- *a growing church*

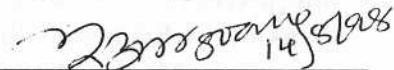

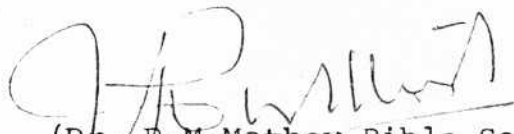
It is in this context that your name has been proposed.

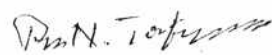

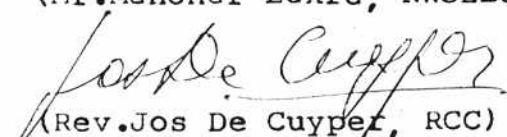

Sir,

The following facts are briefed hereunder on the subject matter which is under consideration by pastorate since Feb'98 . These points be taken into considration in the ensuing pastorate meeting before arriving to any conclusion.

Para-I Existence of G.E.L.Church Kalyanpur.

(i) It is existing since its birth. The church properties i.e. the church premises and cemetery have been registered, in the name of G.E.L. Church Kalyanpur. Naming under certain law-is registered-unchangable (that is why Baptism certificate is given). That is why the N.W. G.E.L.Church is failure to have share of church properties though claimed and displayed a sign Board of N.W.G.E.L. Church in front of the G.E.L. Church Ranchi with a view to have ownership of the church and properties. That is why the CNI Church though existing in Hesag is establised in the name of CNI Church Kalyanpur.

(ii) The pastorate is well aware of the fact:-

(a) That G.E.L.Church Kalyanpur even after division continued to function till posting out of previous Pastor relieved by the present one, governing by its Congregation council elected by the general body having its office bearers i.e. a Pracharak (Chairman) appointed by Parish Council, a Secretary, a Treasurer and tola Panchs.

(b) That Kalyanpur Congregation has a privilege to participate in the administration of Pastorate by sending its representatives. Pastorate has a privilege to have a qualified Cashier from this unit of Kalyanpur .

(c) The Kalyanpur Congregation took the responsibility to finance the Pastorate a sum of Rs.800=00 per month and also the other contrtributions when a very difficult time was being faced.

(d) Kalyanpur Church obliged the responsibility to collect and centralize all the contributions as per rules for years together.

Para-2. The so called G.E.L. Church Hesag.

The Postorate is well aware of the fact:-

(a) That it is originally G.E.L. Church Kalyanpur. It was divided into two groups for some reason or other. Consequently they declared a separate Church naming "G.E.L.Church Hesag Mandli/Parish". An extract to this effect is enclosed to substantiate it. This was done without approval of the competent authority.

(b) That the so called G.E.L. Church Hesag stands debarred from the privileges of Pastorate, Parish and the Diocese for years for the reasons well known to them and the Pastorate.

(c) That it was managed to run the church till posting out of the previous Pastor.

(d) That after posting in of the new Pastor from Feb'98 as Chairman of Hatia Pastorate the matter regarding getting the privilege of Pastorate and higher offices is being progressed through Pastorate by changing name of GEL Church Kalyanpur to GEL Church Hesag.

(e) That it is understood that action on change of name is based on majority and minority. This view of Pastorate is baseless and unconstitutional for the following reasons:-

(i) The question of minority and majority does not arise as minimum of 10 to 20 communicant members constitute a Congregation .

(ii) Every local Congregation is a Church of God
(1 Cor 1:2)

(iii) There are two units, one "Kalyanpur Church" other

the so called G.E.L. Church Hesag. They are not at par and cannot be compared because one is in existence since birth, the other stands debarred till date from the Pastorate and higher offices.

(iv) Pastorate has no record in possession which can substantiate the necessity of change of name for consideration and submission to competent authority for approval.

(v) That is an open fact that the case is being moved under pressure by Pastorate keeping aside all the weapons provided in the constitution..

(vi) Taking parallel Pastorate members from so called G.E.L.Church Hesag in the pastorate meeting held on 7.6.98 at Hesag and accepted by voice pressure vote for change of name to G.E.L.Church Hesag is unconstitutional as Hesag Church stands debarred from Hatia Pastorate and thus the

decision taken in the meeting are unconstitutional . Holding of meeting in a Church which is debarred is itself wrong.

The requirement may please be noted for future.

Para-3 From the above there seems no other alternative but to streamline with G.E.I. Church Kalyanpur.

Para-4 Finally, it is submitted that relevant rules or Constitution where in responsibilities of Pastorate towards Parcharakpan Council laid down be followed and the matter solved in the best interest of the Congregation.
