodation for Kailash Komgari.

5. Electric Light: The Principal reported that the light points of the new rooms given to the Seminary had to be repaired and line of current had to be disconnected from the G.H. School and College Hostels. The Bill for the same came to Rs. 44-4-0 Resolved that the action of the Principal be approved and that

the Church Council be requested to pay the Bill.

6. Seminary Staff: Dr. Strock told the dembers of the Board that the doctors have advised Mrs. Strock to return to U.S.A. and that Dr. Strock has been advised to accompany her. Dr. Strock also told that they expected to leave in October 1949 so that he would need to be relieved from his work in the Seminary as soon as possible.

President Lakra reposrted about his correspondence with the Santal Mission , Swedish Mission of C.P. and

the Berlin Kuratorium .

It was noted that the Swedish Mission in C.P. is unable to supply any teacher, the Santal Mission is considering, and the request of the Mahasabha tegarding Rev. Schulz has been communicated to the authorities concerned.

In view of the fact that Dr. Strock needed to discontinue taking classes in the Seminary as early as possible

the Board made the following temporary arrangement:

a. Rev. S. Kula to teach Old Testament, First Paper

b. " U.E. Kujur to teach Old Testament, Second "

c. " J.Lakra " " Church History d. " J.A.Kujur " " Christian Ethics.

e. Mr. J.Barla " " Greek New Testament Rext. and General Knowledge.

This news of Dr. and Mrs. Strock having been advised to return to U.S.A. as soon as possible came to the members of the Board with a heavy shock and the members tried to understand if the doctors could not change their decision. They were told that the advice had yet to be confirmed , even so preparations had to be made. The members expressed their deep sympathy for Dr. and Mrs. Strock and wished speedy recovery of Mrs. Strock.

7. Books from Dr. J.Roy Strock for the Seminary Library: Dr. Strock expressed his desire to sell away some of his books at 34 % of the cost price. At this rate books worth Rs. 56-4-0 were ordered for from him.

In view of the fact that the Principal had to EXEMPTE the cost of transport of the books from U.S.A. it was resolved that this payment be made from extra money for which the Church Council should be requested to make a special grant to the Semiary. 8. Dhankumar Tirkey: The Principal reported that Dhankumar has placed under Church discipline for misconduct and he did not come back for his stadies. Noted.

9. Request of the Students: Read petition dated 19.8.49.

a. Musical Instruments - Resolved that the Church Council be requested to sanction Rs. 300/- only for half a dozen of violines and two harmoniums.

b. Help for buying books: Resolved to recommend to the Church Council to pay Rs. 15/- per annum per head for the purchase of books.

10. Contribution to the Setampore College: Dr. Strock very kindly offered to contribute Rs. 10/- . It was resolved to send Rs. 15/- to the Serampore College (Rs.5/- to be spent out of the Contingencies) towards the Serampore College Funds as per Circular letter signed by Dr. G.H.C. Angus and Dr. C.E. Abraham dated July 20,1949.

The Principal informed the Board that the affiliation fee of

Rs. 300/- has been paid to the College.

11. Seminary Bulletin: Resolved that the Principal be authorized to go ahead with the publication of a Bulletin to be called The Lutheran Theological Seminary Bulletin. It may be half yearly for the present. The Church Council be requested to pay a sum of Rs. 60/- from the Budget for publication towards the initial expenses.

12. Examinees for 1950: The Principal reported that the follwing are to appear at the various Examinations in 1950:

L.Th. 1st Year ... Immanuel Ekka, Silas Kujur, Bhim John Murmu, Junas Soy, and Baruk Tirkey .

Serampore Matriculation: Mansukh Topono, Prabhdayal Soreng and Zackariah Bodra.

Seminary Examination: All except the five who will appear at the First Year L.Th. Examination.

13. Drama Income: The Principal reported an income of Rs.27-4-0 which has been converted into a special fund. Noted.

14. Rev. J.A. Kujur: In view of the fact that the Rev. Kujur is in charge of several congregations where the students go for practical work it was Resolved knakking to recommend to the Church Council that Rev. J.A. Kujur may be made a member of the Seminary Bd.

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The meeting was closed with a word of prayer.

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PROCEEDINGS OF THE THIRD MEETING

THE SEMINARY BOARD OF THE G.E.L.CHURCH, RANCHI. Meeting held in the Seminary Office at 4 p.m. on Sept.1,1949

In the absence of President Lakra Dr. J.Roy Strock Chairma n: was voted to the chair. President Lakra arrived for the Items 3 to the end.

1. The meeting was opened with a word of prayer by Rev. S. Kula.

2. Attendance : The following members were present :

President J.Lakra (Chairman), Dr. J.Roy Strock, Rev. S.Kula, Rev. J.A.Kujur, Mr. J.Barla and the Rev. J.J.P.Tiga (Sec-Pr.) Confirmation of Minutes: The Minutes of the meetings held on the 19th. of August, 1949 were read and confirmed.

4. Matters arising out of the Minutes :

a. Dr. and Mrs. Strock - Heard from Dr. Strock and noted that the final advice of the doctors has been heard which is that Dr. and Mrs. Strock should return to U.S.A. soon. It was also told that boat arrangements have been made and that these two friends have planned to leave Ranchi on the 10th, of October, visiting ANNIE

Guntur on their way to Bombay.

b. Kailash Kongari: Heard that Kailash is steadily impreving and that the President of the Northen Synod has no objection in his staying in the hospital premises because he thinks that he can make other arrangements for the accommodation of the Church

workers when they will come here for their meetings next week.

Noted with gratitude. c. Seminary Staff: The Board was happy to learn that Dr. Shotts is in favour of Rev. Schulz's coming to Ranchi and that there will be no difficulty about his support. This news was given by Dr. Strock who was told the members about his correspondence with Rev. Gausdal giving impressions that none could be expected from the Santal Mission so soon as this Board would want.

A long and careful consideration followed. It was then unanimously resolved , (a) That the Church Council be requested to post Rev. J. Klimkeit at Ranchi to join the Staff of the Seminary

with effect from the 12th. of September, 1949;

(b) That the C.C. be asked to request Dr. and Mrs. Strock to give accommodation to the Klimkeits.

5. Books from Dr. J.Roy Strock: It was very kind of Dr. Strock to give first chance for the Principal of the Seminary to select books from his list . The Principal reported that he selected 75 books including the 24 books reported at the last meeting. The actual price of these books is Rs. 386-8-0 but Dr. Strock is giving them all for Rs. 161/- only and in addition to these books he is giving for the Seminary Library a large number of books, magazines etc. all free. It was agreed to purchase the 75 books and to thank Dr. and Mrs. Strock for this liberal gift.

Furniture and Equipments for the Seminary : The Principal reported that he and President Lakra had gone to a neighbouring store to look for some furniture for the Seminary. The Principal placed before the members a list of articles to be bought e.g; shelves, desks, benches, chairs etc. for the Seminary Library and Reading Room. The total want for the present was shown as follows:
