#### PREAMBLE

The GELC was established in the year 1919 and registered under Societies Act on July 30; 1921. Subsequently there have been several changes in the Contitution from time to time. The Gossner Church has been functioning in five Anchals namely, 1) Assam Anchal, 2 North Western Anchal, 3) Orissa Anchal, 4) Madhya Anchal and 5) South Eastern Anchal, as per revised Constitution adopted in 1960, In the year 1969, the Gossner Church resolved that the GELC Constitution adopted in 1960 needed revision and in 1975 adopted as revised Constitution.

However the Constitution as amended in 1975, could not be implemented for various reasons and at this time the North lestern Anchal declared itself as an independent Church. The Gossner Church did not recognise the new NWGELC as an independent Church. The new NWGELC had been quite eager to become a member of UELCI and LWF. Under these circumstances the UELCI initiated negotiations for the possible reunion of these two Churches or agotiations for the possible reunion of these two Churches or cognition of NWGELC as an independent Church. The UELCI meanwhile the year 1989, on April 28th, accorded NWGELC associate neership of UELCI for a period of 5 years with the expressed oal of negotiating a reunion of the two Churches within the riod of 5 years. Over this period of 5 years under the leadership UELCI, from 28th April 1989, series of negotiations took place. Both the Churches expressing strong inclinations to come together as one Church as Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church but with new features and structures reflecting the true nature of the Church. Basically this meant that the Anchals should become autonomous

Church as a whole. Both the Churches heartily agreed on this new continuous and new structures of the Church and thus almost a new Church has emerged. The UELCI and the Gossner Church leaders regard this as a great work of the Spirit of the Lord in reviving and strengthening the great GELC into a powerful instrument in God's hands in Chotanagpur and other parts of India.

#### THE CONSITUTION

# THE GOSSNER EVANGBEICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH IN CHOTANAGPUR AND ASSAM (Effective from 1995)

# ARTICLE ONE NAME AND REGISTRATION

1. The body organised under this Contitution shall be called "The Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church in India". The short name of this body in this Constitution shall be "Gossner Church".

The Gossner Church was duly registered on July 30,1921. in the Office of the Registrar, Joint Stock Companies, Patna under the Societies Registration Act 21 of 1860.

# ARTICLE TWO DOCTRINAL BASIS

- The Gossner Church receives and holds the Canonical Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as the inspired word of God, and as the only infallible rule and standard of faith and practice according to which all doctrines and teachings are to be judged.
- The Gossner Church accepts the three ecumenical creeds: namely Apostles, the Nicene and Athanasian, as important testi-monials drawn from the Holy Sceiptures and rejects all errors which they condemn.
- 3. The Gossner Church receives and holds the Unaltered Augsburg Confession as a correct exhibition of the faith and the doctrine of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, founded upon the word of God: and acknowldges all Churches that sincerely hold and dait—hfully confess the Doctrines of the Unaltered Augsburg Confession, to be entitled to the name of "Evangelical Lutheran".
- The Gossner Church recognises the Apology of the Aggs-burg Confession, the Smalkald Articles, the Large and Small Catechisms of Martine Luther and the Formula of Concord, as be-ing in harmony with the one and the same scriptural faith.

#### ARTICLE THREE

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE GUSSNER CHURCH

To Preserve and extend the pure teachings of the Gospel Christ and observance of the Holy Sacraments (Eph.4:5-6: the sburg Confession Article 7).

To conserve the unity of the true faith (Eph.4:3-16: Cor.1:10) to guard against any departure therefrom (Rom.16:17) and to strengthen the Church in its faith and confession.

- To preserve her unity, identity and integrity in larder to forster the Communion of believers historically known as Gossner Church and proclaim and practice the vision of oneness of all communities in the wide Gossner family.
  - IV. All administrative units of the Gossner Church shall be committed to strengthen this oneness as a vital function of the witness of the Church in India.
- V. To strengthen ecumenical co-operation and unity in all areas and ministries of the Church.
- VI. To anable commitment to the essential fourtold functions of the Church - viz. worship, nurture, proclamation and development.

#### ARTICLE FUUR

#### MEMBERSHIP

- All members baptised and confirmed in the congregations of all the Dioceses of the Church, are members of the Gossner Church.
- 2. PRACHARAKPAN (CONGREGATION)
  (A). ORGANIZATION
- A congregation is the basic unit of the Gossner Church it consists of a group of such faithful members of the Church who are locally organized into a group or groups of Christian asponsible for worship, nurture, evangelism, healing and development in witness to the salvation in Jesus Christ. Such congardation (s) shall be recognised by the Pastorate concerned.
- b. The Congregation shall consist of a minimum of 10 or 20 communicant members in a given place headed by a Pracharak/Pracharika or an ordained minister of the Gossner Church, to minister to its members as per Church regulations.
- c. The rightful membership of a congregation is limited to those baptised by an ordained minister of the Gossner Church as prescribed in the bylaws of the Church.
  - ii) those who are residents in the locality.
- 3. Those who are members of other denominations who wish to become members of the Gossner congregation may be admitted as per bylaws of the Church by a resolution of the local congregation.
- 4. i) Fraternal Membership (associate members) = Members of any other denominations resident in the area of a particular Gossner congregation, who desire to be ministered by the Gossner congregation, the ministries of the Church may be extended to them for their spiritual nurture. They shall be considered fraternal members without voting rights.
- The provilege of participation in the administration of the Church is confined to its bonafide confirmed members only.

#### ARTICLE FIVE

#### BASIC PRINCIPLES

In accordance with the aforesaid Doctrinal basis, the Gossner Church sets forth and declares the following Principles as fundamental for its organizations:

The full authority of the Church belongs primarily and exclusively to our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, the need of the Church. The Lord has shared this power with His body which is the Church to be exercised collectively as the Communication.

#### livers in Christ.

All just power exercised by the Church has been committed to her as the servant of Jesus Christ for the intherance of the Gospel through the Word and Sacraments. The church, therefore, has no authority to bind the conscience of my person except as taught and commanded by her Lord Jesus Christ.

- In obedience to her one Lord, the Church is bound to seek and preserve constantly the unity of the believers in faith and in witness, irrespective of whatever social or racial groups they may have come from. (Gal.3:28). In the same obedience, the Church shall so organise herself and mould the spiritual life of the defferent individuals and groups that they can live to—gether in love and mutual respect for the God given freedom as true Christians (1 of Cor.9, 1-23).
- The authorities and taske given to the Church are authorities and tasks of the whole Church operating through the Dioceses of the Church. Therefore, they are to be administered by all constituent parts of the Church, the local Congregations. The Parishes and the Dioceses and duly contituted some bodies of the Communion entrusted with specific tasks as set forth in this Constitution and its Bye-laws. (Eph.2:1, 1 Cor.10:15-17, 12:12-31).

#### POLITY (ORGANIZATION)

The Church accepts episcopal polity of administra-

The Church is divided into 5 Dioceses and the Head Quarter Congregation at Ranchi at the time of adopting this constitution.

Each Diocese is headed by a Bishop.

- 4. The basic functions of the Gossner Church are exer--cised by the biocese through its congregation.
- 5. The congregation is pre-eminently the basic unit of the Church for worship, nurture, evangelism, Healing and development.
- 6. The structure of the diocese is supported by the logal participation of duly elected representatives of the congregations/parishes.
- Parish as an organisation of congregations serves an administrative unit with defined functions in the live-laws.
- The Gossner Church shall have an organization for cration of certain administrative functions at the central Lygl and it shall be called Gossner Council. The Gossner Council has some distinct role in the life of the Gossner Chunion has explained in Articles 15-16.
- The structure and functions of various units of Church = the Gossner Council, the Diocese, the Parish and congregations = are spelt out in the Constitution and the laws as appropriate.

# PRACHARAKPAN (CONGREGATION) (A). ORGANIZATION

- Church. It consists of a group of such faithful members of the Church who are locally organized into a group or groups of Christians responsible for worship, nurture, evangelism healing and development in witness to the salvation in Jesus Christ. ## (B). FUNCTIONS OF THE CONGREGATIONS

- a. The basic functions of the congregation shall be carried out by the General body of the congregation through its duly elected council of the congregation.
- b. A congregation has the responsibility to see that its members are murtured in Christian faith through proper and regular teaching and preaching of the Word of God and administration of the Holy Sacraments: that the teaching, life and discipline are in accordance with the confession of the Gossner Church: that its members are active in Pastoral ministry and are striving for a life of mutual love and unity: and that the Gospel is proclaimed to the people of other faiths within and outside its jurisdiction.
  - c. A congregation has the responsibility to have a ce for common worship and quarter for the Pracharak/Prachaka or ordained minister.
- d. A congregation has the responsibility to provide ance for the support of all its activities within its juristion and to participate actively in the financial support if the Parish/Diocese in accordance with the Diocesan regulations.
- e. A congregation has the responsibility to participate in the administration of the Diocese in accordance with the Diocean Constitution and bye-laws.
- f. In order to fulfil the aims and objects of Church and through the congregation, it has the power to organise shiphas and samitees to hold meetings and to from committees for Sunday School works, Women's work, Youth work, Laymen work and such other works as may be required for life of the Congregation in accordance with the constitution and bye-laws of the Diocese.

It shall participate in the general administration of the Diocese by sending its officers and representatives to he higher administrative bodies in accordance with Diocesan constitution and bye-laws.

- g. A congregation has the responsibility to collect, aceive and centralise all its contributions and incomes as per rules.
- h. Where the congregation fails in its responsibility for consecutively three months it shall be debarred from the privileges of the Diocese.
- i. The congregation shall carry out all the policies and programmes decided by the Diocese.
  - j. A congregation shall have the following Officers:---
- 1. Pracharak/Pracharikas or ordained minister- To be appointed by the Parish and posted by the Pastorate. He/She be normally a = FULL TIME EMPLOYEE.
  - 2. Honorary Secretary
  - 3. Honorary Treasurer

Both to be elected by the Pracharakpan Panch (Congregation Council)

The administrative functions of the congregation all be carried out through Pracharakpan Fanch (Congregation uncil) according to the rules provided under Diocesan Constitution and bye-laws.

#### PARISH COUNCIL

#### (A) COMPOSITION

- i) Parish is a grouping of congregations located with cographical boundry and is administered by Parish Council. The Parish Council shall consist of members elected by the Pracha-rak and Pracharikas who are in active service in the Parish shall be members by virtue of their office. Where membership to Parish is by election to Parish Council, such membership shall be for a period of five years, in additition the heads of institutions, a representatives of Mahila organizations of Parish are members of Parish Council.
- ii) Each Parish Council shall have youth and Mahila orga--nisations and have its own Committees to promote youth, Ma--hila and other works.
- iii) The Parish Priest appointed by the Diocesans Council shall be the Chairperson of the Parish Council. The Chairperson and Parish Council shall function for a period of five wars. It shall also elect an honorary Secretary and Freasurer for five years.
  - It shall meet at least once in three months.

#### (B) FUNCTIONS

- i) To see that the Pracharakpan Panchs are properly organised and that they function according to the rules and regulations of the Dioceses.
- ii) To elect representatives to Diocesan Council and ther bodies as may be required by the bye-laws.
- iii) . To assist in the administration of Parish Priest in delaher duties within the Parish.

- iv) To be responsible for the income's and for accounting same to appropriate authorities.
- v) To help the congregations in the implementation of the five told ministries of the congregations, namely, Worship, furture, Evangelism healing and Development.
- vi) To maintain the membership register and statistics, minutes book, cash books, records of marriage, birth and death, confirmation. Holy communion, record of disciplinary actions, record of Church properties within Parish.
- vii) To establish and develop new ministries in pursuance of the five told ministries and organise Sabhas and Samitees.
- viii) To find suitable students for theological studies and other leadership training courses.
- ix) To undertake any other Christian nurture programmes the Parish Council considers relevant to the growth of their noregations.
  - x) <u>In single congregation parish</u>, the congregational will function as Parish Council.
    - NOTE: Functions of Ilaka as shown in (B) under Ilaka should be added here as Parish Council Functions.

#### PARISH ASSEMBLY (COMPOSITION) :!-

- 1) All Pastors all Pracharaks and Pracharikas.
- 2) Elected member (Number to be specified).
- 3) Women and Youth (Number to be specified).
- 4) Head Teachers of School.
- 5) Parish Assembly shall meet at least once in every two years.
- 6) The Parish Council is primarily an administrative body related to concerns entrusted to its care, defined herein below.
- 7) To identify specific ministries in the promotion of five told ministry, in particular, proclamation and development.
- 8) To look out for new areas within the Parish for Tarthering Churches' ministries through congregation or council with the assistance of the Diocese.
- 9) To identify both human and material local resources needed for the new ministries in new areas.
  - 10) To have responsibility to collect, receive and cenclaise all contributions and incomes from congregation as per
- 11) To preapare budgets for the whole Parish and to collect local funds for the purposes approved by the Parish Council to consultation with the Diocesan authorities.
- 12) To co-operate with Diocesan authorities in all schmes and projects approved by the Dioces in the management of the properties and in the educational institutions according to

# the rules and regulations of the Dioces.

- 13) To maintain consolidated statistics on the life and administration of Parish and report the same in the Diccese.
- 14) To elect the Executive Committee of Parish not exceeding nine members at least two of them shall be women. Not more than 50% of its membership shall be clergy.

Diocese is a territorial organization of the asser Church It consists of number of Parishes organised and actored as a Diocese under this Constitution. For the present the Constitution of Gossner Church, the Gossner Church anall have five Dioceses:

- a. North Mast Diocese.
- b. North West Diocese.
- c. Madhya Diocese.
- d. South East Diocese.
- e. South West Diocese.
- ii) A Diocese is governed by a Diocesan Council consisting of the following:
  - a. The Bishop
  - b. The Arch Deacon
  - c. The Secretary
  - d. The Treasurer
  - e. Chairpersons of Parishes within the Diocese.
  - f. One Pastor from each Parish to be elected by the Parish Council.
  - g. Three lay representatives from each Ilaka elected by Parish Council.

- h. One head of the institution from high middle and primary school from each Parish belonging to the Diocese. Where the head of an institution is not a member of the Church, another member of the Church from among the staff members be elected by the Parish Council.
- i. One Youth representative from each Parish.
- j. Two women representative from each Parish.
- K. One representative of Pracharaks/Pracharikas from each Parish elected by the Parish Council.
- 1. The Executive Committee shall co-opt sufficient number of women to make up women membership of the Council at least up to 30%.
- m. The term of members of all elected and co-opted members shall be for a period of five years.

# C. FUNCTIONS OF THE DIOCESAN COUNCIL

- 1) GENERAL FUNCTIONS
- a) The primary responsibility and authority of the biccese is to carry out and fulfil all the aims, objectives, auties and activities of the Gossner Church as mentioned in Apricle Three within the territorial jurisdiction of the Diocese.
  - b) The Diocese assumes all responsibilities of a Church, and at the same time is in total fellowship with the entire assner Church as a witness to its oneness.
  - c) The Diocese is free to co-operate with other Diocess within the Gossner Church in specific ministries in acco-clance with their own inspiration and initiatives for the growth of the Church.
    - d) The Diocese extends full co-operation to the various ervice units of the Gossner Council such as in various boards and Committees administering the institutions, properties and cumenical relations.
      - 2) SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS OF THE DIOCESAN COUNCIL
  - a) The Diocesan Council shall administer the work of the Council through the following Boards.-
    - Board of Education (Primary, Middle, Secondary and Collegiate)
    - Board for worship, nurture and theological education Finance Committee.
    - Board for Diocesan Mahila Sabha
    - Diocesan Youth Organization
    - Board for managment of properties
    - Any other Board the Diocesan Council may consider necessary to create in the discharge of its functions each of the above boards may consist of sevan members

clected by the Diocesan Council including the Chairperson of the Board. At least two members shall be women and one youth member.

- b) The Council shall elect Officers of the Diocesan Council and other members of the Executive Committee.
- c) The Diocesan Council shall normally meet once a year annually, giving five weeks notice for the Diocesan Council.
- d) Special Diocesan Council meeting may be called either by the Executive Committee or by one third of the Council memars requesting the Bishop in writing to call for the special session of the Council giving the reasons. Such emergency meeting shall be called for giving at least two weeks notice.
- e) The Diocesan Council shall appoint its representative various Committees of the Gossner Council as per the Constitution.
- f) The Diocesan Council shall receive the following apports at the regular annual session of the Council -
  - The assessment report from the Bishop particularly in relation to the impact of the five told ministries of the Church.
  - The reports from the Chairpersons of all the Boards and other Diocesan organisations under the Council.
  - fhe Treasurers report and addited statement of account and budget for the following year.
    - Report of the Statistician.
    - Reports from the Parishes 0 avenues de
    - Any other matters of the Diocese.
    - g) The Council shall appoint the auditors of the Diocese.
- h) The Diocesan Council shall be responsible for its share of financial and personnel support to the Gossner Theolical College and Gurukul Lutheran Theological College and also for the scholarships of its students of theology, in any the Theological College/Seminaries.
- i) In initiate and promote ministries and programmes that enrich the life and witness of the Church within the blocese.
- j) The Council shall meet for a minimum of three full

#### C. LICUESAN COUNCIL MEETINGS

- i) The Bishop shall preside over the Diocesan Council meetings.
- ii) In the absence of the Bishop, at his authorization in writing the Arch Deacon shall preside.
- iii) In an emergency situation when neither the Bishop nor the Arch Deacon will not be able to preside, two thirds of the Council members can convene and the senior most Ordained member in age shall be asked to preside.

#### (B) FUNCTIONS

- The Executive Committee shall act on behalf of the Council between the meetings of the Council. i)
- ii) The Executive Committee functions as the Executive of the Council implementing all the decisions of the Council.
- The officers of the Council = the Bishop, the Arch Deacon, Secretary and Treasurer = are also the Officers of the Executive Committee and may meet as Officers to handle any emergency situations which shall be later retified by the Executive Committee/ iii) Council.
  - executive Committee shall be responsible for the appointment of all the staff for the Council's office and for recruitment of personnel for various positions which the Diocesan Council has approved. iv)
    - The Executive Committee shall fix the pay scales of the Diocesan workers, that is, bishop, Pastors and all other workers in the Diocese except those paid by the Government. v)
  - The Executive Committee shall prepare the agenda for the Diocesan Council meeting in good time to be Circulated to the members befor the annual meeting. vi)
- (C) MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
  - i) The Executive Committee shall must as often as nece-

#### ssary but at least once in three month.

- ii) The Secretary in consultation with the Bishop shall prepare the agenda and convene the Executive Committee meetings with at least 3 weeks notice to the members.
- iii) Emergency meeting may be called with a minimum of three days notice.
- iv) At both ordinary and emergency meetings 1/3 = 1 shall be the quorum.

#### HOM ANTICLE SEVEN I

#### OFFICE BEARENS OF THE DIOCESE

The Office Bearers of the Diocese shall be :

- a) The Bishop, (clergy)
- b) Arch Decon (Clergy) bas data9 add to
- c) The Secretary (Lay)
  - d) The Treasurer (Lay)

The Office bearers shall be elected during the regular meeting of the Diocesan Council and shall hold office from the close of that meeting till the close of the next election meeting of the Diocesan Council. The term of office of Bishop is Six years and other Office bearers is five years.

Any vacancies arising among the office bearers excluding the Bishop shall be filled by the Diocesan Council in the procedures laid down in the By-laws and such office bearers shall be in the office for unexpired part of office or till a new person is elected to the person they replace.

- In case the Bishop is not able to function due to illness or other reasons the Arch Deacon shall act in his/ner place as per the written direction of the bishop which is to be circulated to all the Council members till the Bishop resumes his duties.
- The Office bearers of the Diocesan Council shall implement the decisions taken by the Diocesan Council and also by the Gossner Council.
- The Office bearers shall act on behalf of the Diocesan Council in emergency and get their action approved in the next meeting of the Diocesan Council.

#### ANTICLE LIGHT

#### THE BISHOP

The Bishop shall be elected by the Diocesan Council of the G.E.L.G. for a term of six years as per rules. Eligible for reclection only for one consecutive term. (Ref: Bye-laws, Election Procedure).

The Bishop being responsible to the Diocesan Council of the G.E.C. and being an office bearer with authority shall see to it that the Lutheran Doctrine is safeguarded the Gospel of Lord is preached and that the Church constitution, the rules and regulations and the By-laws are followed and also see that the decisions of the Diocesan Council be carried out.

He/She shall have the general pastoral over sight of the whole Church and shall concern himself/herself with the spiritual life of the Church and the theLord's mission.

He She shall give spiritual guidance and encouragement to the Parish and Congregation.

He|She shall be the Chairperson of all meetings of the Diocesan Council.

He/She shall have the general supervision of the work of the other office bearers of the Diocese.

Special duties and special authority of the Bishop of the Diocese shall be defined in Bye-laws as determined by the Diocesan Council.

The procedure of election is laid down in Articles-

He/She may be re-elected once if eligible otherwise.

#### ELIGIBILITY AND ELECTION OF BISHOP

#### A. ELIGIBILITY

Bishop shall accomplish his/her tasks together with other members of the Diocese and society. To carry out his/her tasks with good conscience and spititual authority his/her life and work should be blameless according to scripture, 1 Timo 3:2-7. Therefore,

- a) A Candidate for Bishop should be with qualities of leadership good reputation, honesty, integration, sound theological education in a Seminary and should not have been convicted for moral turpitude.
- A person who has proven ability in his/her previous work, spiritual leadership, in management of property stewardship of resources and other works.
- A Candidate for Bishop should not be below 45 and above 59 years of age and must have at least 10 years of successful ministry provided that in the new set up. The First Bishops may be iligible even after 65 years of age who shall have to retire by the age of 70 years.

#### INSTALLATION OF THE BISHOP ELECT .

- end of the Diocesan Council during which he/she was elected or re-elected.
- Clause B: The installation of the Bishop shall take place within six weeks from the date of election. The installation should be done according to the order of service fixed for it.
- Clause C: The Moderator (presiding Bishop) of the Gossner Council shall consecrate the newly elected Bishop assisted by the outgoing Bishop of the Diocese concerned and one or more Bishops of the Dioceses of Gessner Church and/or the other Bishops in the UELCI and CNI.
- Clause D: The Bishop shall bear a cross as a sign of his/her high sacred service, a ring and shall carry a shepher-d's staff. The Diocesan Council may decide for special robes for the Bishop. Uniformity is designs and colour of the robes shall be maintained by the Diocese.

#### C. NESPONSIBILITY OF BISHOP

- Gause A: The Following shall be the responsibility of the Bishop:
  - a) He/She may conduct worship and administer Sacraments in any parish of the Diocese.
  - b) me/She has the right to inspect all records, registers, account books, property, documents and so on of all the bodies and institutions of the Diocese.
  - he/She shall send pastoral letters to the congregations from time to time and state therein his/her advice and encouragement with regard to events that have happened within the Diocese and outside of it. Such pastoral letters shall be read out at the time of Sunday services.
  - d) He/She shall propose the transfer of Pastors to the diocesan Council through the Workers and Admimistrative Committee, if any.
  - He/She may attend the meetings of the Parish Council and congregational meetings and all other Boards and committee as a standing invitee and give advice and guidance as ex-officio member without voting right.
- of Jesus Christ be preached to all people living in the whole area of the Diocese (Matth.28). He/She shall continually enable both ministers and members of the Diocese their duties in this respect and promote evangelistic work by his/her own example and by encouragement to others.
- Diocese shall be responsible for the spiritual life of the Diocese. He/She shall carry out this task together with the members of the Diocesan Council so that the aims of the Church will be fulfilled faithfully according to the Constitution and decisions of the Diocesan Council.

- the word of God and shall have oversight of the instruction concering Christian faith in the congregations of the Diocese.
- Clause E: He/She shall be responsible for fostering spiritual unity, love, faith and discipline in the local congregations and watch over His flock by making every effort to prevent false teachings. If a person from a Church not ecumenically related to the Church wants to speak or teach in the Diocese, the Congregation shall have to get prior permission from the Bishop for allowing such persons to preach.
- Clause F: he/She shall make every effort, personally of through delegation, encourage the following works to be carried out faithfully in all areas and branches of the Church:
  - That the Diocese shall share the responsibility of the Gossner Council in its work, as a prophetic voice in matters affecting the Government. State and the people in general of the country.
  - b) appropriate teaching materials be made available for Christian children's religious instructions in confirmation classes. Sunday schools and hostels.
  - That the Diocese for the love of Christ and in witness thereof, shall work for the sick, the poor and the needy through appropriate services of the Diocese.
- lause G: The Bishop as the pastor of pastors shall have the authority to advise and admonish the pastors, and the other workers of the Diocese. If necessary the Bishop can take disciplinary action on any pastor, head of institution, trangelist or any worker and can suspend temporarily any Pastor, evangelist or any worker of the Diocese upon the recommendation of their concerned Boards and report of the Diocesan Council.
- Clause H: He/She shall accept condidates for ordinations and ordain them.
- Clause I: He/She shall induct the Parish Priests to their work.
- continuing education programmes and workshops be arranged by the Convenors of the respective Boards and committees for the workers, Elders, Lay people including women and Youth of the Diocese.
- Clause K. Concerning Administration:
  - 1) He/She shall have general supervision of the management of the Diocesan office through the office bearers and the other workers who are appointed by the Diocesan Council.
  - 2) He/She shall see that the decisions of the Diocesan Council be implemented properly and in due time.

5) The Diocesan Bishop shall participate upon request by the Gossner Council in programmes organised by the letter.

VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF BISHOP LUE TO KETIKEMENT AND OTHER REASONS:

A Bishop shall retire from service according to the Clause A: hules of retirement applicable to pastors.

The Bishop has the right to resion from his/her office giving three months notice. In such an event the matter is to be placed before the Dio-Clause B: cesan Council.

Liuse C: A Bishop shall accept the work assigned to him/her by the Diocesan Council after the term of his office is over. He/She has no right to hold the bishop's title after the term of office is completed.

-lause D: In the case of demise, the Arch Deacon shall act as Bishop until new Bishop is elected.

THE BISHOP'S IMPEACHMENT

All Complaint and charges against the Bishop must be made in writing and supported by evidence. Any complaint without valid and sufficient evidence should not be entertaned at all . A complaint against bishop unless signed by one third of the ordained ministers of the Diocese, cannot be entertained. As a Bishop is a pastor of pastors and spiritual leader of the Diocese the matter of impeachment of a Bishop must be dealt with utmost care and respect. Therefore the question for impeachment of Bishop can be entertained only if it is signed by at least one third of the pastors in active ervice in the Diocese. This complaint shall be made to the Lica Deacon of the Diocese who shall inform the same to the retary and the Treasurer, The Arch Deacon of the Diocese shall send a cory of the complaint to the Bishop with a reoutst to submit his comments on the complaint allowing atleast 15 days time. After expiry of the period, the Arch Deacon, the scretary and the Treasurer shall jointly call for a meeting the Dioceson Council where the complaint the comment of the hop is to be placed for consideration. This meeting of the - Sesan Council is to be presided by the Arch Deacon. Then the Diocesan Council shall examine the matter.

If it is found that the complaints are manipulated, the complaint if he/she is a worker of the Diocese, he/she must be dismissed from service, if he/she is a lay person the Diocesan Council may keep him/her under the Church discipline as deemed fit. The Diocesan Council may also take appropriate

tion against the abaters of the complaint in the act of shop impeachment.

In case the said Liocesan Council finds that there is a prima facie evidence, the Diocesan Council shall appoint an enquiry Committee consisting of five members which shall be constituted as follows:—

Two Parish Priest, two lay persons(one of whom shall be a women) and the Chairperson for whom the help of the wossner Council shall be sought. The Chairperson of the Enquiry Committee shall either be a Bishop of another biocese of the wossner Council or a retired Christian judge or a senior legal person deputed by the Gossner Council.

If the Enquiry Committee confirms that there is a prima facie case, the Bishop may be honourably relieved until the final report is presented within three months, After clocure of the enquiry, the Enquiry committee shall submit a report along with all evidences collected to the Diocesan Committee appropriate action in the matter. If the Diocesan Committee appropriate action in the matter. If the Diocesan Committee, the Diocesan Council shall take any of the following actions.

- In case of the offences proved against the Bishop are minor the Diocesan Council may take appropriate action.
- b) The Bishop may be asked to submit his resignation.
- c) He/She may be removed from the post of the Bishop.
- d) He/She may be dismissed from all posts.

# ARTICLE ELEVAN

#### ALBITRATION IN THE DIOCESE

All disputes between members/workers/institutions/ Parish Council and the Diocesan Council shall be decided as per the provisions of the constitution and byc-laws of the Diocese.

If any person/institution/Parish is not satisfied with the decision of the Diocesan Council, the said dispute is to be referred to the Arbitration Committee of the Diocese through the Bishop. The Executive Committee shall set up an Arbitration Committee in each case of the dispute.

In case the function of Office bearers is seized by any court order or otherwise, the Gossner Council shall take the responsibilities of spiritual care and the general administration of the Diocese until the Diocese can function legally.

#### ARTICLE TWELVE

#### HANCHI CONGREGATION

#### HATIONALE

Lutheran Church since its establishment. In shaping the life of the Gossner Church. Manchi witnessed great historical debates, strugles and solutions. Thus it has developed a personality of its own more often inspiring than otherwise. Its history recalles to memory its great personalities its leaders, pastors, men and women who have regarded Gossner Church worthy of sacrificing their lives even. Thus Ranchi is a symbol of Gossner family's guest for unity, struggle for dignity and identity, autonomy and self reliance. In the future too hanchi should continue to inspire not only through its historical past but also by creating a new history demonstration to the people of Chota Nagpur that in Christ the different cultural communities of the area could worship and witness to the one Lord together in true Christian social fellowship. Therefore Manchi congregation historically known as the "headquarters congregation" remains autonomous reflecting in its composition and administration the unity of the Gossner Church consisting of several cultural communities.

Hence the Manchi congregation continues to enjoy in this new constitution also a separate identity and status, but an integral part of the Gossner Church.

#### CO. POSTI ION

to all members of the Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church from whichever diocese they may hail, members of Gossner Church may join Manchi congregations by transfer letters from their respective congregations. The Manchi congregation however is the ultimate authority to admit members to the congregation.

- viii) It can undertake its own ministries of witness and service in addition to the worship, nurture, evangelism, healing and development ministries.
  - ix) The Council of the manchi Congregation shall appoint its representatives to various committees of the Gossner Council.

#### 4. KELATIONSHIP

- A) Administrative relationship.
- i) hanchi Congregation shall send its representatives to committees of central institutions and properties.
- ii) It shall send its representatives to the Gossner Communion.
- 3) Spiritual Relationship
- i) The Presiding Bishop of the Gossner Council is the spiritual leader of Manchi congregation.
- In view of the fact that the North West Diocese will not have its own congregation in Manchi the Bishop of the NW Diocese be put on the preaching schedule in the Manchi congregation services according to mutual agreement. Similarly, the Bishops of other Diocese shall also have the same privilege.
  - iii) The congregation may also let North West Diocese to have its special servicese for some special occasions on a mutual agreed basis.
    - iv) The rresiding bishop of the Gossner Council who is also the spiritual leader of Ranchi Congregation be extended facilities by the congregation for him/her to share the spiritual life of the congregation.
      - v) The Ranchi Congregation shall neither initiate nor entertain any negotiations for altering the status of the congregation like merging with any diocese at any time.
- 5. FUNCTIONS OF THE MANCHI CONGREGATION EXECUTIVE CO. MITTEE.
  - The officers of the Council of the Ranchi Congregation (CRC) are also the officers of the Ranchi Congregation Executive Committee. The Executive Committee is the Executive of the Council implementing all its decisions. The Executive Committee shall act on behalf of the Council of the Ranchi Congregations. The Executive Committee shall meet as often as necessary but at least once in 3 months.
  - ii) The Executive Committee shall be responsible for the regular conduct of worship services in Manchi Church and for nurture, proclamation and development ministries of the congregation.
  - iii) The executive Committee shall administer the institutions under the management of Ranchi Congregation and is free to open new institution and coperate with other central institutions by sharing resources with them.

- iv) The Executive Committee shall appoint staff for the institutions under its care, required number of pastors for the congregational work and other staff.
- v) The Executive Committee may also appoint separate committees for the administration of the institutions under the overall supervision of the Executive Committee.
- Vi) When there is a vacancy for the position of the Dean, the Executive Committee shall prepare a panel of five names one from each of the Diocese of Gossner Church one of whom to be elected by the Council of Ranchi Congregation.
- vii) The Lean so elected shall serve for a maximum period of ten years.
- viii) The Executive Committee shall appoint other assistant pastors, the number of whom shall be decided by the congregation.
  - ix) Including the Dean, the pastors of the Manchi Congregations shall be representatives of all the Dioceses (as far as possible).
    - x) executive Committee through the Dean shall report to the annual meeting of the Council of the Ranchi Congregation on the ministries of the congregation.
  - of all the workers of the ChC including the Dean and the assistant Pastors.
- 6. THE OFFICE BLAKERS AND THEIR DUTIES.

  - i) The Dean should have at least a B.L.Degree and should not be less than 40 years of age.

  - wi) He/She shall be the custodian of all legal documents and represent the RC in all legal matters, and shall sue and be sued on behalf of the RC. He/She shall act according to the decision of the CRC.
- vii) He/she shall submit all necessary amendments to the constitution and bye-laws and necessary documents to the negistrar of Societies. He/she shall be responsible for circulating all minutes as per rules.
- He/She shall carry out all duties assigned to him/her by the CRC and the Dean.
  - ix) He/She may be re-elected for only one consecutive term.

#### TREASUNEN

- i) The Treasurer shall be a lay person elected by the CRC for a term of three years.
- ii) The Treasurer shall according to the instruction of the CRC take care of the finances of the LC.
- He/She shall operate joint accounts of the RC with signatures of the three office bearers. Two signatories are enough for a single transaction one of whom should be the Treasurer, He/She shall also receive contributions from abroad or locally on behalf of the RC. He/She shall make proper investments in the bank as per the decisions of the CRC.
  - iv) He/She may be re-elected for only one consecutive term.
  - v) The duties of the Treasurer shall be defined from time to time as determinded by the Ckc.
  - vi) The Treasurer is responsible to prepare various plans and projects for future financial self support of the RC and place before the CRC for approval.

- vii) The Treasurer is responsible for reporting to the CRC and for submitting audited accounts.
- viii) The Tresurer is responsible to the CRC for proper financial management of the Church as per the recommendation of finance committee.
- OF THE RANCHI CONGREGATION (CRC).
  - i) For any amemdments, the General Body of the Ranchi Congregation can amend only the bye-laws related to the CAC with the consent of at least 50% + 1 of the members of the General Body present at the time of voting.
  - ii) Proposals for such amendments shall be submitted by the Executive Committee to the CRC with one month notice to the members, which will then place the proposals before the General Body meeting for its action.

#### . .. ARBIT.ATION

Any disputes in the administration related to the Executive Committee or the CAC shall be referred to the Committee of Managment of each institution or any ministerial committees.

- i) In case of grievance, any staff can appeal in writing to the Committee of management.
- ii) In case the decision of the Committee of the management is not agreeable, he/she can appeal to the executive Committee of Chc, whose decision shall be final.
- iii) In case the function of the office bearers cannot function due to Court litigation or otherwise, the Gossner Communion may take over the administration till the dispute is settled.

#### ANTICLE THINTEEN

#### GOSSNER COUNCIL:

Note:

The Umbrella structure of the Gossner Church in the new dispensation is now termed as "Gossner Council" to eschew any misunderstandings of the return of the central authority and enforce the new role - a spiritual role of fostering Christian fellowship of the whole Church as a communion. The Gossner Council therefore refers to the new structure that holds the Gossner Church together as a family and enables the decentralised autonomous Dicceses to function effectively. It shall be the unifying force for all the Dioceses and therefore shall restrict dis-integration of all kinds. Where a particular diocese may still need any help or support, the Gossner Council is still a valuable structure for support.

#### COMPOSITION

Gossner Council shall consist of the fellowing:

- i) Bishop from each of the diocese
- ii) One layman from each diocese
- iii) One lay women from each diocese

- iv) One youth (male or female) from each diocese
  - v) Dean of Manchi Congregation
- vi) One layman/Woman (by turn) from Ranchi Congregation.
- vii) One co-opred from special field.
- viii) The Gossner Council will elect one of the Bishop as Moderator (Presiding Bishop) of the Gossner Council who shall preside over all Gossner Council meeting.At the same time he shall be the Bishop of his own Diocese.
  - ix) The elected members from the Dioceses shall hold office for a period of five years at a time.
    - A full-time paid General Secretary appointed by the Gossner Council for a period of five years at a time, will serve as the Secretary of Gossner Council. He/She shall prepare the agenda for Gossner Council meetings in consultation with the Presiding Bishop and call the meeting of Gossner Council with two month's notice. He/She will also be responsible to organise any other meetings, conferences etc. as per the decision of the Gossner Council. The Gossner Council will have an office of its own in kanchi under the leadership of the General Secretary. Who shall co-ordinate the diffrent Central Committees and execute the decisions of the Gossner Council. He shall also discarge all other responsibilites which might be assigned to him from time to time.
  - xi) The Gossner Council will normally meet once a year. The General Secretary will present a report of activities. The Gossner Council will hear from the Diocesan representatives information on their life and work.
  - xii) Treasurer: The Gossner Council will elect from amongst its members an Honorary Treasurer. The Treasurer will keep accounts for the incomes and expenditure of the Gossner Council, have the accounts audited and present the audited accounts, the budget and financial statement at the annual meetings of Gossner Council. Duly authorised bank account shall be opened in one of the nationalised banks in Ranchi and operated jointly by the General Secretary and the Treasurer.

#### 2. FUNCTION

- i) Gossner Council is the leader of the Gossner Church in extending spiritual support through various programmes, bringing together periodically the Gossner Church Dioceses and members for spiritual nurture and fellowship.
- ii) The Gossner Council also plans programmes to demonstrate the Gossner Churches commitment to the Church and society for Christian witness.
- iii) The Gossner Communion will relate itself to all programmes and events of expressing national Christian solidarity on all religious and political, justice, peace issues affecting the Church and the nation.
  - iv) The Gossner Communion will appoint ecumenical representatives of the Gossner Church to the following ecumenical institutions:
    - (1) Lutheran World Federation
    - (2) World Council of Churches

- (3) Christian Conference of Asia
- (4) National Council of Churches in India
- (5) United Evangelical Lutheran Churches in India
- (6) Gossner Mission
- (7) Any other national or international bodies. making sure that all the diocese share these responsibilities.
- v) The Gossner Council will also have the responsibility to relate itself to overseas Mission and Development agencies specially on behalf of dioceses that need such help from the Gossner Communion.
- vi) Upon request from the dioceses, the Gossner Council can extend help through its secretariat in initiating new ministries in particular of Development.
- vii) The income of the shopping complex shall be contributed to the Gossner Council for its operational financial needs.
- shall be shared according to an agreed principle by all the dioceses and hanchi Congregation of the Gossner Church. It shall extand special financial sapport to Gossner Theological College.
  - ix) The Central Institution will also contribute certain percentage of their total income to the Gossner Communion(Council).
    - x) Gossner Council will celeberate all important historical events of the Gossner Church.

## ARBITHATION

Disputes not settled within the diocese or disputes between dioceses shall be referred to an Arbitration Committee consisting of the Moderator of the Gossner Council and other Diocesan Bishops excluding the Bishop or Bishops in dispute. The Moderator may invite a Christian legal expert to help settle the dispute. If still the party to the dispute is not satisfied, then the final appeal lies to the Arbitration Committee of the UELCI. Under no circumstances the parties to the disputes shall seek recressal of their grievances in the Court of Law before the dioceses. Gossner Council or UELCI constitutional processes are exhausted.

#### ARTICLE FOURTEEN

# CENTRAL INSTITUTIONS

The following Educational institutions below to the whole Gossner Church:

- (2) Gossner Theological College
- (3) Bethesda B.Ed. Training College

They shall be administered by separate committees of management. In order to ensure the participation of the whole church in each of these committees of management, it is ensured that all the five bishop are members of these committees with one of them being Chairperson of one committee of the other.

## i) GOSSNER COLLEGE

Inthe case of Gossner College, in addition to Diocesans representatives, University and Government nominees are members in accordance with the regulations of the Education Department of the Government of Bihar. The following additional members are proposed:

- (1) The Principal of the College- Member Secretary
- (2) One representative of AIACHE
- (3) Executive Secretary of UELCI/nominee
- (4) An Educationist nominated by UELCI from outside GELC
- (5) One representative from CNI
- (6) One representative from Catholic Church, Bihar
- (7) One representative of Manchi Congregation
  Secretary Principal Gossner Theological
  College

Chairperson - One among the Diocesan Bishops to be elected.

# ii) Thaining colleges

Governing bodies of Bethesda B.Ld. Training College and Bethesda Primary Teachers Training College shall be formed according to the rules prescribed by the Government. However, all Bishops of all Dioceses of uELC and the Dean of Manchi Congregation of Gossner Church or their nominees are members of these Governing Boards. The respective heads of the institutions are Member Secretaries of the Governing Committee.

- The Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church is the legal owner of all immovable properties, lands and buildings presently lying within the territorial jurisdiction of Gossner Church congregations, dioceses, kanchi Congregation and Central Institutions. All properties that may be acquired in the future by various units of the Church also belong to the GELC.
- The various units of the Church have only legal right to the use and development of the properties under their jurisdiction but have no right whatsoever at any time under any pretext to alienate the properties in whatever from.

All users of GELC properties shall enter into legal aggrement with the appropriate property authority (Committee & Trust) of the Gossner Church, on the terms and conditions for such use of the properties.

4. The users of the properties shall take steps to demarcate the properties under their jurisdiction and document placed in the office of the ultimate proposed authority of the Church.

5. There shall be a Property Trust of the Gossner Church with <u>full</u> legal powers to manage the properties on behalf of the Gossner Church.

The Property Trust Association will have to be defined (Awaiting the reports of the Committee appointed for this purpose).

# ARTICLE SIXTEEN

AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF GOSSNER CHURCH

- 1. Notice of amendment to the Constitution may be given by resolution of a Diocesan Council or Councils.
- 2. Notice for such amendment must be given to the Presiding Bishop with copy to the General Secretary.
- The Presiding Bishop should circulate this amendment amongst all Dioceses and Ranchi Congregation.
- '4. If three Dioceses reject the amendment, the amendment is lost.
  - If no such objections are raised, the General Secretary in consultation with the Presiding Bishop shall call for a General Meeting of the members of the Executive Committees of the Dioceses at least three months after the circular of amendment notice Mas been sent to the Dioceses.
  - 6. Fravel and food expenses of the members of the Executive Committee attending this meeting must be met by the Dioceses themselves.
  - 7. Two-thirds majority of the total strength of members of all Executive Committees is required for passing an amendment.





Overall performance of DAMI is very poor 1.

- 2. CMAI evaluation Ms. Pauline Brown also made the same observation.
- 3. Documentation, record keeping, monthly reports, registration is not upto the mark.
- 4 During our visit all the community workers and health guides were not present.
- 5. Financial transactions were found to be faulty :-
- The CHVs (Community Volunteers) are not paid their a. salaries regularly. We don't understand why when all the salaries are budgeted.
- b. The Chairman and Secretary of the local committee are listed as CHVs and getting CHV salary.

This just can not be. They can either be CHVs in their own village and do work as CHVs or be Chairman and Secretary of the local committee and work as honoraries. There is no salary for that work could you please look into this ?

- The accounts and report are not maintained properly. C.
- d. Project funds amounting to Rs.18,000 are being kept by three individuals with them. The reason given was that the bank is far and there is delay in getting funds from the bank.

This is highly irregular. As you are aware, no individual should keep project money with him, money needs to be given to Project Manager as and when required and proper accounts and receipts kept. you can look into this and get this matter cleared.

I am sorry for bothering you, but these are rather alarming findings. I can assure you all the help from Delhi Office and I am asking Mr. Topno from Ranchi office to make a visit to Dami in August and help.

We would be grateful if from your side you can look into financial matters, staffing and proper budgeting of CHVs salaries and supervision of the project.

Greetings from CMAI. A team from CMAI recently visited project Burju. I am writing to let you know their observations and finding. This may help you to take appropriate decisions on some matters.

Project - Burju No. - CHDP/9502 PM - Mr.C.N.Lomga

- 1. The project reports were not sent to Delhi Office from January 96 to May 96.
- 2. Before that the reports came regularly.
- The project has good community support, all CHVs and health guides were present at the time of visit.
- 4. The workers are enthusiastic and there is great potential for this project to succeed and expend.
- 5. CHVs and P.M. and H.G. all need training in record keeping and monitoring registers.
- 6. The Development component (weaving of Durries) was
- a. Started in March 1997. This does not seem to be with the project area community. We need more information on this. Also the project manager has withdrawn RS.16,000/= for development activities from the project. We have budgeted only Rs.10,000/= for the development activities in the project area only. The amount Rs.16,000/= is not settled with the project. This is irregular and needs immediate rectification.

The CHVs are not paid salaries for the last 10 months we are surprised to note this. There is budget for CHV salary. If the Project Manager gets his salary, how come the CHVs do not? Also I feel Rs.50/= month is too little for CHV work. Their salaries need to be raised to Rs.100/= month.

c. A camera worth Rs.2,500/= is bought with project money. That is not a budgeted item. How is this justified?

I can assure you of all our support. I am asking Mr. Topno to visit Burju and look at the registers etc. Together we need to make this project a success.

We will plan training and another visit to Burju after we hear from you. Unless all the financial matters are rectified, continuation of the project will be difficult.

Dear Ipe,

I have received your fax message of 24 May 1997 seeking our prayers for the victims of the earthquake in Madhya Pradesh and financial support for their rehabilitation.

I am surprised and shocked to see this note from you? You are fully aware of the fact that as the Related Agency of the National Council of Churches in India, CASA is the only ecumenical organisation mandated to do relief and rehabilitation work on behalf of all the Protestant Churches and Orthodox Churches in India which are also members of the NCCI. As the General Secretary of the NCCI, you are a member of our National Board and Executive Committee and have often heard reports from CASA and international resource partners about CASA's ability to respond with speed and efficiency to the needs of people suffering from natural or man-made calamities, CASA is internationally recognized of being in the frontline when it comes to administering humanitarian assistance. In the instance of the Madhya Pradesh earthquake too, CASA was the first organisation to contact the Jabalpur Diocese of CNI and other Church organisations, including the Catholic Churches, to organize relief work among the victims. Our relief teams are already there and I have sanctioned immediate assistance for 1,500 families belonging to the weakest sections of the society.

I am, therefore, amazed and pained to see how you, as the General Secretary of the NCCI, are flagrantly violating the set norms and precedence by soliciting funding support from CASA and others. You have maintained on several occasions in the past that the NCCI is not an agency for soliciting and collecting resources for programme, especially for emergencies, neither is the NCCI mandated to do so. I fall to understand why the NCCI found it necessary to send an independent relief team to assess the situation and start relief and rehabilitation work? You have always asserted that the NCCI is not an operational agency, yet you have gone ahead and sent a relief team to

Ams.

Madhya Pradesh. The member Churches of the NCCI have already mandated CASA to do relief and rehabilitation work on their behalf. Cannot CASA be trusted to do this, when it has a 50 year history of responding to similar situations? We have trained and experienced staff to fulfill various functions during an emergency, which includes survey, needs assessment, co-ordination and liaisoning with Government authorities and NGO partner network, identification of beneficiaries, actual distribution of relief material, monitoring and reporting. Over the years, we have made concerted efforts to build up the capacity of our staff to do these tasks in an efficient manner, so that the relief intervention is both relevant and effective. Furthermore, we have a proven track record in emergency response and are recognized as a leading NGO in disaster response and mitigation. If you had simply taken the trouble to call us up and find out what CASA is doing, NCCI could have saved itself unnecessary expenditure of time and money.

This is very serious matter. Your action are diametrically opposed to your frequent assertions. Perhaps this is why people are losing faith and trust in what is being said and what is actually being done. I have taken very strong exception to your action, which is creating a divide between the Churches and CASA. I will be raising this issue at the forthcoming meeting of the CASA Executive Committee in New Delhi. I also intend to make it a primary issue for discussion with Church leaders in the future.

I am instructed by my clients Messrs. SIRINGULA WASHINGTONG and REV. DOLLA PRAKASA RAO of TANUKU and VELPUR respectively to inform you as follows:

The District Munsif's Court, Tanuku granted an injunction in I.A.No.1698 of 1997 in O.S.No.206 of 1997 on 28-4-1997 restraining the then acting President G. IMMANUEL and others from holding biennium convention of the A.E.L. Church including the meetings of the Executive Council, all boards and committees. In view of the urgency an Advocate Commissioner was appointed to serve the injunction Hukum. IMMANUEL with his aids assaulted the Advocate Commissioner and refused to receive injunction Kumums and hence he was intimated separately by means of a registered letter which he received on 10-5-1995. He was also similarly injected in I.A. No.362 of 97 in O.S.No.4@ of 97 on the file of the vacation Civil Court, Guntur. Sri G. EMMANUEL appear to have convened the biennial convention of A.E.L. Church on 27th to 29th May at Guntur inspite of these injunctions with men of his choice and is now claiming to be its President-elect. At the regular convention held on 26th and 27th May at Tenali as per original schedule fixed by Executive Council on 16/12/1997, Sri Y. MARTHIN LUTHER SASTRI was elected as the President of A.E.L. Church, Guntur. Both of them are sending rival circulars to all the origins working under the control of the A.E.L. Church demanding allegiance to each. In the circumstances in a suit filed by my client in 0.S.No.342 of 97, the District Munsif Court, Tanuku granted an injunction in I.A.No.2792 of 97 restraining 1) Sri G. EMMANUAL, 2) SRI N.CHINA JOSEPH, 3) SRI MANNAVA RAJ KISHORE and 4) SRI MANNEM SAMUEL from any manner interfering with the administration of A.E.L. church represented by its President Sri Y.M.L.SASTRY and not to act on behalf of the church in any manner, Sri G. IMMANUEL and the three others referred to above are not the officers of A.E.L. Church and any direction by them to demand obedience to their orders constitutes gross contempt of Court and will be void.

You are therefore requested not to give any weight to any letters/circulars/orders that may be sent by Sri G. IMMANUEL etc., and take guidance from the President of A.E.L. Church Sri Y.M.L. SASTRY.


