Dear Mr. Tiga,

In accordance with the request of the Federation of Lutheran Churches in India, and with the permission of the Executive Committee of the U. L. C. Mission, I came to Ranchi on the 14th and the 15th, in order to try to help you all. After my series of conferences with you and other friends in Ranchi, I beg to sand you herewith my considered opinions and advice.

- 1. Your request through the Lutheran Federation, to the U. L. C. Mission for an American Missionary to come to Manchi is a reasonable one, and I will / strongly recommend it to the U. L. C. Mission. I will also report to the U. L. C. Mission your opinion, that in view of the present war conditions and probable post-war relations with the Berlin Board, the presence of such an American Missionary is desirable for an indefinite period.
- 2. This Missionary, when he comes to Manchi, should immediately become the Principal and Meadmaster of the Gossner Migh School. No other assignments to administrative posts in the High School should be made at present, until the Missionary Principal-Weadmaster is able to study the situation and make recommendations regarding the same to the bodies concerned. And also at present no length of time for this Missionary Principal-Meadmastership should be specified.
- 3. The Rules of Agreement between the Managing Committee of the High School and the Church Council (adopted by the Mahasabha in 1939) should be revised and re-drafted. I suggest a small edotorial committee of five, two from the Managing Committee, two from the Church Council, and a Chairman appointed by the Bihar Christian Council, should undertake the preliminary steps in this matter. The Commission of the Federation made a similar recommendation in Gudur in December.
- 4. This Missionary, as you have requested, should study the whole financial situation of the Church. He would also be of valuable assistance in the proposed adjustments regarding the present Board of Management. In order to enable him to do this effectively, and in accordance with the wish expressed by the Church Council, it seems wise that he should handle the finances of the Church, too.
- 5. This Missionary should also be a member of the General Conference (Mahasabha) and, if an ordained minister, he shall also be a member of the Ministerium of the G. E. L. Church. Any further matters of agreement between the G. E. L. Church and the U. L. C. Mission regarding this Missionary and his status and relations shall be drawn up for the approval of these two bodies after the Missionary arrives on the field.
- 6. The services of this Missionary may be availed of in the Theological Seminary to teach a subject in English (if he does not know the Hindi language.)

My prayer is that the Gossner Church may go from strength to strength, by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and that a brotherly spirit may prevail between those responsible for the work of the Church and its institutions, especially the Gossner High School.

File Maylu A copy of letter no. 9404, dated the 21st September, 1940 from the Director of Public Instruction, Bihar. " I have the honour to state that for some time past the question of the adjustment of holidays in schools and colleges has been under consideration. I now request you to ask headmasters of high schools under you to collect opinions on the subject by convening meetings of guardians and by such other means as are feasible. These opinions should then be considered by the managing Committees and their considered views together with your comments sent to me at an early date. 2. I do not think that our schools and colleges in Bihar have too many holidays, but I certainly do think that they could be distributed more advantageously from the educational standpoint. The fundamental idea is to have holidays at times which will be most beneficial educationally. One may look at the problem from the following aspects: The weekly holidays. The annual holiday. C) The occasional holiday. The school year. The School Examinations. 3. As regards the weekly holiday, in India as elsewhere, Sunday is the weekly holiday. It should be retained, and along with it there should bee a half holiday on Saturday. This will give the pupil the whole of the week-end to which he may look forward for his private pursuits, study, sports, going home to his parents, etc., the encroachment on this private time should be permitted. School and college meetings and functions should never be held on Sundays. The student should be able to regard this weekly holiday as his own time for his own work. Some educationists consider that there should be also a holiday in mid-week, as Thursday is a holiday in the army; but I do not consider this is necessary in our schools and colleges.

4. As regards the annual holiday or summer vacation, it should be fixed according to climatic conditions. In Bihar, therefore, it should occur in the months of May and June. In one or two places, perhaps on account of floods or special harvest work or other circumstances, the annual summer holiday may be fixed at another time. Generally, however, it will fall in may and June. This annual holiday should not be too short. It should give the student time to recapture his home-life, to regain his health in in a home environment, to give a complete change from school life, to have time, if he tan, for a little travelling. It should be long enough to permit him to draw up a systematic x acheme for private study. This annual summer holiday should begin not later than the beginning of may and it should continure after the middle of July. Schools may have a two months' holiday; colleges may extend it to 12 months.

5. As regards the occasional holidays, this should be colleges may extend it to 12 months.

5. As regards the occasional holidays, this should be discouraged between the months of october and march, which are good working months. The most important of these occasional holidays is the Puja holiday, which under the present system often extends to one month. I think that it should be confined to the Gazetted Puja holidays. Another important break is Christmas, and there does not seem to be any valid reason why in India Christmas holidays in schools and not seem to be valid reason why in India Christmas holidays in schools and colleges should stretch to a week or eight days. On the other hand, such well-established religious holidays as Holi, Muharram, Id., etc., should extend to about a week apiece. Occasional single - day holidays are to be avoided; they are merely a disturbing element without any corresponding benefit. In 1940 our chief holidays should have been arranged somewhat as follows:
Id-uz-Zuha 3 or 4 days from January 20th.

Fuharram 8 days from February 17th. colleges may extend it to 12 months. 8 days from February 17th.
9 days from March 22nd.
29th april to 13th July for colleges and 29th April to 1st July in schools. Puharram Hol1 Summer vacation lujas. 16 days from about 1st October. Lewali and Idul-Fitr. ... 6 days from 30th October.

- important matters arising out of the holiday question. Under the present system the school year begins on the ist January, with the result that both December and January is filled up with Test Examinations and January with admissions. Most educationists are now agreed that the school year in bihar should begin with the re-opening of the schools on or about the ist of July after the summer holidays. There do not appear to be any insuperable administrative difficulties in effecting this change immediately.
- annual promotion, chass and university examinations take place in the month of April. There should be, when practicable, one paper a day, arranged for the early morning. The papers will be marked by the examiners working at their leisure during the summer holidays instead of during term. There may be a supplementary examination in schools and colleges fixed for a date immediately before the Pujas. There again the papers will be marked during the holidays. The Test examination for university candidates should take place in the earlier part of rebruary, six weeks before the annual Examination.



Dear Sir,

I have the honour to state that this morning at about 8 a. m. the Compound Chaukidar caught a boy who was breaking small branches from a tree in the Compound. The branches were meant for the goats and the boy was from Babu Haniel Horo.

Many persons in the compound wish to keep goats because it (the compound) affords a very good pasture for them. But in case they are left free in the compound to graze they enter into the gardens and destroy the vegetables grown therein. Every body cannot afford to buy wire nets, and for big gardens like those we have in the compound it is very difficult to get wire nets. And my personal experience is that even wire nets cannot prevent goats if they happen to find one small hole. So in case the goats are left free to graze in the compound, they are sure to destroy our gardens, and in case they are kept tied, the owners of those

those goats are sure to destroy the trees in the compound. So the C. C. was rather compelled to pass this resolution that goats should not be kept in the compound. Mr. Haniel Horo, Pandit Masihdas Khalkho and Puranprasad Chaukidar still keep goats in the compound. My suggestion is that they must either remove the goats from the compound or they must themselves remove from the compound.

We are all anxious to keep flower gardens and vegetable gardens. We all wish to grow trees in the compound. And so in order to achieve these ends we must banish goats.

By the by I should like to say that the garden work is one of the compulsory subjects prescribed for the classes IV & V.


It is a very good subject for the Chhotanagpuri boys as almost all of them are from farmers' families. And as far as I know that that subject is neglected in our High School. I understand I know the reason why it is so. And it is this that in the High School compound there are many goats and you find it very difficult to protect the garden from the goats. My request is that you will kindly avail yourself of this order of the C. C. Please ask those three of your employees to remove the goats at an early date.

And you can have a nice garden for the boys without much difficulty.

(a) You are guilty of norongful Confinement when you shut up the girlo students within a room and bother it and you forced them to sign and threatening. Them with rustication and undue in fluence to put down their signatures on a blank sheet of paper the Contents of which were not fully explain to them and they, were further askes at the pain of rustication not to disclose it to thony body they out side. Not this is a Criminal Charge of assualt wrongful Confine ment by closing them withen a room. You will please explain why you did so and why we shall not prove against you criminally. (by You assaulted Junas Thono a student of our class on 15th instent 1929, without any recessor. You know that bodily punish ment is forbidden by educational Law.

You will please explain, Why we should not go to Criminal Court against you on a charge of assualted and to the Inspector of Schools for having Violated the government Circular.

(c) you have by treachry induced some of our class friends to put down their signatures on a blank piece of paper i.e. to Walter Thejer without having shown the Contents thereof.

As such you are guilty of having practised fraud and forgery and you will please explain why we should not move the higher authorities for the Same.

But this Charge is base less. On the other hand the questions leakaged out on account of the Carelessness of the Headmaster who did not set his paper in time and there for hence they has to be Littives in the School and Secondly the Headmaster left his question paper in manuscript on his table with which his Child was playing and thirdly the Son of the Headmaster went to Mr. Samaya a teacher of the School to get the very piece of Franklation Corrected which was found set in the question paper next morning. Even then the students of other classes were for seed to appear at a se-examination and the poor Clear is victimised merely to shift the blame on this shoulders. We are not prepared to Submit to this injustice and we request you to kindly explain why you have used physical force to Compell us to do so.

(e) These are only some of the Charges which are specially in Concetion with the Students of the R' Class but have been doing Similar things in the Otostel and are allowing the Stead master to do so. You have for example been informed that the students of the hostel are almost half starved and their Money orders are not paid in time and in some Cases they have been never paid. You will please explain why a charge of emberthement should not be brought again of the Glead master and you as an arbiter.

We hope you will kindly answer to thise Charges by 8 A.M. to morrow morning, if not do please take notice that we shall commune general strike and hunger strike besides going to Criminal Courts on the variouss established that Charges mentioned in this notice.

1. Yotish Tirkey was neither expelled nor rusticated. In case of expulsion or rustication no transfer will be issued to the boy according to Ed.Code Art.245. The fact that the transfer was issued to Yotish Tirkey shows you clearly that Ed.Code Art.212-14 are not under consideration.

2.As the incident took place in the Hostel it was acted according to Ed.Code Art.536,i.e. the boy was removed from the Hostel and consequently also from the school according to the rule mentioned above.

3. It is fully useless to deny that the Principal should not have the right to issue a compulsory transfer.

4. Your attention is also drawn to Ed. Art. 288, 18: the grant of transfer certificates.... shall be decided by the Headmaster subject only to the supervision of the inspecting officers of the depertment.

The Board of the Gossner Mission Society in Berlin was informed of the progress of this year's Mahasabha through minutes and reports. We thank God that He gave the Mahasabha sucha a blessed and peaceful course.

The Board already discussed several points of your reporters So it approved of the election of Missionary Radsick into the Church Trustee Board and of the appointment of the Missionary Jellinghaus as treasurer of the Church.

To-day we are sending you a signed copy of the Agreement which was accepted and signed in the Board Meeting of March 9th in the form agreed upon by the Mahasabha . The minutes March 9th in the form agreed as follows ;of the Board Meeting read as follows ;"The Agreement was signed

after having been dissussed and accepted at the General Conference gin Ranchi.

The Mahasabha changed the Board's draught of the agreement in some points, one of which moved us deeply. It is point 1, paragraph 2, beginning with the words: " The relationship ...". The relation between the Board and the Thurch in Chota Nagpur could not be expressed more beautifully and more deeply.

The Board also rejoices at the idea of sending one or other highly qualified young man from the people of Mundas and Uraos to Germany or America for the study of Theology. The Board would be very glad if these studies could be arranged and is very willing to render this service to the Church of Chota Nagpur and

If some amendments of the agreement drawn up in the Mahasabha express the fear that the Missionaries might interfere with the autonomy of the Church , we beg you to disperse even the shadow of such mistrust from your hearts. On the other hand it must not make us distrustful if an amendment of the agreement discusses the possibility of inviting missionaries from other missions to co-operate in the Church of Chota Nagput and Assam. Here we do not only keek to the text of the agreement, which provides that Missio naries from other Missions shall only be invited in friendly understanding which xhanxprenning with anxent x than x nine tyxyears x between RanshixandxRariinxx with the Board , but we trust that also in this point the relation of mutual understanding which has prevailed for more than ninety years between Ranchi and Berlin will be continued.

God bless the resolutions of the Mahasabha; God bless your work in the Church Council .

Herewith I am placing before you an application which I have been asked to forward by the General Meeting of the Gossner Evangelical Church. The Mahasabha found it too difficult to agree to the instruction of Hindustani as medium of instruction in our High School. The Mahasabha is of opinion that it is a great advantage for the Aboriginals to have a good working knowledge of English. Therefore the people of our Church would like to see that English should be retained as medium of instruction in the Gossner High School.

This application is made on the following grounds:-

- 1. English is to be said easier to them than Hindustani.
- 2. In so far as both languages are not the mothertongue of the Aboriginals within our Church.
- The medium is not Hindi but Hindustani containing many Urdu elements which will be still more difficult for them.
- 4. By not making English the medium of instruction little attention only is paid to the study of this important language which might separate gradually the whole education work from the European culture.

If there is any way under the present rules to continue with English or any special provision can be made for the Gossner High School, you should kindly consider the views of our Aboriginals.

DRAFT FOR THE CONSTITUTION BETWEEN C. C. AND M. C.

1

The following constitution regulates the relationship between the Church Council of the Gossner Ev. Lutheran Church in Chotanagpur and Assam and the Managing Committee of the Gossner High School, Ranchi. The rules provided therein are defined to govern its procedure, to guarantee the Christian influence upon the School and to save its character as a Lutheran Mission School. On the other side it lays down the responsibility of the Church towards the School and defines the extent to which the Church is expected to lend its help for a properous mutual co-operation.

2

The special power the Education Code attributes to the officers of the School and the exclusive rights and competencies of the Principal and Managing Committee for all internal matters are not modified and do not suffer any reduction by this constitution. Especially the appointment, discharge or dismissal of all members of the staff, the control over teacher's work, discipline and finances, the management of the Hostel affairs and all other matters relating to the management of the school are entirely left in the hands of the Managing Committee and are to be refferred for approval or decision only to the Inspector of Schools in accordance with the provisions of the Education Code.

3

The rights and the influence of the Church are safeguarded by the following three items: (1) The Principal of the Gossner High School cannot be appointed by the Managing Committee unless the name of the Candidate proposed by the Managing Committee has got the approval of the Church Council. (2) The Church is represented on the Managing Committee by two representatives. (3) The Church shall have certain particular rights defined in Par 6.

4

With regard to the appointment of the Principal the Church has the right of approval, the Managing Committee has the right of proposal and appointment.

On the occassion of the appointment of the Principal the Managing Committee has to select a candidate for the Principalship, if possible, two, but not more than three. His name is to be forwarded to the Church Council for approval. The candidate approved by the Church Council is to be appointed by the Managing Committee. If more than on name has been sent, the Church Council has the right of selection and the Managing Committee has to appoint the candidate selected by the Church Council.

The proposal of the Managing Committee can be rejected only if important, convincing and well founded grounds can be shown to the Managing Committee proving the inefficiency of the chadidate from the Christian point of view in so far as his Christian conduct and character, his interest in church affairs and his ecclesiastical activities are concerned. In this case a new proposal is to be made by the Managing Committee.

The Home-Board of the Gossner Mission shall have the privilage of expressing its opinion and giving its suggestions in the matter of appointment of the Principal.

5

The Church representatives are to be nominated by the Church Council and their names are to be sent to the Secretary, Managing Committee. They become members with effect from the date of approval by the Managing Committee.

The total strength of the Managing Committee shall be nine, included the Principal and the Head-master. Besides the two members to be nominated by the Church Council, one member is to be elected by the staff, four are to co-opted from the different communities by the Managing Committee. The Principal and the Headmaster are members ex-officio. The Principal is ex-officio Secretary.

The Members of the Managing Committee elect from among themselves a President (Chairman), vide Ed. Code Art. 287, rule 4. It is desirable that one of the Church representatives should be appointed to be the President.

If the presence of a Church representative in the Committee becomes undesirable the Managing Committee has the right to remove him. The Managing Committee should report the grounds, hindering useful co-operation to the Church Council and request the Church Council to withdraw the undesirable representative and to fill up the vacancy by sending another representative. If the Managing Committee however is of opinion that the question of his membership is to be solved immediately, it can act according to Ed. Code Art. 287, rule, 5 " Any ex-officio member of the Managing Committee other than the Maadwa Headmaster and any ordinary member may be removed from office by a resolution to that effect passed at a meeting specially called to consider the question, provided that the resolution is supported by the votes of at least three-fourths of the members present and voting." The resolution of the Managing Committee passed according to the rule quoted above will be final and binding on all concerned. This should be an exceptional step to be taken only under extraordinary circumstances.

6.

Besides the rights mentioned in paras 24-5, the Church Council shall receive the Annual Inspection Note and shall be infromed about the Annual Matriculation Examination results.

The Principal has to submit a report on High School matters before the Annual General Conference of the Church (Mahasabha).

The Church Council has the right to request the Principal to submit reports occasionally.

Consequent on the privileges mentioned in para 3-6 the Church grants the High School the following rights; (1) The High School is to be represented on the Church Council. (2) The Church agrees to fulfill the duties enjoined by the Ed. Code to the proprietors of the Schools. (3) The High School represents a separate parish. (4) The Principal of the High School represents has special influence upon the religious instruction within the area of the Gossner Church.

8.

Corresponding to the representation the Church has got on the High School Committee, the High School is to be represented on the Church Council. Therefore the Principal shall be member of the Church Executive ex-officio.

The Principal is allowed to send the Headmaster in his place, if he decides so.

9.

The Church Council agrees to remain responsible for necessary repairs, for furniture and for an eventual deficit which is to be made up by the Church, if the school suffers one.

It is agreed that regular contributions towards the funds of the High School will be continues by the Church Council if the financial position of the Church allows.

10.

The High School forms a separate parish under the jurisdiction of the Principal, if he is a Missionary or an Indian Pastor.

As separate parish the School is to be represented on the General Conference of the Church (Mahasabha) by two delegates.

The Principal shall be the sole authority over the High School compound.

11.

The Principal, if he is a Missionary or an Indian Pastor, has special influence upon the religious instruction within the area of the G. E. L. Church. The religious instruction in all middle schools is open to his inspection. He prepares the syllabus and gives his suggestions for changes or modifications to the Church Council.

At their meeting held on August 3rd, 1938 the Executive of the C. C. considered your draft of a constitution. I am directed to communicate to you the following.

We have asked you to make a first draft of a constitution. There was, of course, no objection to your doing this in consultation with the experts in the High School. But instead of submitting your draft to the President of the Church you submitted it to the Managing Committee of the High School for approval. This draft is now the proposal of the Managing Committee. It was certainly not the Managing Committee who have to take the lead in this affair.

Materially, we regret to say, the draft on the whole goes astray. It is based on the supposition that the G. E. L. Church and Gossner's High School are co-ordinate partners who have to come to terms. In fact the G. E. L. Church is the owner of this High School, the High School is one of the institutions and agencies of the Church. Dear Sir,

We have no rules governing the relation between the S.P.G. and the Managing Committee. The S.P.G. is the owner and controller of the school, but since it accepts a Government Grant-in-aid it conforms to the B & O Regulations that concern Aided Schools.

Managing Committee. The Bishop is ex-officio President, and the members of the Committee appoint new members as required. The S.P.G. retains the right to reject any member it considers unsuitable. The management and discipline of the school are entirely under the control of the Managing Committee though in actual practice the Headmaster and the Bishop have the initiative, and executive powers.

The appointment and dismissal of teachers is in the hands of the Headmaster, such charges as he makes being referred to the Managing Committee for their approval, and to the Inspector for confirmation. Everything has been rather undefined, and the Mission has had to point out to the Inspector of Schools more than once that this is not a Government School, and that the control of the school; its continuance or closure, lies in the hands of the S.P.G. We accept the Government grant, and thereby conform with their regulations, however unsatisfactory they may be, and are subject to annual inspection by the Inspector, and occasional audit of accounts.

With reference to my work in the Gossner High School may I submit the following facts for the Council's information and kind consideration.

1. I joined the School on the 20th September 1937, after getting the full assurance, both from the Church Council and the Principal, to the effect that I will be a genuine member of the High School Staff.

2. On the day I joined the School kxwaxxdwkxxirkraduardxbx Dr. wolff/to the Staff and to the students as a Teacher who has been appointed to the Staff in accordance with the resolution of the Managing Committee, stating that along with other secular subjects Religious Instruction will be my special subject for teaching. Then Mr.Tirkey in interpreting Dr. Wolff's statements in Hindi omitted certain salient points in Dr. Wolff's speech and said that "Mr. Barla bishesh kar ke Dharmm bishay parhane ke liye bahal kiye gaye hain - etc." without interpreting that statement of Dr. Wolff's which definitely emphasised that I am appointed to the Staff of the School. This gave a wrong impression to the boys and so when I was entering a class for taking up a secular subject the students told me that it was not a Bible period, meaning thereby that they did not expect me to teach any secular subject.

3. To my great surprise and disappointment I found at the end of the month that I was not paid from the Acquittance Roll but from an ordinary receipt book whereby I could not make out on what account I had been paid. This then, clearly shows that I am not a genuine member of the Gossner School Staff and so, the resolution of the Managing Committee and the assurance from the Principal have not been carried out, which is rather disappointing to me and the action stated above is positively unconstitutional.

In view of the above facts I pray to the Church Council that the matter of my appointment to the Staff of the School be taken up again and proper steps be taken to decide my status in the School.

I know that the Church Council has appointed me to represent the Church on the Managing Committee of the Gossner High School and it has been communicated to you on the 10th May, 1937. I have been waiting for a call from you but so far I have received none. In this connection I also enquire from the Church Council Office if you have written to the Church Council on this matter and I am told that there has been no correspondence from you. This means that I have been taken on the Managing Counittee but now it is full two months and yet I have not been called for any meeting.

I have come to know from a very reliable source that Mr. Theodore Surin the ex-C.C. representative has submitted a complaint under three head which I beg parden to deal with very briefly in the following lines.

1.Mr. Surin says that his term of membership is not expired. I have nothing to say in this connection except to point out that the moment the Church Council sent a new name in place of the old it was made as clear as day light that the old has been given frix farewell at least from that particular position.

2. He says that the Executive of the Church Council cannot send the representative because, in his opinion the full Council ought to send as it has hitherto done. I wish to point out that the full Church Council which met after the last Mahasabha decided to send me to the Managing Committee and now when a vacancy has occurred, it is only in order that the Church Council's decision is being carried out by the Executive. Apart from this

This the Executive is empowered to act on behalf of the full Church Council in the ad-interim period as contained in Section 5 Article 10 of the Consti tution of the Gossner Church. I may just remind you that the appointments made recently of Mr. A.L. Tirkey as Off: Principal and Dr. O. Wolff as Principal r spectively was only by the Executive of the Church Council. The full Church Council knew it only after the appointments were made and the appointments were supported by the full Church Council. In case of my being a member of the Managing Committee it is the full Council which has taken the lead and the Executive has followed the train. I do not see why on this ground set forth by Mr. Surin the M.C. should make any delay.

3. Under the last head he says that I have embezzled some money at Lohardaga. Now I wish to know if you have entertained this complaint agains me and whether you have forwarded to the Inspector of Schools. If you have done so I shall be compelled to defend myself even before the Inspector and if necessary before any other competent Officer of the Government. I have the honour to state that the Gossner High School, Ranchi, is an institution of which the G.E.L. Church is the proprietor. The Christians of this Church numbering at present 140000 are deeply interest ed in it and look upon it as the only institution for educating their children, and consider it to be the life and light of their Church.

Recently we have come to know from the Principal of the said High School that the Government Grant to the School has been reduced by Rs 40/- p.m., that is, Rs 372 has been sanctioned against Rs 412/- in the previous years. This reduction of Grant has put the Church and the High School in great difficulty.

- 1. Again the Church Council which is the Governing Body of the Church hears that there is a rule in force that all the High Schools under the Patna University have been classed into A., B and C., according to the University result they obtained.
- 2. That the Grant is given at present to the High Schools according to the above classifications.
- 3. May we know whether there is really any such rule in force, and if so, to which class the Gossner High School, Ranchi has been placed.

May we request you also to furnish us the reasons for the above reduction of the Government Grant to the Gossner High School, Ranchi, so tha we may take necessary steps immediately for the amelioration of the High School, if this reduction is because of the inefficiency of the said High School.

Respectfully, I beg leave to draw your attention to certain broad questions affecting the management of the Gossner High School at the present moment, and request you to kindly through inquiry and investigation set them in good order for the welfare of the students at large and the guardians as well.

I refer to a question ---- the It is with a heavy heart, that deplorable situation in the management of the school hostel. I strongly feel that there is no good arrangements for medical aid to the sick students; the sick-room is not well-ventilated; there is no regular visiting health officer to the hostel; students com-plain of gross neglect; and the students who fall sick are left utterly neglected. In consequence of which, the fact remains that my son died in the hostel on 9th March 1937, through sheer act of negligence. Recently, my son Belkhas Lakra, a strong healthy youngman, some 20 years of age, who was a boarder in the hostel, was simply suffering from Marrhoea; both the Frincipal and the Warden of the hostel were informed to this effect; but no adequate medical aid nor sufficient food was rendered; no doctor was consulted; niether the guardians (including me) was informed; and at last my son died untimely through sheer act of negligence on the part of the school authorities who are in charge of the hostel management ---- both the Principal and the Warden. To make things worse, that the very night my son died, both the Principal and the Warden were informed of the seriousness of my son's situation by the fellow students, but the hostel authorities taking it lightly left file uncaredfor, utterly neglected, waiting to see some doctor on the next morning. Alas: before dawn and the dupes of the school authorities, the boy breathed his last on the same night. Suspicion arises in his death; and perhaps this is nothing short of a police case. This is certainly a disgrace on the credit of the whole school and on the part of the school authorities. Things are going on in unusual course till they have come to a crisis when the guardians and the well-wishers of the school as well, are no honger satisfied with the present management of the whole school and demand a whole sale change in the matter of its management. Many complaints to this effect about the school and its present officiating Principal Mr. A.L. Tirkey, have been lodged to the above office by the guardians, but hi therto no action has been taken into the matters of the school. Now, in connection with the present sad trend of events in the school situation, a necessity at this hour has arisen that action should be taken at once into the matters of the school and that the present Warden of the school should be removed from the hostel. I understand that the school is grant-in-mided, and the Government gives grant towards the better arrangement of the hostel and for the good of the boys.
I therefore, lay the above facts for your kind perusal and

favourable considerations, for the benefit of those students who falling sick may unwarily meet the same fate of my son and for thewelfare of the guardians who may also become bereaved of their sons untimely. On the eve of Mr. Cooper's departure and due to Easter holi days I could not inform this matter earlier than this. I think it is not too late. I pray therefore, that you will kindly view this with

favour and take necessary action thereon.



Dear Mr Kandulna,

This is to acknowledge receipt, with thanks, of your letter No. 1145/37/F--23, dated 4th Feby 1937 (by air mail). In reply, I desire to make the following observations:-

- 1. I am not in a position to answer the question put to me in regard to the donations received by Rev. Joel Lakra from American sources, as to whether they were intended for private use or for the Gossner High School. My memory is not good enough to recall transactions that took place so long ago, even if it were true that I had some connection with them.
- 2. So far as I can now revall, I had nothing at all to do with the donations that came to Mr Lakra in cheques from America; these must have been received directly by Mr Lakra and so I had no knowledge of them.
- 3. While I was Treasurer of the U L C A Mission, Guntur and Rajahmundry, I did receive certain amounts from Dr Morehead of the World Lutheran Convention (possibly also from the Natl Lutheran Council) for the Gossner Church and for the Gossner High School, but my recollection is that I forwarded all these amounts to the Treasurer of the Gossner Ch., Rev. Mr Prehn. The records of these transactions would be, I take it, in the office of the Treasurer at Ranchi and in the office of the Mission Treasurer in Guntur; I have no such revords with me.
- 4. The item of Rs 140/ per memsem is, according to my recollection, the amount of Mr Lakra's salary as agreed to when he became Principal of the High School. The rules of the Educational Department and of the School will show, I take it, just how this amount was to be entered in the accounts.
- 5. My understanding is that, while Mr Lakra was in America, he made many friends and the presumption is that some of these sent him the donations after his return to India. However, I am not able to say at all whether these donations were private or for the School.
- 6. My own feeling is that you should furnish Mr Lakra with a full statement of the amounts involved in the Auditor's report and should request him to give you, on his word of honour, a statement showing the intention of the donors concerned; or at least the names and addresses of these donors. If satisfaction is not received in India, then I would suggest that the Secretary of the Church Council deal with the parties concerned in America, as he is in an official position to do so, and I am not. I desire of course, wholeheartedly desire, that all doubts in connection with the amounts in dispute be entirely cleared up. It is to Mr Lakra's interest to see that these doubts are cleared up.
