A meeting of Women's Boards including the C.C. officers, Dr. J. Roy Strock and Mr. J. Barla set in the office of the C.C. on 1.7.47 in which the following points were discussed :-

(1) 6 months Bible Course at Burju :- Reported by the ladies concerned that only 5 students turned up but they were found very weak and of under-age. It was therefore thought proper to drop even this scheme.

After a careful consideration it was recommended that the scheme be continued and the students be allowed to attend class 7th of the Lutheran M.E. School Burju without any fee. They should attend the selected subjects and in the remaining periods, the Scriptures be taught and they should do practical work. The management are entirely left in the hand of the ladies concerned.

(b) Recommended that the expenses of these students be met out of the C.C. grant for the Short Course Bible Training and the ladies concerned are requested to make some saving out of the budgeted sum.

(2) Tabitha School :- It was further reported that the leaders' training or any other short course training does not produce the quality required by our Church for Pracharikas. The ladies in-charge therefore strongly request the C.C. to allow them to open the Tabitha School (Bible Training School) for two year course. They also undertake not to put any financial burden upon the C.C. and they desire very much that they should be allowed to open the Tabitha School with effect from January 1948 and they request that the action of the C.C. on this matter be communicated to them as early as possible.



Minutes of the first meeting of the Board of Education held in the C.C. Office on 1-5-47.

Members present:- Rev. J. Lakra, Mr. P. C. Horo, Mr. Z. Horo, Miss. K. C. Sokey, Mr. J. Barla-Convener.

Prayer:- The meeting was opened with a short prayer by Mr. Barla.

Following business was transacted:-

1. Certain urgent matters may be dealt with and disposed of by the Head Supervisor and Lady Supervisor and report of the same be submitted to the Board of Education.

Similarly matters of urgency and importance decided by the Board be executed even before the formal approval of the C.C. and report of the same be submitted to the C.C. by the respective officers.

2. Applications:-

(a) Purulia Schools:- The Head Supervisor may continue his correspondence with the Chair man Purulia Municipality and a request be made to the Chairman to hand over the Schools not later than June 47.

(b). Kochedega school:- REcommended to the C.C. that Rs.10/- p.m. be granted to the school.

(c). Kaifmati School:-The Ilaka be informed that according to the opinion of the 'Am Sabha', both languages may continue-Oriya as the medium of instruction according to State rules; and Hindi as one of the subjects.

(d) Headmaster for Marcha School:- The Ilaka be asked to report to the C.C. if they are ready to support a full time Headmaster at Marcha from June 47.. The Board also feels the necessity of a full time Pastor and a full time Hdmaster.

(e) Mr. R. Kerketta's request:-Recommended that Rs.25/- be paid to Mr. Kerketta as a special help from the School.

(f) Bethesda School matters:-The M.C.'s resolutions be forwarded with recommendation to the C.C. for approval. ✕

(g) Services outside the Church:- In calculating the time scale salary, services outside the church will not be taken into consideration; but increment be added to the present pay which has been fixed in consideration of the previous experience of workers.

(h) Payment of increment falling due even now:- This may be deferred for the time being.

✕ As regards the Secretaryship, it may be reconsidered by the Church Council with the suggestion that in some cases a separate Secretary may be allowed.

(1): Scale of pay for Messrs. I. S. Kujur, A. Horo, J. Bage, and C. M. Mundu. :-- In ~~view~~ consideration of their experience and qualification the four teachers may be given a maximum of Rs. 40/- on their scale of pay.

3. In order to bring about uniformity in all the schools following recommendations are made to the C. C. :--

(a) Same text books in different schools for different subjects be followed. Heads of Goswami, Eidnaes, Bethesda, Hda supervisor and Lady Supervisor should prescribe the necessary texts.

(b) Bible Examination with uniform questions for different classes be held on the same date in all the schools. It should conveniently precede the Annual Examination.

(c) Model Rules adopted by the Church Council be uniformly enforced in all the High Schools and Proposed High Schools in the Church.

The minutes of the first meeting of the Board of Education are hereby respectfully submitted to the Church Council for the needful.

The President led in prayer.

I. Constitution:—

The Constitution submitted to the Mahasabha through the C.C. was considered in detail and Resolved that

1. The Constitution as amended be accepted as whole.

2. The organisations among the women, young girls and children be re-organised

in order to bring them under the Mahila Sammelan.

3. Krush Sena should be entirely for the boys and Tara Sena for the girls, but there should be occasional joint gatherings.

4. The Ilaka Mahila Sanitee Secretary be allowed to give reports of the Women Department ^{at} ~~and~~ the monthly Ilaka meeting and also take reports from the Precharaks ^{Church} or ~~workers~~ Karmacharis of the Ilaka, present in the Ilaka meeting.

II. Sammelan Sauchalaks:-

It was reported that Misses Diller and Schmidt have refused to be the President and Treasurer of the Mahila Sammelan.

After Consideration it was resolved that Mrs. Strock be appointed as President and Miss K. C. Soley as Secretary and Treasurer until the 1st. Convension of the Mahila Sammelan.

III. Precharikas Refresher Course:-

It was reported that the Precharikas refresher Course is in session since

April 9, and at Buryu and will continue till May 1, 1947.

That some Ibakas refused to pay the travelling, 8 srs. of rice and one sr. of dal to their Pracharikas.

After discussion it was resolved that the Pracharikas from the Ilakas who are not paying extra amount for their Pracharikas including the expences for the Pracharikas refresher course be taken away from them ^{after warning} and given to those Ilakas who will be willing to pay these expences.

It was further resolved that Pracharika Haimi Samad be transferred to one of the Ilakas where there is no Pracharika as ~~Khuti-toli has two~~ there are two in Khuti-toli.

IV. Plan II : — was fully considered and resolved that —

„Instead of training Course for leaders a six months course for Pracharikas be held with the same amount and the C.C. be requested to give assurance that these new Pracharikas will be appointed employed.

That Anises Diller & Schmidt be in

Charge of the Course and the Hd. Pracharika & the Superintendent help the occasionally.

V. Plan III :— Was thoroughly discussed along with the suggestions given by Messrs Diller and Schmidt.

After full consideration it was resolved to start a training school for girls in 1948 for 2 years only with basic training hrs at Ranchi and Musie. Sohey he instructed to make all the preliminary arrangements with the department and report by the middle of July.

The Budget which Costs Rs 4000/- for 1948 he recommended.

It is also recommended that as much as possible the syllabus which has been prepared for Religious Instruction and Domestic economy be incorporated in the above scheme.

VI. A New Pracharika for Puruba;—

The Board approves the action of the Superintendent in appointing Surji Sal as Pracharika in the place of Carolina Das who died.

VII. Untrained Pracharikas;—

The Ilakas are
