

'Today's traditions are yesterday's inventions'

JAN, 23.—From newspaper editors to Prime Ministers, all talk unblushingly of Indian culture and tradition. In recent years, a variety of beliefs about our past—the spirit of non-violence and the religious tolerance of the Hindus, for example—have been unquestionably accepted as part of our "tradition", but few have concerned themselves with the historical basis, if any, of these beliefs.

What is often regarded as tradition having long pedigrees, turns out to be an invention of vesterday, rooted in contemporary requirements. Delivering the third Qureshi Memorial Lecture at St Stephen's Col'ege, Delhi University, yesterday. Professor Romila Thapar, well-known historian, said traditions were not self-created, but cansciously chosen.

Speaking on cultural transaction in early India; tradition and patronage, Professor Thapar said a fresh look was needed into what had been quietly accepted as "tradition". She said that in order to understand the role of religion in Indian society, it was necessary to move away from the paradigm

in Indian society, it was necessary to move away from the paradigm of Hinduism as projected during

She said that for such a diverse country to create a uniform cul-tural tradition for itself could country to create a uniform cuttural tradition for itself could
become an exercise in juggling
with history. In ancient India there
was no consciousness of a Hindu
community, of a re'iglous identity
which cut across other segmental
differences. The term Hindu was
used first in Arabic sources to denote the inhabitants of the subcontinent across which the river
