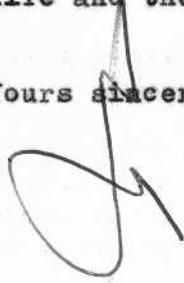
Subject: Stipend for the new convert to get his matric

Your letter No. 465/65 of 5th July 1965

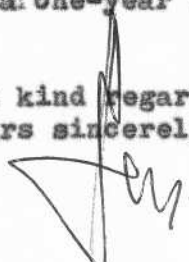
Dear Brother Bage,

It is, indeed, very generous that you and the KSS intend to send P. Kerketta to Serampore for another year of study to pass his M.Th. examination there, after his having studied here for quite a number of years. To lose him for another year, will surely mean much to the Church.

If I were member of the KSS, I would not know whether I had supported this decision. But, if it is your's and the KSS' opinion to invest once more money and time in this matter, I, then, want to confirm the discussion between you and Pastor Seeberg at Jerusalem and want to grant the needed amount of money for the one year's study of P. Kerketta. We hope that our friend will, then, reach his aim which he could not reach in Germany.

An executive College Council was held on the 27th Novemebr 64 in the College Library room.

The Following members were present:-

1. Rev. J.J.P.Tiga (Chairman)
2. Rev. J. Toppo
3. Rev. S. Surin (Secretary)

The minutes of the KSS dated 20-22 Oct.64 were read and noted that the admissions of Sri Solomon Tirakwar and Miss Merian Minz are approved.

It is further noted that Sri Solomon Tirakwar expired on the 7th Oct. 64.

The B.T.E. be requested to make a proposal to the KSS to raise the number of stipends for P.D. and B.D. students as there is a plan to start B.D. class in 1966.

The College Council noted the following decision of the K.S.S. dated 20-22 Oct.64 regarding B.T.E. matters item 26,(b) & (c).

Kushalmay Tirkey:- Resolved that Sri Kushalmay Tirkey will be given stipend with effect from the 1st of Oct. 1964.

Miss Merian Minz:- The Principal reported that on account of the following reasons the Principal allowed Miss M.Minz to live in her own house at Kathartoky- Ranchi.

- (a) That the Hostel fees of the Girls' College Hostel is Rs 45.00, besides other expenses, whereas our students get only Rs 40.00 p.m.
- (b) That the daily routine of that hostel is fixed to suit the students, who attend the secular Colleges in the town which are quite different from the routine hours of our College.

The Principal further reported that he is giving her Rs 30.00 p.m. for food and pocket money, the rest is deducted for maintenance, medical, books etc.

Budget:- The matter of budget is postponed for the next meeting to be held at Govindpur within the next two days.

Declaration of New Candidates:- Only those students can be declared candidates, who have passed L.Th. These students have passed the L.Th. in the year 1964.

1. Samuel Barla
2. William Khalkho
3. Nehemiah Topno.

The Principal reported that in addition to these three Royan Dang has also passed the L.Th. who is already a Candidate. It is noted that he has stood first in the L.Th.examination of the Seram-Pore College. Thus he will receive the ~~Sanat~~ Senate Prize this year.

The College Council feels that the designation " Candidate" is too common and secular. It no longer suits the purpose and significance of the church. It is therefore suggested that the word 'Candidate' be replaced by a more suitable word for instance "Decon" (*δῆκονος*) " Vikar " etc.

N.B:- The College council is not in favour of declaring any student a Candidate for the ministry, who has not passed the L.Th. On the other hand every help should be given to such students, that they may pass their L.Th. examination.

The College Council recommends that all the full-time Indian members of the College Staff be given the Ranchi town allowance of Rs 15.00 per month with effect from January 1965.

The meeting ended with the last prayer led by Rev.John Toppo.

Umzug in das Neue theol. College auf dem Ranchi-Compound

Es ist mir eine Freude zu berichten, dass nun endlich die Militaerhaeuser auf dem R.Comp. in der Naehel des Main Road unweit der Christuskirche gekauft werden konnten. Das KSS hat entschieden, dass der gesamte Komplex, der im Wesentlichen aus zwei Teilen besteht und relativ gut erhaltene Haeuser enthaelt, dem theol. College gegeben werden soll, damit dieser nun schon lange und sehnuechtig erwartete Plan einer ordentlichen und der Arbeit des College wuerdigen Staette verwirklicht werden kann. Dadurch wird dann auch das bisherige behelfsmassige College Hostel frei, in das dann die Maedchengrundschohle hineinkommen kann, die der ohnehin schon sagenhaften ueberfuellten Bethesdaschohle zur Zeit noch zur Last fallen muss. In theol. College werden dann nicht mehr 6 oder 7 Studenten in einem Raum schlafen muessen, sondern nur 2, die sanitaeren Verhaeltnisse werden endlich ihre entsprechende Aufbesserung erhalten, die dringend benoetigt wird gerade auch im Blick auf den Gemuehdheitszustand der Studenten (Anfang Oktober ist einer unserer neuen Studenten in seinem Dorf verstorben, den ich noch kurz vorher zusammen mit einem anderen Studenten mit Typhus ins Krankenhaus bringen liess, der eine kam durch, der andere nur scheinbar bzw. zunaechst!). Das neue College wird Toilettenanlagen mit septic tank haben. Die gegenwaertige service latrine wird taeglich von Personal bedient, das nicht leicht zu bekommen ist, und verpestet in der heissen Zeit die Luft in der ganzen Umgebung. -

Ich gehe deshalb so in die Einzelheiten, damit sie sich einigermaßen vorstellen koennen, was dieser Beschluss des KSS bedeutet. Bruder Schwark hatte nun schon mit der Einrichtung des einen Teiles begonnen, weil diese Raume fuer die Unterbringung der einen Haelfte der All Asia Delegierten benoetigt wurde. Auch unsere Konferenzkueche war dort.

Es mussten einige Tueren und Fenster in die Waende gebrochen werden, septic tanks sind gebaut worden, Mauern wurden gezogen etc. Die schon bestehenden Haeuser machen es uns nicht allzu schwer, daraus Lehrerwohnungen, Vorlesungsraeume, eine Kapelle, Buecherei etc. zu machen. Doch war noch nichts bisher getan zur Umstellung, bzw zum Umbau des Teiles der den Studenten, Vorlesungsraeumen, Essraum etc. dienen soll. Hier muessen eine Reihe von Waenden gezogen werden, um die ZweiMann-Raume des Hostels zu ermoglichen etc. Das konnte Schwerk nicht tun, weil er dazu noch kein Geld hatte. Er hat, aber den Plan des neuen College schon fertig entworfen unter geradezu genialer Ausnutzung des vorhandenen. Sein Kostenvoranschlag betraegt Rs 25000,00 fuer das gesamte Projekt. Das ist im Blick auf das Ausmass und den Charakter der Gebaeude, die er damit gewinnt, ein geringer Preis.

Die ganze Arbeit muesste nun aber stocken (nach Abschluss der Konferenz), wenn er nicht wenigstens einen Teil (vielleicht 2/3) des genannten Betrages sofort erhalten koennte. Es ist auch auf einem Compound wie dem Ranchi Compound nicht ungewoehnlich, einen solchen Komplex von Haeusern ungenutzt, leer fuer eine laengere Zeit, und seien es nur Wochen und Monate, stehen zu lassen. Schon einmal (im Jahre 57) war dem College vom KSS ein Gebaeude zugesprochen worden. Es wurde im Handstreich ueber Nacht genommen und ein langer Courtcase entwickelte sich. Von allen Seiten schiebt und drueckt es, nicht zuletzt von der revolutionaeren, leicht entzuendbaren Masse der 40 Ranchi College Studenten, die eine Haelfte des Raja Bungalows bewohnen. Der Zustand dieser Studentenquartiere straeubt sich einfach gegen jegliche Beschreibung.

Ich moechte nun, auch auf Bitten von Bruder Schwerk hin, ~~somit~~ sowie auf Bitten von Sabab Surin und anderer (Bruder Bage) den Appell an Sie richten, wenigstens einen Teil des Schwerkschen Geldes zu senden. Ich bin mir darueber klar, dass Sie das vor ungeahnte finanzielle Schwierigkeiten stellt. Diese Planung konnte zur Zeit der Aufstellung des Budgets fuer 64 nicht gemacht werden. Damals wussten wir noch nicht, wie schnell und wann wir die Militaerhaeuser bekommen wuerden, auch bestand noch nicht der Plan, die Militaerhaeuser an Main Road fuer das theol. College zu verwenden. Ich weiss auch nicht unter welchen Titel dieser Betrag kommen wuerde (5 Jahresplan oder etwas extra!?) Auf jeden Fall moechte ich Ihnen, wenn es sich ~~um~~ irgend ermoglichen laesst, die Ueberweisung dieses Betrages oder zumindest eines Teiles sehr ans Herz legen. Bruder Schwerk kann Ihnen noch naechere Mitteilung machen. -

Was meine Abrechnung angeht (JMB etc), so will ich versuchen gleich nach meiner Rueckkehr nach Ranchi einiges zu uebersenden. Nur fuehrte ich, dass Bruder Seeberg leider nicht recht behalten kann, wenn er annimmt, dass sich groessere Betraege haben einsparen lassen.

Dear Sir,

Please find enclosed Bill for October, 1964 submitted by the headmaster of the Pracharak Training School along with a statement of income and expenditure for September, 1964. The bill has been duly recommended by me although I have noticed several discrepancies. Dr. Seeborg has written a letter in connection with these matters of the Pracharak Training school addressed to me dated the 28th. Sept., 64 and copies have been sent to, Dr. Bage, Rev. Tete and Rev. Kless. In the Financial statement for September all these should have been shown clearly, item by item. I am afraid Pastor Seeborg will again feel unhappy about it. We are all interested in the fact that the School needs to be paid regularly and on time and for this reason I leave this matter for settling up in course of time and recommend the bill so that it may be passed and paid.

I have further difficulty, namely that I get one copy of the bill and the Financial Statement which I have to recommend and send to you although at times I get two copies of the bills but not that of the statement. This means that I have no copies left in my files and at the time when Pastor Seeborg or your office refers me to these bills & financial statements I am non-plussed and I find myself in quite a helpless situation. In the case of the Theological College I sign four copies of the bills and the financial statements, one copy is given to me and other three are taken back for service to the three different offices. This is very convenient. As Revd. Tete is far away at Govindpur I shall not mind if he will send all four copies to me of the bills and the financial statements and I shall take care to get them passed on to you, to the head accountant and to the Pramukh Adhyaksh keeping one copy for myself. If you agree kindly instruct the headmaster to do so. It will apply also to the Tabitha School. In any case, unless I recommend even if you get the bill it is not paid. Unsigned (by me) copies may be sent to you and others if the headmaster and the headmistress so wish to do.

Before it is too late may I request you to kindly arrange for a checking of the accounts of the Theological College, The Pracharak Training School and the Tabitha School so that we may be quite safe with this financial matter of these institutions.

Dear Rev. Seeberg.

I acknowledge with thanks receipts of your letter of 1-7-64. and a copy of your letter addressed to the Rev. J. J. P. Tiga on 28-9-64. I am sorry that I could not reply your letter in time. Following are my explanations on the points raised by you.

1. Your letter of 1-7-64, shows the sum of Rs.1004.00. balance from the January to May Financial Reports, including the medical fund. It is correct. The K. S. S. treasurer had to pay Rs.960.00 . to the school, but he paid only Rs.864.00. for January 1964.

Financial Reports from June to August shows a balance of Rs. 908.00. including medical fund. It is correct, because the K. S. S. Treasurer paid to the school a sum Rs. 96.00. less for January 1964. The sum of Rs.96.00. has been paid only on 1-9-1964, as arrears stipends for January 1964.

So the difference between the figures of the P. T. S. and the Gessner Mission is of the sum of Rs. 96.00.

2. Medical Fund: I have with me the sum Rs. 322.15, a balance from the January to August account. But I have not kept a separate cash book for Medical Fund. I hope to have a cash book very soon.

3. Rs. 430.00. spent for furnitures from the surplus amount:
I have clearly understood the position of the Gessner Mission in this connection. The school was in urgent need of these furnitures and I had to take personal initiative to fulfil the need. It is not a ~~luxurious~~ luxurious purchase.

I believe that the heads of the central institutions have freedom to see the needs of the institutions, and to guard the honour of the institutions for peace and harmony in the whole Gessner Church.

The students of the school are thankful to the Gessner Mission for the help they are receiving.

Sie hatten wohl die Zahlungen für den Gharbandhu und den Adhyatmik Patr ab Juli eingestellt, weil Sie erst einen Bericht von mir haben wollten. Ich hatte bis jetzt noch nicht Einzelheiten geschrieben - das heißt es war - was Sie angeht - alles in Ordnung. Das Geld wird, soweit ich sehen kann, ordentlich verwaltet. Da ich nicht mehr Treasurer des Adhyatmik Patr war, wie vor 1 1/2 Jahren, habe ich auch nicht direkten Einblick in die Gelder. Ich weiß aber, daß die Sache läuft, nachdem nun auch ein vollamtlicher Redakteur (eben jener Konvertit Ch. Tiwari) mit dem Pramukh A. zusammen arbeitet. Ich habe folgende 2 Punkte erreicht:

- a) der Adhyatmik Patr wurde mit dem Gharbandhu zusammengelegt, indem der Gharbandhu einige Seiten mehr erhielt, die Adhyatmik Shiksha genannt werden, d.h. "geistl. Unterweisung". Dadurch wird ein Konkurrenz der Blätter vermieden, die sich auch finanziell auswirken würde. (Ich darf am Rande vermerken, daß es nicht leicht war, beide unter einen Hut zu bringen, da leicht immer alles "persönlich" mißverstanden wird.) Auf das Management des Gharbandhu habe ich keinen direkten Einfluß. Ich glaube aber Ihnen versichern zu können, daß die Finanzen richtig verwaltet werden. Man hat nun schon bei Mittenhuber und bei mir Anleihen gemacht. Senden Sie also bitte den Budgetbetrag. Das Gharbandhublatt kostet jetzt natürlich mehr, wenn auch durch die Zusammenlegung - wie ich hoffe - gespart wird. Was nicht gebraucht worden ist, wird am Jahresende zusammen mit dem ganzen Kirchenbudget abgerechnet werden. Falls ein Rest bleiben sollte, wird er ordnungsgemäß anderer Verwendung zugeführt in Rücksprache mit Ihnen.
- b) Seit dem Jahre 1940 hat - wie sich jetzt herausstellte - der Gharbandhu illegal existiert. Da die Registrierung - wissentlich oder unwissentlich - nicht jährlich erneuert worden war, war die alte Nummer an ein anderes Blatt vergeben worden - ausgerechnet an das Blatt der Arya Samaj (die ind. Nazis!). Die wollten einen Case anstrengen gegen das General Post-Office in Patna, weil eine andere Zeitung frisch fröhlich ihre Registration Number benutzte. Unserm erschrockenen, unschuldigen (weil neuen) Redakteur bot man auf der Post sofortige

Verhaftung an, wenn er nicht sofort nach Patna fahre und die Sache in Ordnung bringe. Das alles geschah in Bages Abwesenheit. Durch Finanzierung der Fahrt etc. durch mich konnte die Sache gerade gebogen werden. Außerdem entpuppte sich der Postmeister in Patna als Christ. Schwindlich aber kann einem werden, wenn man daran denkt, daß in all den 24 Jahren die Kirche wegen der fehlenden Registration nie das vergünstigte Porto zum Versenden des Gharbandhu in Anspruch genommen hat, d.h. bei jedem versandten Exemplar wurden mindestens 2/3 zuviel bezahlt!

3. New admission:- These ~~xxxx~~ two students Amarnath Singh and Masihdas Surin have dropped.

Solomon Tirakwar:- His admission is confirmed today because the authorities of the Khutitoly school withdrew the objection and recommended his admission. Therefore the Principal and the chairman admitted him provisionally. This was approved by the Council.

Girl-students:- There was only one girl candidate- Merian Minz. The admission of Miss Merian Minz be approved.

Hostel accommodation of Miss M. Merian Minz:- It was resolved that she will be accommodated in the Girls' College hostel with proper understanding with the authorities.

New admission for a vacant seat:- Kushalmay Tirkey be admitted in the College for a probationary period.

4. Money received from the Mahila Sammittee:- It was reported by H. Kloss Acting Principal that he received Rs 100.00 from Miss A. Minz the President Mahila Sammittee.

The College Council notes that Rev. H. Kloss has spent Rs 160.00 for beds in advance. When the budget for beds will be released he will be paid back of his advance money.

This money Rs 100.00 is a gift from Mahila Sammittee therefore this amount be spent in publicity of the Lutheran theological College.

5. Scholarship for higher theological studies:-

- (a) The B.T.E. and the K.S.S. be requested to provide in the budget of 1965 for L.Th.2nd class for prosecuting their studies for the P.D. and also provide for the certain number of B.D. students for studying in the Colleges, where there are classes for these Courses.
- (b) All L.Th. students, who pass in the 2nd class be required to prosecute their studies for higher theological Courses.
- (c) One scholarship for B.R.E. and one for M.Th.Course.

6. Unpaid stipends for B.Tirkey and M.Samad of Serampore College:-

The Pramukh Adhyaksh informed the Council that the church owes to Serampore College Rs 1020.00 only towards the stipend from these two students. Serampore College has advanced this amount to these students in the hope that the church would spend this money to the students. The church has so far failed to refund this advance met by the College.

Resolved:- That Rs 1020.00 be paid out of Rs 6130.00 being the balance of stipends received from the Kuratorium for 1965 and that the Pramukh Adhyaksh be authorised to forward this money to Serampore College.

7. The New College Building:-

- (1) The Pramukh Adhyaksh ~~the~~ informed the College Council that there is a plan to set apart the portion of the M.E.S. area namely the eastern portion of the road from the church to the Rajah-Bungalow.
- (2) The College Council is also happy to know that the architect Mr.Schwerg has already prepared a plan for accommodating the theological College therefore its remodelling etc.
- (3) The College Council would request the authorities concerned to keep in mind ~~that~~ the necessity of upgrading the College in the near future. For this purpose the College Council would appreciate if architect Mr.Schwerg would kindly prepare a full plan and an estimate.
- (4) The College Council should make a effort to obtain funds for construction and renovation of present building from the T.E.F. and for this purpose the planning Commission of the G.E.L.Church be requested to state how much of the estimate the church will be able to bear by itself.
- (5) The College Council requests the K.S.S. to allow the College to occupy the proposed Campus as soon as the Asia-Lutheran conference is over.

Dear Sir,

Please refer to your letter dated 16.9.64 addressed to the Head Accountant, K.S.S. of the G.E.L. Church. In that letter you have mentioned in connection with the accounts of Income and Expenditure of the stipends of students for the months of June, July and August, 1964 submitted by the Lutheran Theological College and have stated that "the items of expenditure are in accordance with the decision of the College Council duly approved by the B.T.E., K.S.S. and the Kuratorium".

However, the K.S.S. records show that the K.S.S. has on recommendation of the B.T.E. approved Rs.4/- for Book grant and Rs.4/- for maintenance to be included in the stipend paid to each student. The financial statements submitted to our Office shows that the payment has been made at the rate Rs.2/- for Book grant and Rs.6/- for Maintenance for each student. Thus, when the statement is based on what K.S.S. has approved, the trial balance shows that the Book grant loses Rs.100/- whereas the Maintenance account gains Rs.100/-. This fact has been mentioned by the Head Accountant in his letter dated 30.7.64.

Therefore, please clarify as to when the B.T.E. approved the change shown above and whether the same has been forwarded to the K.S.S. or not. If it has been forwarded when has it been done. In case the recommendation of the B.T.E. has not yet been forwarded to the K.S.S., the same be please done along with which the reasons for such a change be stated.

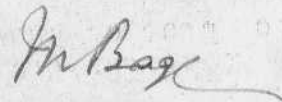

- c) Rs. 3.-- into the medical fund to be administered by the <sup>school</sup> college authority (Whatever may be the rest of this money, not used in the present semester, should be carried over to the next in order to fill up a possibly bigger gap of the semester to come under the same title.)
- d) Rs. 4.-- for books and similar things needed for the work, which have to be owned by the student. Also this money be administered by the <sup>school</sup> college authorities.

Rs. 40.-- total monthly.

The Kuratorium of the Gossner-Mission in Berlin expects that the authority of the <sup>school</sup> college will send a report on the expenditure of the money according to the scheme above or the scheme agreed upon later to the Board of Theological Education with a copy to the Gossner-Mission in Berlin at the end of the semester (March/April 1964).
