Dear Sir,

With reference to your Office No. 1459/44/F-62,
dated 7th July, 1944, I beg to submit the following :-

1. Mr. M. Khess expressed his desire to buy the jack fruits of the tree just to the Bethesda School, (formerly occupied by Mr. Munzni) on behalf of the Bethesda Staff, when the fruits were too young to settle the price sometime early in May. I gave him the word to sell the fruits to him then. But as I was away from Ranchi for a long time he was not able to pay the price until 5-7-44 when I received Rs 8/- only from him for the jack fruits. This amount I have deposited on 7-7-44 ~~to~~ to the Secretary Board of Management.

2. What you remember about the price of the jack fruits of the tree in question, 'enjoyed by the Church Council in former years' is entirely wrong. I wonder how you can remember things which have never occurred.

3. Since the time I am in charge of selling the fruits of this tree I have regularly deposited the price of it every year to the Secretary, Board of Management. And by enquiring the Acct. Book of the Board I find that the Board is receiving the price of the tree every year since 1933.

4. Regarding the house in question I beg to point out that the Rent of ~~Rs~~ Rs 2/- per month is due to the Board since the time the Bethesda is holding the classes. The Secretary of the Board has written several letters to the C.C. as to who will pay the rent and the matter is still pending with the Council.

5. Under these circumstances I see that the question of invalidity of my selling the fruits does not arise.

To clear up the matter please arrange to refund the amount of Rs 10/- to the person from whom it has been received.

Dear Mr. Surin,

Thanks for your letter No. 2164/42/F.30 dated 16.10.1942 in reply to my letters Nos. 441/42, 442/42 and 440/42, all dated 13.10.42, and also for the copy of your letter No. 2171-73 /42/F.58 dated 16.10.42 to Dr. I. Cannaday on the subject of British Cemetery at Ranchi .

1. With regard to your request in my letter No. 441/42 I beg to give the following information :-

a. The bigger bungalow at Jharsuguda was occupied by the Kanika Raj from 1st April till the 31st July 1942, It was reserved by them as a precautionary measure on account of the fear of Air raids and invasion of Orissa by the Japanese. On the 15th August, an officer of the Tatas engaged the bungalow on a rent of Rs.50/- per month and paying the rent in advance for one month occupied it. But the Head Office at Jamshedpur wired to him to vacate it immediately and so after two days' occupation the officer had to vacate it. The Deputy Commissioner of Sambalpur then negotiated for the bungalow and the P.W.D. occupied it from the 1st August 1942 on a rent of Rs.60/- per month.

b. The Smaller bungalow at Chaibassa was occupied by the Extra Assistant Recruiting Officer from the 2nd July 1942 on a rent of Rs.35/- per month.

c. The rents of the two bungalows at Jharsuguda and that of the Smaller bungalow at Chaibassa go to the Board's Treasury as these three bungalows are under the direct management of the Board.

d. No boundary wall has been built at Jharsuguda, but pagars have been raised and hedging plants have been planted on the boundaries. In this connection please refer to your letter No. 2121-23/42 F.21 dated 12.10.1942, in which you write that the C.C. Executive have directed the local pastor and Mr. N. Toppo to look into the matter of demarcation. I have been waiting for their report.

2. With regard to your remarks in connection with my letter No. 442/42, I do not wish to say in writing at present. I think the matters ought to be discussed face to face at a meeting.

3. With regard to your reply in regard to my letter No. 440/42, the contents have been noted and it is hoped that the rents received for the requisitioned bungalows at Ranchi have by now deposited in the Bengal Central Bank, Ranchi, in the joint names of the Treasurer and Secretary of the Church Council as decided by the latter.

With reference to your letter No. 2232/42/F-30 d/- 27.10.1942

forwarding me extract from the Minutes of the full C.C. meeting held from 3-7 October, 1942 in respect of Item No. 32, I beg to state as follows:-

(1) The Minutes of the Mission Trust of Northern India from 1919 to 1929 and these of the Board of Trustees from 1929 to 1939 are comprised in two big volumes containing about 1 ream of thin typing paper in each. The Minutes of the Board of Management from 1940 to 1942 have not been bound yet. They are contained in about 3 quires of thin paper.

(2) At present thin typing paper is not available in the market. I tried to get it at Ranchi and Purulia, but without success.

(3) White foolscap paper on which 3 to 4 copies can be obtained was purchased by me on 23.10.42 for the use of Board of Management's Office for Rs 6/4/- a ream. The paper dealer supplied me with one ream only and said that he could not give me more than this quantity.

(4) I have got a clerk, Babu Hardugan Horo, to assist me in keeping the accounts of the Board of Management and for typing my correspondence. He is a regular Government servant and works as a Typist in the District Judge's Court at Purulia. He works daily 2 hours in the office of the Board of Management and is paid Rs 10/- (Rupees ten) only for his part-time work by the Board of Management. It is impossible for him to type all the Minutes.

(5) If an outsider be engaged to do the typing of the Minutes at a contract rate, the cost of mere typing will come to about Rs 80/- to Rs 100/- per volume and if he devotes 10 hours per day for them he will be able to finish typing all the Minutes in about two months' time.

(6) It will be perhaps a bit cheaper if the Church Council arranges for paper and a good typist and I shall give him the Minutes to be typed.

(7) Please let me know the Church Council's decision in the matter.

For the information of the Church Council I beg to
report to you the following :—

1. The bigger bungalow at Jharsuguda has been given to the Deputy Commissioner, Sambalpur ,for the use of the Superintending Engineer of Orissa as his office on a rent of Rs.60/- per month from August 1942 . The Kanika Raj had engaged it on a rent of Rs.40/- per month ,but it was never actually occupied by the Raj, though it paid the rent regularly .
2. The Smaller bungalow at Chaib^assa has been engaged by the S.D.O Chaibassa for an office of the Extra Assistant Recruiting Officer from July 1942 . The old rent of Rs.35/- per month is being paid by the latter officer .
3. The Lal Bungalow at Purulia has been made over to the A.R.P. Officer ,Purulia, for use as Reserved Hospital ,from to-day ,the 13th October 1942 . It was occupied by the S.D.O. of Purulia and the Senior Deputy Magistrate . They vacated the bungalow on learning that the A.R.P. Officer required it . The rent will be the same as before i.e. Rs.40/- per month . I demanded Rs.50/- per month , but the P.W.D. Sub Divisional Officer valued it at Rs.40/- per month rent .

As the negotiations were done amicably there was no need for a requisition under the Defence of India Rules .

Thanks for your letter No.2104/42/F-30 dated 8th October 1942 ,forwarding to me Extract from the Minutes of the C.C.Executive Committee held on the 31st August,1942 in regard to Item No.238.

The collection of rents from the tenants of the Church in the Church compound at Chaibassa seems apparently to be satisfactory .But without details about tenants and their rents it is not possible to say what is the income there .

Regarding the defaulting tenants at Chakradharpur the local pastor had sent a list to you .You sent it on to me for legal action . It was returned to you for furnishing certain details and also for instruction from the Church Council who should take legal action against the defaulters and from what funds the legal-action expenses should be met .

It is noted that the office of the Church Council took about a month and a half to send an extract from the Minutes of the Executive Committee . Where some action is to be taken some expedition should be made .

(1) I have just received your letter 298/42 dated the 29th July 1942. The President is making correspondence with the Military authorities for the lists of Furnitures of the requisitioned bungalows of the G.E.L.Church, Ranchi. The lists have not yet been received from them. These lists were in origin submitted to them by the Rev. J.J.P.Tiga in March 1942 without keeping any copy of them and without a forwarding letter. With great affords the President could dig them out. Now the military authorities have admitted that they have received lists of furnitures in origin and also in duplicate or triplicate. They have promised to sign on all the lists and then they will be sent to the President. I shall send you complete lists of furnitures on receipt of those lists.

(2) The Rev. Habil Topno of Singhani has written me on 28-7-42 that Rent Suit has been instituted against the Church for Rs. 70/- only being the arrears of rent and cess for the Church properties at Barhaw, in the Court at Hazaribagh and the dated 10-8-1942. Please see to it.

(3) The Church Supervisor Rev. L. Jojowar has written me on the 14th of July 1942 from Jharsuguda, on the Church Compound there. He says in the letter " Ek bishes bat dhayn dene ke jogya hai ki compound ka ghera thik karna hai. ' Encroachment' ka bahut dar hai jaisa Dr. Nallathambi ne 1939 men kiya hai, jis par Board of Management G.E.L. Church Properties ne kuchh nahin kiya hai." I suggest that it should be walled or at least demarcation pillars be put wherever necessary round the compound.

The Rev. Jojowar has arrived here yesterday afternoon. He says that the Orissa Government is going to take on lease at Rs. 60/- p. m. the Bara Bungalow at Jharsuguda. He also says that you have already consented to it. Thanks for the same.

Further he reports that the rent for the Jharsuguda compound ^{has} is not yet paid for years. I hope you will see to it immediately so that case may not be instituted against us.

(4) On the 23rd June 1942 on your request the Assistant Manager Mr. N. Toppe and the Tahsildar Mr. D. Topno has been placed directly under my supervision and control. This has been communicated to you on 3-7-42 by my letter No. 1521-23.

I have ordered them to realise all the arrears of rents and cess as far as practicable. The Tahsildar did his best this time and realised Rs. 1517/- in one tour. This sum includes the sale proceeds of adhbatai paddy. Mr. N. Soy says " This time the Tahsildar has done wonderfully ". I have ordered him to report all the arrears of rent and cess village by village stating fully the years in arrears with a view to save limitation.

I have given ^{orders to} Mr. N. Toppe to realise rents from the Municipal areas. He should also submit the statements of all arrears of rents and to try his best to realise specially in every first week of the month.

I enquired about Municipal tax of our compound, Bethesda and other holdings, ^{but none could tell me the amounts.} Please give me a full detail of Municipal taxes payable for the entire compounds in details of Chakradharpur, Lohardaga and Ranchi and various incomes therefrom, the Church is entitled to receive.

(5) The Gumla garden has been settled with Christophar Barha for three years from 1-7-1942 to 30-6-1945 at Rs. 33/- as annual rent. Lease is not yet executed. Please let me know who will execute the lease.

(6) The garden near the Gossner High School has been taken possession of by the Church Council in this month and green plantations from the Church Council is going on. I and the President are trying to get lessees for both gardens as decided on the 23rd June, 1942 by the Church Council.

Item No. 18.

" The report of Mr. N. Toppo, Assistant Manager and the Tahsildar Daniel Topno regarding collections from Jona and Dokad properties was read and noted.

Mr. D. M. Panna pointed out that he himself lives at Purulia, and the Asst. Manager and the Tahsildar have their head office at Ranchi; hence he was unable to direct and control them properly nor is he able to supervise their works efficiently. He requested the C. C. to control and direct them and to supervise their works.

Your No.1465/42/F-30 dated 25.6.1942.

I have been requested to pay Rs.50/- only to the Chairman of the Chainpur Ilaka for the repairs of the church and bungalow at Chainpur by the Executive of the Church Council. The Executive of the Church Council had requested me to give them a loan of Rs.300/- for the repairs of the churches and bungalows under the management of the Church Council, but when I went to Ranchi to attend the meeting of the Executive in May 1942 with the money, I was told that the Church Council had found money and so it was not necessary to take any loan and I had to bring back the Rs.300/-. It now strikes me why the Church Council Executive asks me to pay Rs.50/- for the repairs of the church and bungalow at Chainpur.

In your letter you write " it was resolved that as the repairs are concerned with Packka chapel and bungalow, which were in the care of the Trustees ... ". I may point out to you that the Packka chapels and bungalows were never in the care of the Trustees and they were not responsible for their repairs etc. It was the Advisory Board which was responsible for their repairs, and Church Council is the successor of the Advisory Board, and so Church Council is the body to care for the repairs of Packka chapels or bungalows. So please do not make any such mistake in future. This, of course, does not mean that the Trustees did not help the Church Council when a request for help was made and they had funds to repair such buildings and could make a grant.

Please let me know if you wish this money paid to the Church Council as loan or what. The Board of Management sanctioned Rs.2000/- for the Church Council for the repairs of chapels and bungalows under the Church Council, and as Mr. Naiman Toppo may inform you, the entire sum of Rs.2000/- has already been allotted for repairs of some chapels etc.

Also please let me know what do you mean by the term "Property Funds". If you mean the funds under the control of the Board of Management, then without their sanction I can not give any part of the same. So a meeting of the Executive of the Board of Management will be necessary. But if you wish that the money be paid from the Singhani bungalow income funds, then please make the expression very clear.

I am sending you copy of letter dated 21.5.1942 from Rev. L. Kongari, Chairman of the Koronjo Ilaka. He and other tenants at Koronjo pray for legal action against Pelka Suleman Kharia and his sons for cutting keond trees from the Church's jungle at Koronjo without authority or permission. From the letter it appears that the offenders did not listen to the decision of the Ilaka Panch. If the Church Council will keep quiet, it will be very difficult to manage the Church's jungles. Please place the matter before the Church Council Executive and let there be a resolution passed by it sanctioning the prosecution of the offenders in the criminal court at Simdega. After the sanction by the Church Council, Tahsildar D. Topono should go to Koronjo and then with his help a criminal case will be filed at Simdega. Last year there was some trouble about cutting of trees at Koronjo, and the Church Council should take deterrent action this time.

Extract from the Minutes of the C. C. Executive Committee held at Ranchi on the 18th May, 1942.

Item No. 32.

" The Church Council heard the verbal report of the President Rev. J. Lakra about the Mandli paisa at Purulia and the differences between the Pastor and the Panch there about collection and the way of its disbursement and after full discussion on the matter it was resolved that

(1) The Mandli Paisa should be collected at the rate fixed by the Mahasabha and be credited to the general fund of the Ilaka.

(2) The Ilaka Panch is competent to dispose off the Fund according to the needs of the Ilaka including the payment of the Pastor's salary, repairs etc., etc.

(3) Mr. D. M. Panna is hereby appointed District Organiser of the Manbhum District with immediate effect.

The Purulia Ilaka Chairman will be responsible to the Church Council through the District Organiser Mr. D. M. Panna who will have the right to make necessary recommendations to the Church Council and to direct the Ilaka Chairman. "

From a letter of Mr. Naiman Toppo , dated yesterday , I find that you did not go to Burju but sent Tahsildar Daniel Topono to arrange for the Mahasabha meetings . From his letter I find also that Rev. J. Lakra with his things was to leave Ranchi for Govindpur in the afternoon yesterday , which I hope he could do .

From Mr. Toppo's letter I learn that the Military Officer who was occupying the President's bungalow has left it with all the furniture that had been left by us in the bungalow . This is rather bad . He should not have removed our things . Please write to the Deputy Commissioner informing him about the fact of the removal of our furniture , so that in case we sustain any loss by damage, destruction or theft etc. Government will be held responsible and will pay us the price as noted in the list .

Please let me know if the Deputy Commissioner has acknowledged receipt of the lists of furniture left by us in the bungalows requisition for military purposes . In case of loss or damage by the occupants of the bungalows , the acknowledgment of receipt of the lists of furniture will be of great help for us to make claim against Government .
