

Dear Sir,  
Thanks for your letter No 251/85 KSS-155  
of 28.5.85 received yesterday on the above cited  
matters.

In this respect I have to state the following  
That the parishes had been urged to wait till at  
least 30th June 85 for ordination since the Pramukh  
Adhyaksh has telegraphically intimated his inability  
to come on 2.6.85 as per our request. The  
Parishes have however accepted this advice but not  
beyond 30th of June. They are pressing hard to get their  
Pastors from 18th July, as I've already intimated to you  
in my letter of 3-6-85.

That now it is not easy to persuade the  
Parishes for waiting further beyond 30th June 85,  
as per your suggestion. It is feared, we loose  
confidence and cooperation from the Parishes pressing  
so hard, and another problem would be awaiting  
if their demand and need is not fulfilled by  
the 30th June.

May I therefore, request you, consider the matter  
seriously and favourably and fix up the ordination  
date not beyond 30th June and come to Tezpur at  
least for 3 or 4 days by changing your programmes  
in other nearby Anchals for a while, and save  
the situation and oblige.

REGARDING revocation of Power of attorney I  
have to state that the said Power of attorney was  
granted by the KSS only on the request of the  
Assam Anchal, on the condition that it would not  
be misused.

The informant informed enquiry conducted by me in the matter revealed the following :-

There had been protracted correspondence between the publicity Officer and our Secretary Property Board prior to 1981 in respect of repairing the building mentioned above. Our secretary expressed his inability to do so for want of fund and requested the Publicity Officer to vacate the building. But even then when the Publicity Officer persisted for repairing the building, the secretary wrote to him clearly that he would not be held responsible for loss of any life and property if the building collapsed. The Publicity Officer then came up with the proposal to get the building repaired by the Executive Engineer P.W.D. and meet the expenditure involved from

from his fund. The secretary accepted the proposal subject to the condition that the Publicity Deptt. would go on paying rent @ Rs.100/- p.m. as before and the amount that would be incurred by him towards repair would be adjusted against rent only when fair rent was fixed. The Publicity Officer not only agreed to do so, but also assured to get the fair rent fixed immediately after completion of repairing work.

The Executive Engineer completed the repairing work in early 1981 by incurring a total expenditure of Rs.19,000/-. But the fair rent is yet to be fixed. If it is fixed we are expecting to get Rs.10,800/- approximately after adjustment of Rs.19,000/- and the amount already paid by the Publicity Deptt. as rent till date.

Number of officer came and went on transfer but none of them took any action for fixation of fair rent. Their indifferent attitude towards the matter is easily understandable as if fair rent is fixed Publicity Officer will be required to pay ten time more than that what he has been paying per month as rent for the portion of the building he is occupying for residential purpose.

If the matter was pursued property by the Board of Properti properties, the Publicity Deptt. could not get chance to keep the matter pending for such a long time.

We are getting Rs.1200/- per annum as rent where as amount payable by us as holding taxes is Rs.1500/- or so.

It is evident from the facts stated above that the best way to ~~max~~ over come such inordinate delay on any matter is to authorise a local man to deal with the same.

You may kindly recall the meeting which you, the Anchal Adhyaksh and the Secretary, Property Board had with the members of West Bengal Jaka and Purulia Mandir Panch on 27-9-82 at 6-30 P.M. at Purulia G. 





The Commission will be fully competent to take final decision in the matter on the spot if necessary.

Resolved further that both the parties be directed to maintain status quo and refrain from doing any precipitate action which will vitiate and aggravate the situation.

#### 5. Reports from Boards -

##### (i) Medical Board -

Dr. W.Horo Secretary read out the Minutes of the Board meeting. This was thankfully accepted for discussion.

After discussion the report was approved.

Resolved that the revised pay scale applicable to all hospital and despensaries of the Church as prepared and submitted by Dr.Horo be recommended to the Gossner Mission, Berlin for favourable consideration.

The Minutes of the Board is marked as Annexure 'A'.

##### (ii) Finance Committee - The Minutes of the Committee was read by the Pramukh Adhyaksh.

Approving the Minutes (Report) after disau ssion.

Resolved that

- (a) it be ascertained from the Theological College Lecturer-Pastors if they are willing to work as Hd. Qrs. Congregations pastors.
- (b) alternately the Head Qrs. Congregation Panch be requested to contribute a fixed amount every year for the Gossner Theological College.

(c) Tour programme of Central leaders be drawnout for visits to Anchals for pushing up envelope contributions collections.

The Committees report forms annexure 'B'.

(iii) Board of Education - vide Annexure 'C'

Shri. V.M. Barla read out the report which was accepted with thanks for discussion.

On discussion - The members noted that on the one hand there is shortfall in the deposit of P.F. of teachers on the other hand it is claimed that deposit of P.F. was made up to March 1985 in Khutitoly High School. With the above note the report was approved with the direction that as per the demand of the Anchal Adhyaksh, a committee be sent to Khutitoly to help the Anchal form Managing Committee for the Church High School at Khutitoly.

Resolved further that circular be sent out to all the Schools in the Church about the necessity to follow our Church Constitution read with the Albicsa constitution in the matter of formation of Managing Committees and appointment of Headmasters and of Secretaries and other matters relating to establishment and management of educational institutions by the Minorities.

Shri. M.P. Kongari Education Officer also be invited to help the Committee to form M.C.

(iv) Board of Evangelism and Literature - Vide Annexure 'D'.

The Minutes of the Board read by the Director was accepted thankfully for discussion.

In course of discussion it was noted that revision of N.T. & O.T. history has not been done.

The Principal, Gossner Theological be reminded for early revision and submission to the KSS.

As to the desirability of sending in request for higher amount for B.E.L. (Mission fields)

Resolved that (i) The G.M. be requested to consider to increase the subsidy for the Mission fields and (ii) that Anchals also be urged to arrange for funds for Mission fields in their areas.

On the question of the involvement of the MF supervisors and other workers in the Church administration it was Resolved that the Pramukh Adhyaksh all the Adhyakshes and Rev. C.B. and form a Committee to prepare guide lines incorporating therein among other things the no men clature of administrative units like parish and ~~its~~ setup. This be submitted at an early date.

With the above notes and observations the report is approved.

(v) Report of the Ministerium -

This was read by the Secretary Rev. S.Toppo and is marked as Annexure 'E'.

After thanfully accepting and some discussion the report was approved for print and implementation from 1-10-85.

(vi) Minutes of the Board of Properties.

Shri. P. Topno recording Secretary read the Minutes which after discussion was approved with following resolution on Khutitoly Properties that

On the request of the Rev. M. Tete Adhyaksh M. Anchal a commission consisting of

(a) Rev. C.B. Lind, Convener

(b) Rev. S. Toppo, Member and

(c) Shri. P. Topno, Member

be constituted to bring about compromise between the Rev. M. Tete Adhyaksh and his group on the one side and Shri. A. Lakra, Secretary Madhya Anchal and his group on the other.

The Commission read on July 8, 1985 and hold compromise meeting on 9th July 1985.

Both the party leaders viz Rev. M. Tete Adhyaksh and Shri. A. Lakra, Secretary M. Anchal be informed well in advance to attend the meeting.

(vii) Board of Theological Education -

Rev. C.S.R. Topno, Secretary read the Minutes of the Boards meeting. This was accepted for discussion. In the course of discussion following matters in relation to the College cropped up.

(a) A/c. of the Construction of the Gossner Theological College building.

(b) M/s. No. 113/78- Bank of India plaintiff  
Cersees  
Shri. Keki Modi and others

(c) Handing over of the charge of the Post (Office) of the Principal G.T.C.

(d) Provident fund of Rev. Dr. R. Dang and Rev. C.A.B. Tirkey - Rev. M. Tete's failure to deposit the amount of over Rs. 8000.

(e) Vacation of quarter.

All the above matters are interrelated and arose in course of discussion on item 4 of the Minutes of the Board.

It was noted that question of handing over charge of the Principalship involved delivery of files and papers A/cs including A/c of construction of the building which again is interlinked with papers relating to the case i.e. M/s 113/78 Bank of India versees Keki Modi and others.

Nothing that Rev. M. Tete has inspite of requests made for having over of the charge of Principalship including A/c of Provident fund of Rev. Dr. R. Dang and Rev. C.A.B. Tirkey and for vacation of quarter adopted and attitude of supreme indifference towards the KSS and thus has deliberately failed to comply with the directions in these matters.

Resolved that Rev. Tete be asked to -

- (i) Render A/c of the construction of the Gossner Theological College building,
- (ii) hand over charge of the office of Principal of the G.T.C. along with all papers and documents, A/cs viz Cash book, ledger, Bank pass books, cheques books etc including A/c of Provident fund.
- (iii) Vacate quarter

Within 15 days of the receipt of the notice failing which disciplinary action will be taken against him.

Further noting that the involvement of the G.T.C. and therefore of the G.E.L.C in M/s No. 113/78 was due to the fact that Rev. M. Tete became guarantor for Shri. Keki Modi for obtaining loan of Rs. 125,000 from the Bank of India without any authority of the KSS, the Sabha rescinding its earlier decision in this regard directs that no money from the KSS coffers be paid for the aforesaid court case expenses.

Legal opinion regarding desirability of the KSS becoming party on its own to protect the property (G.T.C building) be had and action taken accordingly.

#### 6. Election of Chairman of Boards -

In the last KSS except for the Board of Property the Pramukh Adhyaksh was made Chairman for all other Boards. Both the Sabha and the Pramukh Adhyaksh felt that it is too heavy a burden for one man to preside over all the Board meeting the same day.

Resolved therefore that Chairman be elected for each (except BEL) Board.

Accordingly

##### (i) Board of Property -

Proposed by Rev. S. Toppo and seconded by Rev. S.K. Jojo Rev. C.B. Aind was unanimously elected its Chairman.

##### (ii) Board of Theological Education.-

Proposed by the Rev. Dr. C.K.P. Singh and seconded by the Rev. S.K. Jojo Rev. S. Toppo was unanimously elected as B.T.E. Chairman.

##### (iii) Board of Education -

Shri. Immanuel Minz was unanimously elected Chairman of the Ed. Board.

His name was proposed and seconded by Rev. S. Toppo and Rev. O. Toppo respectively.

contd.....P/6.

(iv) Board of Medical and Health Services -

It was unanimously decided that the Pramukh Adhyaksh be its Chairman as before.

7. Rev. A.S. Hemrom -

Rev. Cyril Hemrom having joined the G.T.C. Rev. A.S. Hemrom who was officeting in his place has been relieved from 1-6-85. Resolved that the Officers decide about his appointment.

8. Dr. T.C. Dale

Resolved that the Rev. Dr. T.C. Dale be invited as visiting Professor in the Gossner Theological College for three months in 1986.

(a) Leadership Training Project of the Gossner Theological College

Since B.E.L. is already having such a programme the College be asked to submit details of its project so that there should not be duplication.

(b) Khijuria Tank - handing over of -

The matter be pursued through the Board of Properties.

9. Letters from Anchals -

(i) Madhya Anchal -

The Anchals recommendation to retire Rev. H.M. Bage with effect from 1-7-85 is approved. It may be noted that Rev. H.M. Bage himself had requested for voluntary retirement.

(ii) Rev. Halan Samad - Latakel Parish -

After listening to the report of the Anchal Adhyaksh and others the recommendation of the Anchal for compulsory retirement of the Rev. H. Samad is approved.

He is retired with effect from 1-7-85 will all retirement benefits.

(iii) Shri. Hardugan Tiru -

The Sabha was informed that Shri. Tiru who hails from Assam failing to secure appointment in the Assam Anchal come to Bokaro where he has since sometime recent past been working as Pracharak.

Since he is already working in the S.E. Anchal he be declared a candidate if not already so declared and S.E. Anchal

be requested to absorb him.

(iv) Ordination of Shri. Paul Khess and Shri. William Karkaria both Pracharaks

They Assam Anchal Adhyaksh informed that their training is over.

Resolved that the Secretary of the G.E.L.Churdi Ministerium be asked to process their case for ordination.

The Sabha was in this connection informed of the Anchal Adhyaksh's letter of 12-6-85 as per which he seems to be bent upon their ordination even without the Pramukh Adhyaksh on 30-6-85.

The Sabha notes with regret his absence in the session and the threatened ordination go to show his deliberate disregarded of the KSS.

His action calls censure.

(v) Rev. S.M. Topno - His application for remuneration was considered.

He was appointed in Jan this year as Hon' Promoter for six months i.e. till June 1985. Decided that his designation it is and that he be paid Rs. 100 per month plus a commission of fifty paise for each new subscriber enlisted by him (not renewal).

His probationary period is extended to six months from 1-7-85.

(vi) Panjika - Rev. P.D. Burhi and Rev. S. Toppo are appointed to prepare the Panjika for 1986 to be ready by October 1985. Remuneration to be paid to them be increased by Rs. 50 over the last years.

10. CASA - Letter from the CASA was read and discussed-

Resolved that CASA be informed the pirst of the two alternatives in the matter of A/cs for projects in the Church be adopted.

11. North Western Anchal matters -

(i) The Anchal's recommendation for ordination of Shri. Ephraim Khess and P.D. Kerketta is approved for onward transmission to the Secretary G.E.L.C. Ministerium for necessary action.

As to the proposal to declare Mrs. Marian Minz as candidate and take up her case for ordination.

Resolved that the same be referred to the G.E.L.C. Ministerium for consideration.

(ii) The Anchals complaint of encroachment by Madhya Anchal-

The Anchals strong protest against the Madhya Anchals encroachment in Jatatoly Ilaka through Anchal Samiti's resolution item No. of 21-6-85 was read.

Recalling the earlier resolution of the KSS on similar subversive facts of the Anchal the Sabha notes with dismay and grave concern the persistent acts of interference in other Anchals affairs in niter disregard to all decency and decorum in inter Anchal relationship.

In course of discussion it transpired that on receipt of unilateral declaration of a section of Jatatoly Ilaka leaders the Adhyaksh Madhya Anchal thought it fit to send as was confirmed by Rev. Sursen Kerketta in the Sabha him (Rev. Kerketta) for enquiry without reference first to the KSS and the N.W. Anchal.

Resolved therefore that Rev. M. Tete Adhyaksh, Madhya Anchal be called upon to explain in writing within fifteen days of the receipt of the show cause notice as to why disciplinary action should not be taken against him for the aforesaid subversive acts.

12. Staff - Appointments & Extension.

(i) Miss. Jenid Surins application for appointment as co-ordinator for Church level Development Projects was considered -

Resolved that (i) a post of a Church Development Project co-ordinator (CDPC) be created with suitable pay scale.

(ii) Resolved th further that Miss. Jinid Surin be appointed to the post on the scale of present Managerial post from 1-8-85.

Be it understood that she is appointed as Coordinator for the whole church and will be responsible for preparation of and imparting training in preparation of projects for the development of the Church and their implementation and such other works as may from time to time be entrusted to her.

13. Auditors M/s. Singhee & Cos letter for settlement of bill of Rs. 19,000.

The letter was placed before the Sabha.

It was directed that the claim be verified and A/c. settled.

(ii) Rev. P. Minz's letter for payment of Rs. 1600 - The Accountant's note (as per direction of the KSS) was read. The KSS agreed that Rev. Minz was not entitled to the claim noting further that he has through promotion given to him been sufficiently rewarded.

14. Medical Bill Committee -

The Committee's recommendation on settlement of claims over Rs. is approved.

Court cases - list of -

List was read the Sabha noted with concern the increasing number of court cases. It however noted with satisfaction that they are being pursued.

15. Purulia Property - Repair of Publicity Office Building fixation of fare rent.

Letter of the West Bengal Ilaka Purulia (Shri. Pechak) was read.

Resolved that Board Of Property be asked to pursue the in after vigorously.

Resolved further that the special power of attorney to attend to rent and court cases be granted to someone who has the confidence of the Ilaka.

16. Revolving fund - grant of fund from -

Request of Debadih Parish for a refundable loan of Rs.25000 out of Revolving fund was read -

Resolved that Rs. 3000 be payment granted to the Parish for unmendrate and that possibility of grant of more be considered by the office.

17. Resignation of the Rev. Dr. C.K.P. Singh from all Committees Boards -

The Sabha felt that Dr. Singh has a clear call for dedicated service in the Church and therefore it can ill afford to be deprived of his talint and training he had at great cost both in terms of time and money.

The KSS therefore regrets its inability to accept his resignation.

18. F.T.T.C. Trust - Expiry of lease to - Renewal of lease -

The Sabha was informed that the lease of the FTTC to the Trust expires on 31-12-85. The members were also informed of the talks the Samiti had with the Director Gossner Mission on April 2.4.1985 meeting in the course of which he had suggested the desirability of continuing the ecumenical venture.

After due deliberation Resolved that the lease be renewed for a period of ten years.

19. G.M's 150 years Jubilee - Publication of Souvenier - Church's contribution of articles -

In the Samiti resolution of April 2-4-1985 the Director G.M. had suggested two subjects on which G.E.L.C. could contribute articles for the Souvnier.

Resolved that the Rev. Dr. N. Bage be requested to write article on

(i) "Strengthening of Autonomy - Brief history from 1919 to date" and the Rev. Dr. C.K.Paul Singh on (ii) "Situation of the G.E.L. Church Today.

That they be requested to submit articles to the KSS by 31 - 10 - 1985.

20. Pay Scale Revision Committee -

Reminded that a revision of the pay is due in 1986 a Committee consisting of the followings is constituted

- (1) Rev. C.B. A ind
- (2) Shri. B. Minz
- (3) Shri. P. Topno, Convener

The Committee may invite Rev. C.B. Minz and Shri. A. Barla to help.

Terms of reference -

- (a) The Committee will prepare proper classification of posts in the Church both for clergies and paymen.
- (b) determination of qualifications for different posts so classified.
- (c) revised pay scales for all categories of posts both on consideration of qualification and the nature of post.

The Committees recommendations should be available for consideration of the next Samiti for finalisation in the next full KSS before the year end.

The Office to obtain date from other Lutheran Churches in India for the Committees consideration.

21. Shri. P. Topno's resignation from membership of G.E.L.C. M/C.

The Sabha was informed of Shri. P. Topno's resignation

The Sabha just regrets its inability to accept it.

22. Amendment - Before the amendment to the constitution was taken up some members raised some doubts about the real import of the amendment made in 1974 in Article 25 doing away with the provision for corroborative vote.

To remove hinging doubts in some minds the Sabha feels that a circular be ussed with extracts from the Minutes of 1974 with relevant portions thereof for the edification of the KSS members.

Apart from the invitee 9 members were present. As the quorum was fulfilled the meeting was declared to be in order.

3. Matters arising out of the previous minutes :-

With much regret the Secretary reported that the minute book of the Board of Theological Education was missing. On this it was agreed upon that the report of institutions concerned and the extract from the minutes of the recent meetings (G.T.C. College council and Pracharak & Tabita Training School M.C.) be considered for further action. (viz Extract from the minute CC 21.3.85)

a. Extract from the minutes of the College Council held on 21st. March 1985.

Item No. 1. (a) Financial support of the College:- under this item all the 3 points were noted. The B.T.E. resolved to request the KSS to take immediate step on these points.

(b) P.F. Fund of the staff members during the time of Rev. M. Tote's Principalsip.

The chairman informed the Board that this matter is on the process.

(c) Staff Quarters -

This subject was also reported to have been on the process. The members therefore expressed that the immediate action be taken by the KSS so that the concerned persons/Institutions may not suffer for a long time.

It was reported that Rev. C. Hembrom has already joined the College with effect from 1.6.85.

5. Matters from Minutes of the last meeting held on 6-1-1985 - The Minutes was read and action there on were noted and decisions on matters needing further deliberations were taken up.

(a) Tujur land - Shri. P. Topno after giving back ground of the situation regarding Tujur property and recent developments reported the action taken thereon. He apprised the members that he had as Secretary KSS on the persistent request of three men delegation recently viz of Rev. J.S. Soy Tokad Ilaka, Rev. I.S. Lugun Tujur and Shri. Johan Hapadgara issued a letter to the Anchal Adhyaksh S.E. Anchal suggesting to the Anchal to take over the land for cultivation and to consider employment of Rev. I.S. Lugun who was here to before employed by the Property Board Approving the action of the KSS Secretary

- (i) the Board recommends to the KSS to hand over the Tujur properties until further orders to the S.E. Anchal and to
- (ii) arrange payments of salary falling in arrears to Rev. I.S. Lugun till the date of his employment by the S.E. Anchal.

(b) Good Books Education Trust -

Resolved further that one of the prerequisite conditions for renting out the above portion of the building is that the party will give a donation of amount sufficient with an area equal to the area that will be given on rent to the party.

(d) Lease to Bible Society -

Resolved that early steps be taken to execute registered deed of lease of the plot originally given to M/s. Ashajote Enterprises Ranchi.

6. Y.W.C.A's application for a long term lease of a plot -

After discussion

Resolved that the plot on the east of the GE's (MES) office and west of NG Sirom Toly (North) be leased out to the YWCA on suitable terms and conditions.

It is directed that early steps for executing lease deed be made.

7. Power of Attorney to Shri. V.M. Barla revocation of -

After careful consideration

Resolved that until further orders in this behalf the P/A be retained by Shri. V.M. Barla.

8. Shri. Johnson Toppo's application for a space for a shop room in the Bookland -

In principle it was agreed to let out a portion of the CCPH. (Bookland) on rent to Shri. Toppo on suitable terms and conditions on the strict understanding that on arrangement of another shop he will vacate it.

Pramukh Adhyaksh and another member will please visit the site and take steps for necessary action.

The meeting closed with prayer for the day deciding to meet in the evening again.

The Secretary read out a press clipping of statesman 19-6-85 regarding forcible occupation of St. Johns Church land at Agra UP. to impress upon the members to be careful in our management of our properties. Nothing therefore with concern the Board decided that wherever possible steps for proper utilisation of vacant urban land be taken by the Church.

10. Khuntitoly properties - sale on 4-6-85 of ATC & farm machineries and implements etc for Rs. 60,000.

The Pramukh Adhyaksh read out the Madhya Anchal Samiti's resolution approving the report of the Anchal Secretary to the Pramukh Adhyaksh.

The Secretary then read out the earlier letter of the Anchal Secretary Shri. A. Lakra dated 10-6-85 reporting unauthorised sale of machineries.

After listening to Rev. M. Tete Adhyaksh and Shri. A. Lakra Secretary the Board felt convinced that the transaction was wholly unauthorised. The members learnt that FIR was made on 12-6-85 and the case is now in the court. It was therefore resolved that the matter be compromised by collecting back the goods sold and refunding the amount of Rs. 25,000 collected so far from the party.

In case no compromise is reached. Resolved that the Board of Properties take necessary steps to pursue the case in the Court of Simdega with the help of the local members who filed FI.

11. Mahila Samiti's application dated 26-6-1985 -

Resolved that reminding the Samiti of the earlier resolution of the KSS the Samiti be asked to submit a detailed project report further they be informed of the KSS inability to allot Lal Bungalow for them as the same to ear marked for a Guest House.

His application for employment by the KSS was considered.

Resolved that he be absorbed in the KSS service on a pay of Rs. 250 PM. from 1-7-85 to look after the Bungalow compound.

YEARLY REPORT (1984)

Annexure 'D'

As the Director, BEL was free from various other main responsibilities (i.e. Acting Principalship GTC). It was being thought in the beginning of the year to revitalise the work of BEL. But every thing did not go in the way as planned. The following reports may be understood in this background.

I. TOUR PROGRAMMES :- As already reported in the half yearly report (Jan. - June '84) extensive and detail tour programmes were made in the m/f of SE Anchal. In the second half of the year it had been planned to visit the m/fs of NWA, but due to sickness in the family, Director could not carry out it. In the m/f of MA. the area was covered during the practical Training Programme of GTC.

II. REFRESHER COURSE :- For 1984 Refresher Courses were conducted in two places, one at Sitapur for NWA and MA Anchal m/fs and in Manoharpur for SEA and O. Anchals. The Epistle of St. James was taken for Bible study. The texts were discussed in different groups relating the same in the situation of the fields. In reports from the fields specially new proposals and projects were discussed. We had 'Leadership Training' in June for the volunteers of the m/fs.

III. PUBLICATIONS :- In addition to the publication of small books like Aradhana and Katechism in different languages used in the church, the major publication of Sakshi Vani was started. In Jan. 85 we have received some copies of the books. We are preparing m/s for printing Susamachar Bhajnawali, 3rd Edition. This is a great asset for our works in the field.

IV. FINANCE :- We thankfully acknowledge that available finance could be disbursed fully by the end of the year, though with 27% deduction based in 1983 pay scale salary. We could give some amount for construction also.

V. READING ROOMS/LEADERSHIP TRAINING CENTRE :- There is no new progress in the site, however the programmes under the project-Leadership Training of Volunteers, Correspondence Course, etc are being continued. We are still not able to carry out 'On the site Works' due to the critical situations in the Compound.

VI. REPORTS FROM THE FIELD :- As in previous years reports are still irregular. Even in the last week of Feb. 85 some reports are not available. We summarize the reports submitted to us as follows.

1. UDAIPUR M/F (NW ANCHAL) :-

There are altogether 29 co-workers (2 Pastors + 1 Pracharika + 26 Evangelists), in the field. Three new centres have been started altogether 63 persons have been baptised. The m/f has been very badly affected by the church-division politics, Court cases are also being instituted.

Steps had been taken for construction and repair works; in Pathalgao Land could be settled in the name of the church. There are also some external forces which are making troubles in the area. But inspite of these troubles and difficulties the work in the field is progressing.

2. SE ANCHAL M/F (SE. ANCHAL) :-

There are 40 co-workers (6 Pastors + 42 Evangelists) with some Part-  
ners in the District of Singhbhum (Bihar), Mayurbhanj (Orissa), and  
Midnapur (W. Bengal). There are 54 centres in the field after transfe-  
rring 5 congregations to the Ilaka. Altogether 364 persons were bap-  
tised in this year. The works in the area was carried on by way of  
proclaiming the Gospal in Dharmmela, Prayer Meetings, by teaching and  
helping people in their needs during Night Schools, Sunday Schools and  
other occasions in their own houses. There were also programmes made  
for the people that they may come together as often as possible.  
Construction and repair works were also carried on, the church constr-  
uction at Nakti is almost complete. The financial condition is not  
quite good, however the field has its own programmes of creating some  
funds for projects, saving scheme, etc. There are some external, though  
local, problems, and specially that of Puja Chanda.

3. SURGUJA M/F (NWA) :-

The field has 69 co-workers along with 8 Pastors, there are also 11  
volunteers. In 1984 altogether 157 persons have been baptised. But  
there are programmes and efforts to consolidate and strengthen the  
Christians in sound faith: Sundy Schools, Mata Samaj, Youth groups,  
Bible Classes are being conducted in different areas. Night Schools  
are also conducted by few workers.  
Small construction works at Bishrampur is yet to be completed. The  
financial condition due to 27% cut has affected the field adversely.

4. SUNDARGARH/SAMBALPUR M/F (O. ANCHAL) :-

There are four Pastor with 23 evangelists in the area. Some of the  
congregations have been transferred to the Ilaka. The work in the field  
is still disarrayed. The workers have seen involved in their own works,  
for daily life, Night Schools are also almost neglected, except in  
some four Places. There is no organised programme and project for the  
field. But in some local places, working and its results are encour-  
aging. Altogether 27 persons were baptised in 1984. There are problems  
from within and outside. The working relationship with the Anchal is  
not satisfactory thus spiritual slackness and financial situation are  
very much hampering the work. There are some local-external problems  
which are also disturbing the work.

5. KARBI ANGLONG M/F (A. ASSAM) :-

There are 10 co-workers (1 Pastors + 1 Cand. + 7 Pracharaks + 1 Pra-  
charika). Two new centres have been started in this year, and alto-  
gether 64 persons have been baptised.

For teaching and preaching Christian Gospal Bible Class, convention  
Sunday Schools and Youth Programmes are conducted. The Programme and  
project of fisci-and agriculture have been also started at Rangagora.  
There is also a private English School at Rangagora. For better and  
fruitful works some more workers are needed. They have also requested  
to make provisions for two young people for Training in GTC and in PTS.

VII. SOME REMARKS AND RECOMMENDATION :-

A. Some fields are unable to coordinate the works among themselves  
financially as well as administratively. It is high time that the  
Anchals have to re-organise and re-evaluate the works in respect of  
their works as well as workers.

- B. The BEL has to rethink and replan to utilise its available funds for fruitful works in the fields. At the same time Anchals also have to fulfill their responsibility in regard with their support to the field financially.
- C. Some of the Supervisors have involved themselves in Anchal Administrative office/Post and thus are busy in the administrative problems. It will be very difficult to carry out the works in the m/f. Anchal and supervisor concerned are to re-think and re-organise their works with these regards also.
- D. Better co-ordination and co-operations between the Anchal and the respective field is to be taken very essential for fruitful result of the work.

III. Matters from Previous Minutes :

(a) Publications : It was reported that S.Bani has been printed and is available for use. Some copies are still to be delivered by the press. It was further reported that Susmacharak Bhajnawali (of BEL) is underprint. The matter of O.T. and N.T. ITIHAS was raised, it was reported that due to some technicalities from the KSS side these books are not yet processed for the printing.

After long discussions taking into consideration the need of these books and also of KURUKH DANDI and KHARI ALONG it was resolved that the KSS be requested to take necessary steps that these books be published as early as possible.

(b) Pay Scale of Rev. J. Kandulna : It was reported that the Assistant to the Director, Rev. J. Kandulna has been ordained as per decision of the KSS and his salary was to be fixed in according to his academic qualifications, in this some difficulties arose in interpreting the fitting in process.

It was resolved that - He be fitted in the pay scale of the ordained pastor with its starting pay of that academic qualifications.

IV. Finance : The Director BEL reported and pointed out extracts from the visit report of the Director G.M. Specially it was reported on the points in connection with Finance of BEL/mfs. During discussions various points were raised for clarifications and for means and methods of full payments to the workers. e.g. actual loss, difference of payments with that of other workers, five point programmes, Gramodya Ashrama. etc. After long discussions it was resolved that the KSS be requested to take necessary steps to give full payment for the workers in the m/f's partly by requesting for

enhanced grants and partly by taking special steps within the Anchals for this. While requesting for enhanced grants BEL also be alert to take necessary steps for better pictures for allround working programmes and possible projects, daily report be stressed.

Further it was also resolved that the Director, BEL be authorised to set up such possible programmes and projects which may be practicable and fruitful in the field.

V. Other Matters : (a) General administration and reports; It was reported that some supervisors have been involved in administrative functions of the respective Anchals. This is in contrary to the General understanding of the BEL and practically it may lead to certain problems and the concerned workers may not be able to concentrate primarily in the mfs works for producing better results and reports. After much discussions it was resolved that the workers and supervisors of mfs. be not involved in the administrative set up and functions of the Anchals. Anchals be directed to take necessary steps accordingly.

VI. Leadership Training Centre : The Director, BEL verbally reported the progress and functions within this Leadership Training Centre (formerly Reading Rooms) Projects, etc. Volunteers' Training Programme and Correspondence Course conducted by the BEL. In this June '85 Volunteers' Refresher Course was conducted in which 19 participants were present. Due to local problems and preference number, the construction and 'on the spot works' are not in progress.

The project was discussed and explained in view of working programmes by the BEL and it was resolved that - The project Leadership Training Centre be continued and its identity be kept.

It was also further resolved that the Director BEL be authorised to take necessary steps to continue and conduct different programmes.

VII. Closing : It was agreed to close the meeting after authorising the available members to confirm the minutes.

In principle it was agreed to let out a portion of the CCPH. (Bookland) on rent to Shri. Toppo on suitable terms and conditions on the strict understanding that on arrangement of another shop he will vacate it.

Pramukh Adhyaksh and another member will please visit the site and take steps for necessary action.

The meeting closed with prayer for the day deciding to meet in the evening again.

26-6-85.

The resumed meeting started at 9 AM. after due notice of the change of time. The meeting started with prayer by the chairman.

9. The Secretary read out a press clipping of statesman 19-6-85 regarding forcible occupation of St. Johns Church land at Agra UP. to impress upon the members to be careful in our management of our properties. Nothing therefore with concern the Board decided that wherever possible steps for proper utilisation of vacant urban land be taken by the Church.

10. Khunti tely properties - sale on 4-6-85 of ATC & farm machineries and implements etc for Rs. 60,000.

The Pramukh Adhyaksh read out the Madhya Anchal Samiti's resolution approving the report of the Anchal Secretary to the Pramukh Adhyaksh.

The Secretary then read out the earlier letter of the Anchal Secretary Shri. A. Lakra dated 10-6-85 reporting unauthorised sale of machineries.

After listening to Rev. M. Tete Adhyaksh and Shri. A. Lakra Secretary the Board felt convinced that the transaction was wholly unauthorised. The members learnt that FIR was made on 12-6-85 and the case is now in the court. It was therefore resolved that the matter be compromised by collecting back the goods sold and refunding the amount of Rs. 25,000 collected so far from the party.

In case no compromise is reached. Resolved that the Board of Properties take necessary steps to pursue the case in the Court of Simdega with the help of the local members who filed FI.

11. Mahila Samiti's application dated 26-6-1985 -

Resolved that reminding the Samiti of the earlier resolution of the KSS the Samiti be asked to submit a detailed project report further they be informed of the KSS inability to allot Lal Bungalow for them as the same to ear marked for a Guest House.

12. Lal Bungalow chowkidar cum Mali -

His application for employment by the KSS was considered.

Resolved that he be absorbed in the KSS service on a pay of Rs. 250 PM. from 1-7-85 to look after the Bungalow compound.

13. Staff Matters - It was reported that services of Sarb Shri -

(1) Victor Nandi and

(2) Caleph Guria are not necessary any longer.

Resolved therefore that their services be terminated with effect from 1-7-85 after payment of one months pay ie salary for July 1985 along with salary of June 1985 in ten of one months notice of termination.

14. Shri. P. Topno a member of the Board of Property is until further orders elected as Secretary of the Board purely in temporary basis.

15. Promotion of Miss Jinid Purti -

Resolved that She be promoted as an UDC on ful fillmant of conditions by her for promotion.

BOARD OF EVANGELISM AND LITERATURE  
YEARLY REPORT (1984)

As the Director, BEL was free from various other main responsibilities (i.e. Acting Principalship GTC). It was being thought in the beginning of the year to revitalise the work of BEL. But every thing did not go in the way as planned. The following reports may be understood in this background.

I. TOUR PROGRAMMES :- As already reported in the half yearly report (Jan. - June '84) extensive and detail tour programmes were made in the m/f of SE Anchal. In the second half of the year it had been planned to visit the m/fs of NWA, but due to sickness in the family, Director could not carry out it. In the m/f of MA. the area was covered during the practical Training Programme of GTC.

II. REFRESHER COURSE :- For 1984 Refresher Courses were conducted in two places, one at Sitapur for NWA and MA Anchal m/fs and in Manoharpur for SEA and O. Anchals. The Epistle of St. James was taken for Bible study. The texts were discussed in different groups relating the same in the situation of the fields. In reports from the fields specially new proposals and projects were discussed. We had 'Leadership Training' in June for the volunteers of the m/fs.

III. PUBLICATIONS :- In addition to the publication of small books like Aradhana and Katechism in different languages used in the church, the major publication of Sakshi Vani was started. In Jan. 85 we have received some copies of the books. We are preparing m/s for printing Susamachar Bhajnawali, 3rd Edition. This is a great asset for our works in the field.

IV. FINANCE :- We thankfully acknowledge that available finance could be disbursed fully by the end of the year, though with 27% deduction based in 1983 pay scale salary. We could give some amount for construction also.

V. READING ROOMS/LEADERSHIP TRAINING CENTRE :- There is no new progress in the site, however the programmes under the project-Leadership Training of Volunteers, Correspondence Course, etc are being continued. We are still not able to carry out 'On the site Works' due to the critical situations in the Compound.

VI. REPORTS FROM THE FIELD :- As in previous years reports are still irregular. Even in the last week of Feb. 85 some reports are not available. We summarize the reports submitted to us as follows.

1. UDAIPUR M/F (NW ANCHAL) :-

There are altogether 29 co-workers ( 2 Pastors + 1 Pracharika + 26 Evangelists), in the field. Three new centres have been started altogether 63 persons have been baptised. The m/f has been very badly affected by the church-division politics, Court cases are also being instituted.

Steps had been taken for construction and repair works; in Pathalgaoon Land could be settled in the name of the church. There are also some external forces which are making troubles in the area. But inspite of these troubles and difficulties the work in the field is progressing.

2. SE ANCHAL M/F (SE. ANCHAL) :-

There are 40 co-workers (6 Pastors + 42 Evangelists) with some Part-timers in the District of Singhbhum (Bihar), Mayurbhanj (Orissa), and Midnapur (W. Bengal). There are 54 centres in the field after transferring 5 congregations to the Ilaka. Altogether 364 persons were baptised in this year. The works in the area was carried on by way of proclaiming the Gospel in Dharmmela, Prayer Meetings, by teaching and helping people in their needs during Night Schools, Sunday Schools and other occasions in their own houses. There were also programmes made for the people that they may come together as often as possible. Construction and repair works were also carried on, the church construction at Nakti is almost complete. The financial condition is not quite good, however the field has its own programmes of creating some funds for projects, saving scheme, etc. There are some external, though local, problems, and specially that of Puja Chanda.

3. SURGUJA M/F (NWA) :-

The field has 69 co-workers along with 8 Pastors, there are also 11 volunteers. In 1984 altogether 157 persons have been baptised. But there are programmes and efforts to consolidate and strengthen the Christians in sound faith: Sunday Schools, Mata Samaj, Youth groups, Bible Classes are being conducted in different areas. Night Schools are also conducted by few workers.

Small construction works at Bishrampur is yet to be completed. The financial condition due to 27% cut has affected the field adversely.

4. SUNDARGARH/SAMBALPUR M/F (O. ANCHAL) :-

There are four Pastor with 23 evangelists in the area. Some of the congregations have been transferred to the Ilaka. The work in the field is still disarrayed. The workers have seen involved in their own works, for daily life, Night Schools are also almost neglected, except in some four Places. There is no organised programme and project for the field. But in some local places, working and its results are encouraging. Altogether 27 persons were baptised in 1984. There are problems from within and outside. The working relationship with the Anchal is not satisfactory thus spiritual slackness and financial situation are very much hampering the work. There are some local-external problems which are also disturbing the work.

5. KARBI ANGLONG M/F (A. ASSAM) :-

There are 10 co-workers (1 Pastors + 1 Cand. + 7 Pracharaks + 1 Pracharika). Two new centres have been started in this year, and altogether 64 persons have been baptised.

For teaching and preaching Christian Gospel Bible Class, convention Sunday Schools and Youth Programmes are conducted. The Programme and project of fisci-and agriculture have been also started at Rangagora. There is also a private English School at Rangagora. For better and fruitful works some more workers are needed. They have also requested to make provisions for two young people for Training in GTC and in PTS.

VII. SOME REMARKS AND RECOMMENDATION :-

A. Some fields are unable to coordinate the works among themselves financially as well as administratively. It is high time that the Anchals have to re-organise and re-evaluate the works in respect of their works as well as workers.

- B. The BEL has to rethink and replan to utilise its available funds. for fruitful works in the fields. At the same time Anchals also have to fulfill their responsibility in regard with their support to the field financially.
- C. Some of the Supervisors have involved themselves in Anchal Administrative office/Post and thus are busy in the administrative problems. It will be very difficult to carry out the works in the m/f. Anchal and supervisor concerned are to re-think and re-organise their works with these regards also.
- D. Better co-ordination and co-operations between the Anchal and the respective field is to be taken very essential for fruitful result of the work.

III. Matters from Previous Minutes :

(a) Publications : It was reported that S.Bani has been printed and is available for use. Some copies are still to be delivered by the press. It was further reported that Susmacharak Bhajnawali (of BEL) is underprint. The matter of O.T. and N.T. ITIHAS was raised, it was reported that due to some technicalities from the KSS side these books are not yet processed for the printing.

After long discussions taking into consideration the need of these books and also of KURUKH DANDI and KHARIA ALONG it was resolved that the KSS be requested to take necessary steps that these books be published as early as possible.

(b) Pay Scale of Rev. J. Kandulna : It was reported that the Assistant to the Director, Rev. J. Kandulna has been ordained as per decision of the KSS and his salary was to be fixed in accordance to his academic qualifications, in this some difficulties arose in interpreting the fitting in process. It was resolved that - He be fitted in the pay scale of the ordained pastor with its starting pay of that academic qualifications.

IV. Finance : The Director BEL reported and pointed out extracts from the visit report of the Director G.M. Specially it was reported on the points in connection with Finance of BEL/mfs. During discussions various points were raised for clarifications and for means and methods of full payments to the workers. e.g. actual loss, difference of payments with that of other workers, five point programmes, Gramodya Ashrama, etc. After long discussions it was resolved that the KSS be requested to take necessary steps to give full payment for the workers in the m/f's partly by requesting for

enhanced grants and partly by taking special steps within the Anchals for this. While requesting for enhanced grants BEL also be alert to take necessary steps for better pictures for allround working programmes and possible projects, daily report be stressed.

Further it was also resolved that the Director, BEL be authorised to set up such possible programmes and projects which may be practicable and fruitful in the field.

V. Other Matters : (a) General administration and reports; It was reported that some supervisors have been involved in administrative functions of the respective Anchals. This is in contrary to the General understanding of the BEL and practically it may lead to certain problems and the concerned workers may not be able to concentrate primarily in the mfs works for producing better results and reports. After much discussions it was resolved that the workers and supervisors of mfs. be not involved in the administrative set up and functions of the Anchals. Anchals be directed to take necessary steps accordingly.

VI. Leadership Training Centre : The Director, BEL verbally reported the progress and functions within this Leadership Training Centre (formerly Reading Rooms) Projects, etc. Volunteers' Training Programme and Correspondence Course conducted by the BEL. In this June '85 Volunteers' Refresher Course was conducted in which 19 participants were present. Due to local problems and preference number, the construction and 'on the spot works' are not in progress.

The project was discussed and explained in view of working programmes by the BEL and it was resolved that -  
The project Leadership Training Centre be continued and its identity be kept.  
It was also further resolved that the Director BEL be authorised to take necessary steps to continue and conduct different programmes.

VII. Closing : It was agreed to close the meeting after authorising the available members to confirm the minutes.

The meeting was closed with a word of prayer offered by the Chairman, Rev. S. Mohan MG.

# THE UNITED EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCHES IN INDIA DELHI DECLARATION ON PEACE, AMITY AND RENEWAL

## **Preamble**

*The Indian Lutheran Churches gathered here as the All India Lutheran Conference in New Delhi during December 6 - 7, 1983 do affirm our solidarity as Lutheran Churches and thank God that we have been called to serve Him in this vast country of ours.*

*We are, however, today in the midst of struggle which may not be a bad thing per se as it is important to get rid of dead wood and affirm the centrality of Christ in the life of the Church. Quite often only local administrative problems are blown up completely out of proportion and sometimes create national and even international tensions which also cause unwarranted misunderstandings between the Churches and the Overseas partners. These fissiparous tendencies often become acrimonious resulting in the total negation of the teachings of the Bible.*

*The UELCI is greatly concerned about these developments. While recognising that the devil is working continuously and that the wolves continue to infiltrate into the Church in the garb of sheep, we must all work with renewed zeal for the upbuilding of the Church in the spirit of peace and amity.*

*We, therefore, pledge ourselves to make the following declaration.*

## **Declaration**

*The UELCI, in its Delhi meeting in December 1983 under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, declares that to start with, the next three years be observed as a period of sustained effort to bring about a climate of peace, amity and commitment to our faith in Lord Jesus Christ through repentance and renewal of Church and Society.*

## **Call to Churches**

*The UELCI calls upon all its constituent churches to urgently assess the extent of the problems and plan and implement concerted remedial measures on a priority basis to restore faith, peace and amity within the respective churches so that an appropriate atmosphere for constructive development and renewal of the church is created.*

*We, hereby, call the Churches to take suitable action to implement these measures through their various ministries such as women's groups, youth groups, brotherhood groups, pastors and conventions as well as through Gurukul programmes.*

*Let us also make these concerns part of our prayers and intercessions at the family, group and church levels in order that the Lord's healing touch may cure the endemic sickness that affects the Church in order that Church may become whole.*
